### Shelter Cluster Humanitarian response

#### 2799 households were assisted during the month of October 2020

##### South West

During the month, UNHCR and partner Plan international carried out several distributions of assistance in terms of shelter and NFI kits to IDPs and vulnerable host community members in West Coast, Tiko and Limbe in the South West Region. Assistances were in the form of shelter materials for persons of concern living in damaged shelters (508 households), light emergency shelter kits to IDPs in need of shelter (196 households), and household core relief items (254 households).

##### North West

800 Households were assisted with core relief items in communities within Widikum subdivision in Momo Division such as Widikum Central, Tikom, Olorinti, Elum and Diche 2, Eka, Ebendi, Nyen, Dinku, Diche I, Bifang, Ambobo and Abegum. 1000 Vulnerable members of these communities also received shelter kits

SHUMAS reported that its assisting about 8 households with 41 individuals with rental subsidies in some quarters in Bamenda.
