Discussion of UNHCR Funding of IDP(1000 HHS) allocation in Rakhine State		Action point
RRSC	The Minister agreed the UNHCR proposed (950 HHs) IDPs located in MRU, MBR and KT townships but he requested the possibility of an extended assistance to (170) IDP HHs living in NC1-PT camp. Those IDPs were also ongoing in the relocation package assistance and their temporary individual shelters were not able to be completed due to funding shortage and the increase of households by population from 2012 to 2015. The Minister explained what was permitted for PT camps in the 1 st phase, which was {605+112*} =717 but only after ground figures in NC1 increased more than 170 HHs due to a settlement between PT-TA and CMC. So after NC1, the total HHs is 775. Currently there are over 100 HHs living in unfinished individual shelters and existing long houses of approximately 15. Heavy rain and strong wind this week has had an affect; some long houses were reported as tilted by CMC. The minister is communicating with PT-TA to get eligible IDP HHs to enlist in assistance to share with UNHCR. The Minister shared an estimate & design of a (USD\$1,000) individual shelter package as developed by DRD.	All concerned members will coordinate and share updates
UNHCR	UNHCR stated that the proposed (950) IDP HHs in Z1 were fully covered in MRU, MBR and partially in KT, see below table. UNHCR will try to respond to RRSC's request of assisting PT-NC1 but with partially and prioritized IDPs, HHs with PSN and residents of Cha Eik new. After a detailed discussion between both parties, UNHCR accepted max: (50) IDP HHs of NC1-PT as part of (1000 HHs) target, "in principle", and will forward NC camp focal agency, LWF, for further arrangements. UNHCR will share a detailed formatted list of (950) IDP HHs of Mru, Mbr and Kt camps and sites with RSG for planning and future activities. The Minister shared an estimate & design of a (USD\$1,000) individual shelter package as developed by DRD.
