

Site Management & Coordination (SMC) in Yemen

Vision

Improved living conditions in IDP hosting sites and promotion of durable solutions with full participation of the displaced and host communities

Goals

Promotion of an integrated – multi-sectorial approach to service delivery in IDP hosting sites to ensure the displaced communities have access to protection and assistance in a dignified manner, and in accordance to humanitarian principles

Objectives

Objective 1

To ensure all stakeholders are fully consulted and appropriately involved during assessments and humanitarian response within IDP hosting sites

Objective 3

To enhance capacity of national/local authorities and service providers in SMC in order to promote improved standards within IDP hosting sites

Objective 2

To improve response to protection and assistance needs within IDP hosting sites by strengthening information management and coordination

Objective 4

To promote community participation in SMC by strengthening IDP self-governing structures for accountability and responsive decision

Integrated Coordination structure

Level One

Site Coordination Support Team (SCST)

Coordination of activities, monitoring of services and standards & reporting, conducting assessments, conducting registration, provision of capacity building training, referral of sectorial gaps/cases, strengthening of community governance structures, Site Planning, Mass information, Monitoring, Evaluation & Sharing lessons learned for improved intervention,

Site Focal Point – Access, law & order, documentation, designating & opening planned Sites

IDP Leaders

Level Two

Sub-National Shelter/NFI/CCCM Cluster

Coordination, Information Management, advocacy, and technical support eg Capacity building at the governorate level and support to SCST in a single site or sites

Level Three

National Shelter/NFI/CCCM Cluster

Coordination, Information Management, advocacy, and technical support eg Capacity building at the national level, overall support to both the Sub National Shelter/NFI/CCCM Cluster & the SCST)
