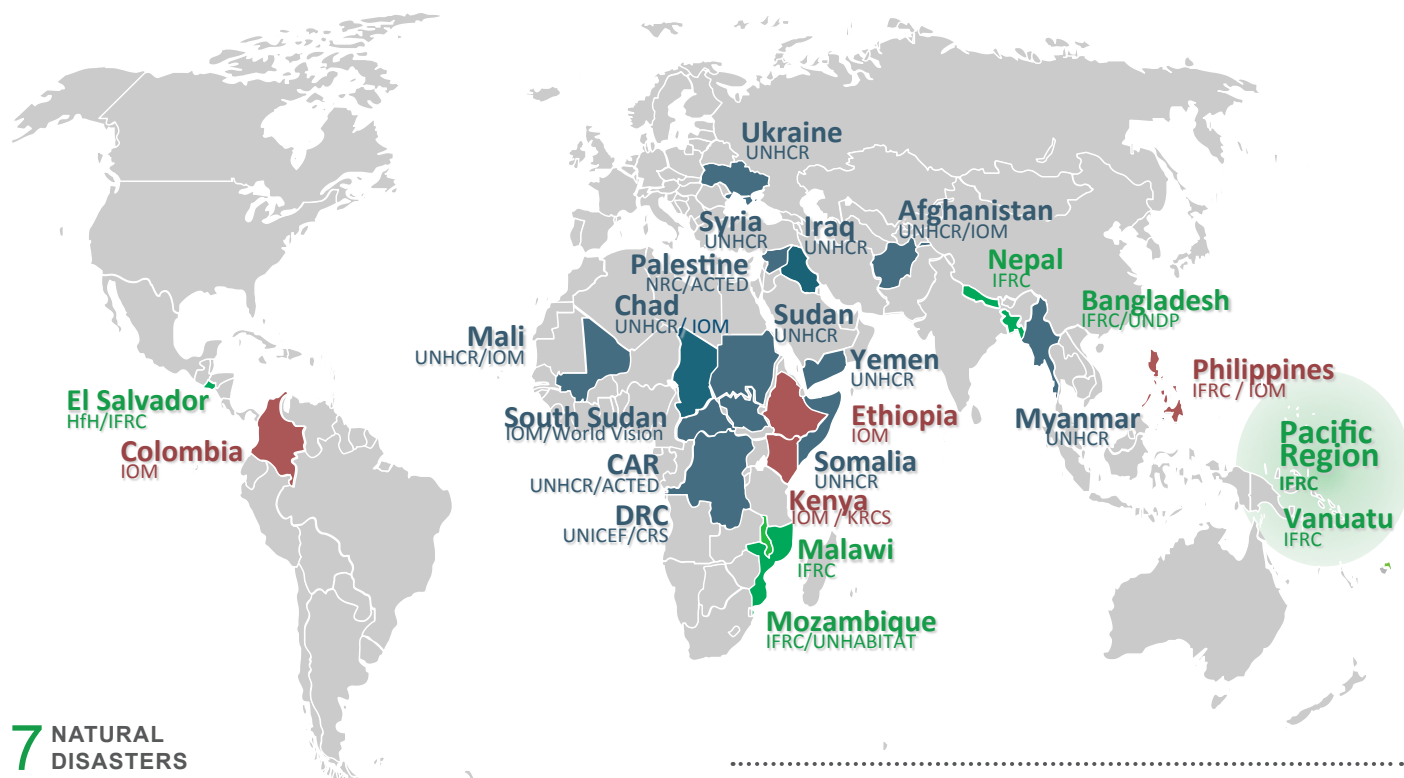

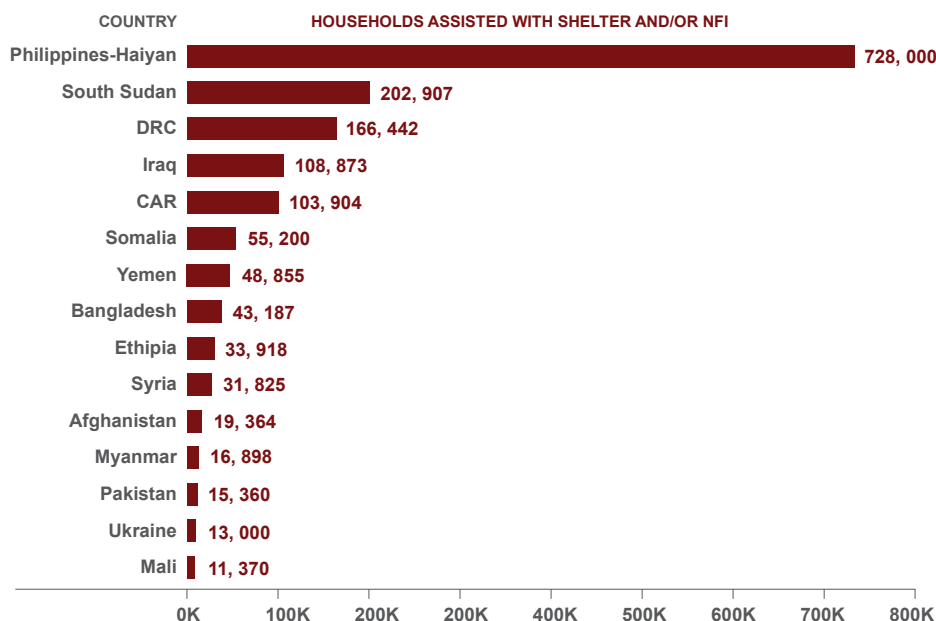

provided assistance to more than 1.3 million households with shelter and/or NFI solutions.

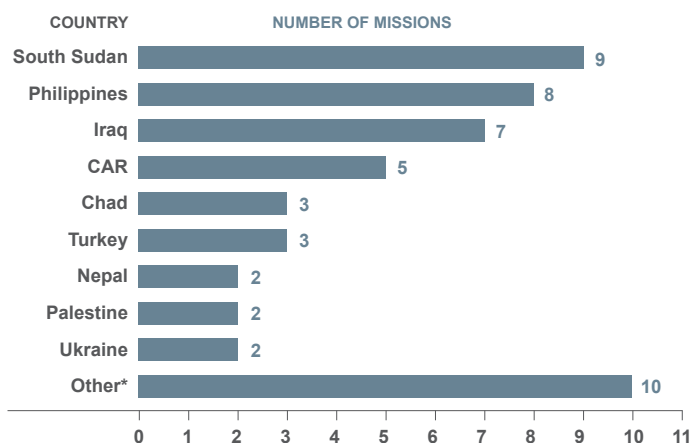
FIELD SUPPORT

COMMUNICATIONS AND ADVOCACY

The Sheltercluster.org website provides key information on active shelter clusters. In 2014 the number of unique visitors to the website was **20,730**.

The number of Twitter followers increased from 20 in January 2013 to 1,226 in January 2015, with an average of 3.7 tweets from the GSC per working day, and a current potential reach of around **12 MILLION PEOPLE**.
