




25	<h2>Summary of the Nepal Displacement Tracking Matrix</h2> <p>In Nepal, the methodology was rolled out within four days of a major earthquake of 7.8 richter scale that hit the country on 25 April 2015. Assessments were done in two waves, difference between them being the questionnaire used.</p> <p>Assessment teams from 29 -30 April used the V1 of the questionnaire, the data from which is reflected in 'Open Spaces DTM-Master List v1'.</p> <p>Assessment teams from 1 May used another version (V2) of the questionnaire, which is more detailed and better customised to the context. Data from this interval is reflected in 'DTM-Master List V2'.</p> <p>DTM Round 3 has started on the 15th of June, it will end on the 12th of July, using the new DTM R3 form.</p>

27								<h3>Criteria for Priority Sites</h3> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1 - 20HH+ - The number of households/families must exceed 20.2 - Higher density tents/shelters – Villages that have scattered shelter within are not sites.3 - Larger distance displacement – Groups of IDPs that have moved away from their homes. (This requirement is more applicable in a rural setting. Commonly, urban areas contain people close to their homes – see 4.).4 - IDPs must be living on site – not accessing their homes.<ol style="list-style-type: none">a) Accessing toilets/latrines on site, or using a nearby toilet that is NOT their own.b) Possession of their belongings – look for things like cooking pots and stoves.c) Clear indications that they are cooking on site (gas cylinders, communal cooking area).

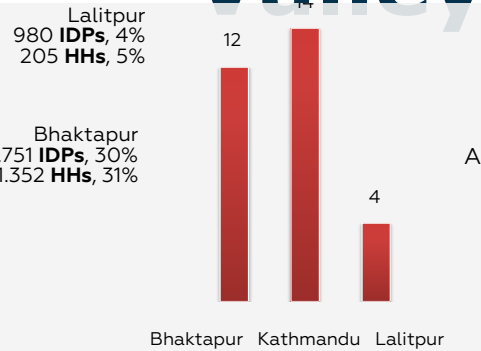

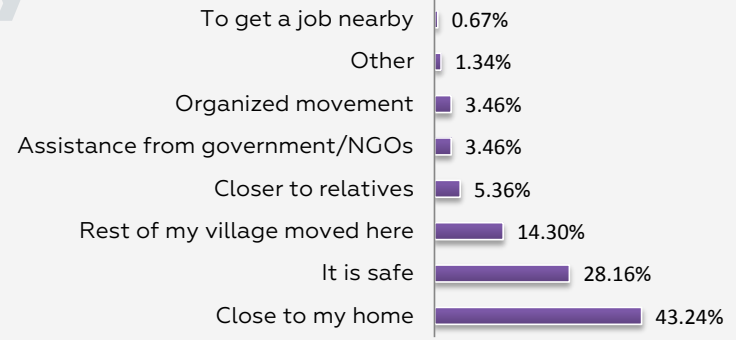

Overarching issues

- Current focus on improving coordination in 4 southern districts
- Need for more focal points
 - Anyone with capacity please contact shelter cluster
- Remote northern areas starting to be cut off
 - Need for more use of porters and helicopters
 - Cash needs to be useable
- Families moving to self reconstruction and in need of technical support
 - Need for improved coordination of training, messaging etc
 - Need for guidance on incremental reconstruction



Sindhupalchowk (Chautara)

- Coordination
 - Weekly Shelter cluster meetings
 - IOM Hub coordinator as acting focal point
 - OCHA sub office so a wide range of meetings
 - Strong government counterpart
 - Strong DLSA

