

## Shelter Cluster (NWSW) input to ICC Monthly Situation Report

### Shelter Cluster Humanitarian response

During the reporting month 21,163 individuals (4,111 households) were assisted in which 2,789 individuals ( 500 households) in North West and 18,611 individuals ( 3,611 households ) in South West

#### North West

- NRC reported the distribution of 500 emergency shelter kits in Donga Mantung reaching 2,789 individuals (1,423 F; 1,366 M)
- FGI has conducted post distribution monitoring in Menchun-valley reaching 18 households who received emergency shelter kits

#### South West

- Plan international reported the distribution of 11,380 soap in Fako divisions (Buea Tiko, Wotutu and Lumbe) to health districts, elderly association and orphanages centres .
- DRC reported the distribution of 982 emergency shelter kits in Fako and Meme reaching 4,608 individuals (2,350 F ; 2,258 M)
- AMEF reported the distribution of 100 emergency shelter kits reaching 500 individuals (255 F; 245 F)

#### Challenges

- Ban of some metallic-based items within the shelter kits in North West continue to limit shelter response
- Funding to respond to shelter/NFI needs in NWSW.
- Continue confrontations between Government Security and Defense Forces (GDSF) and non-State armed caused new displacement and limited access of partners to discharge their duties