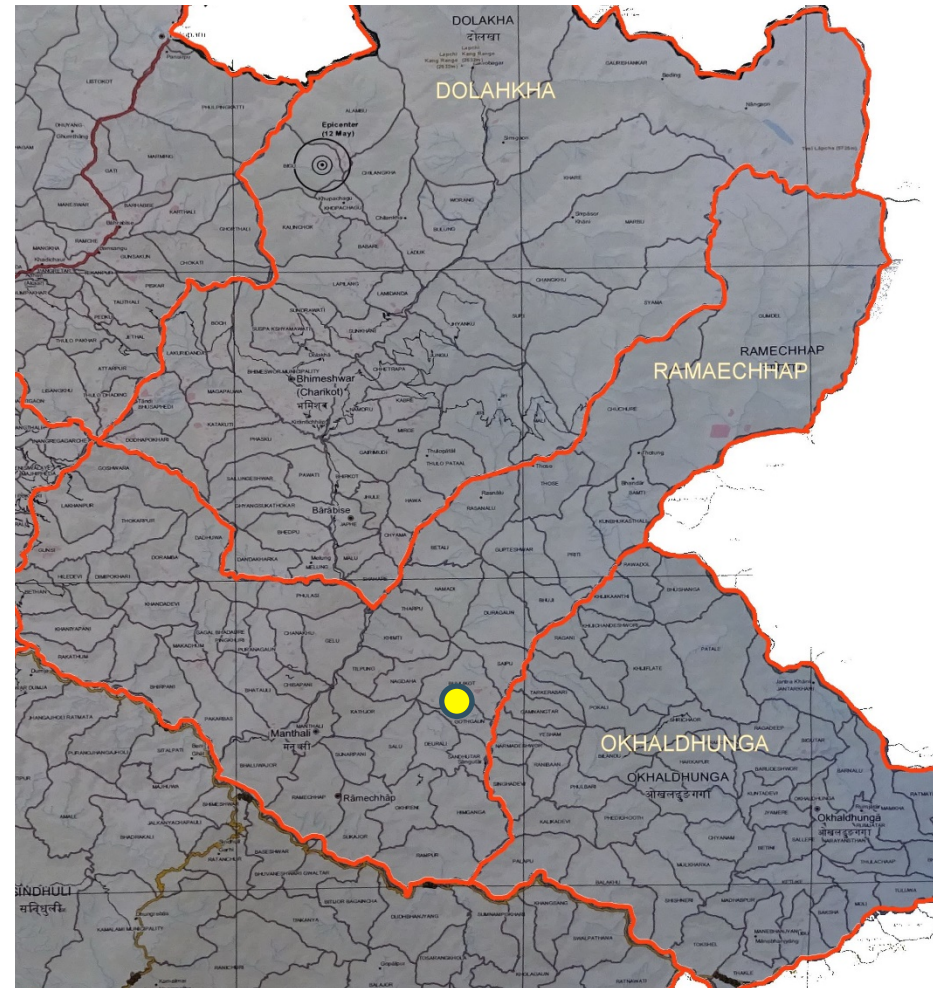

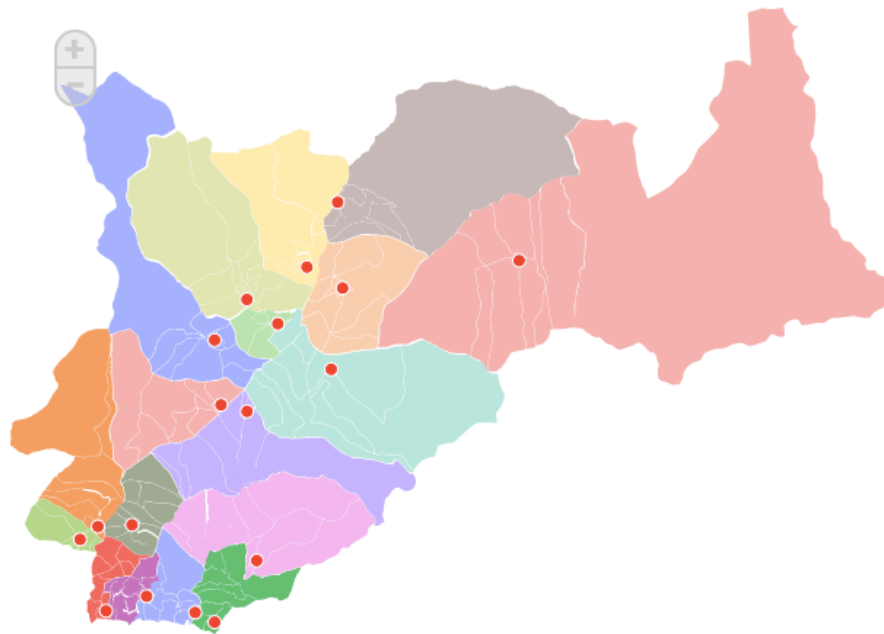

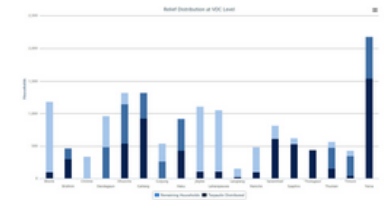
