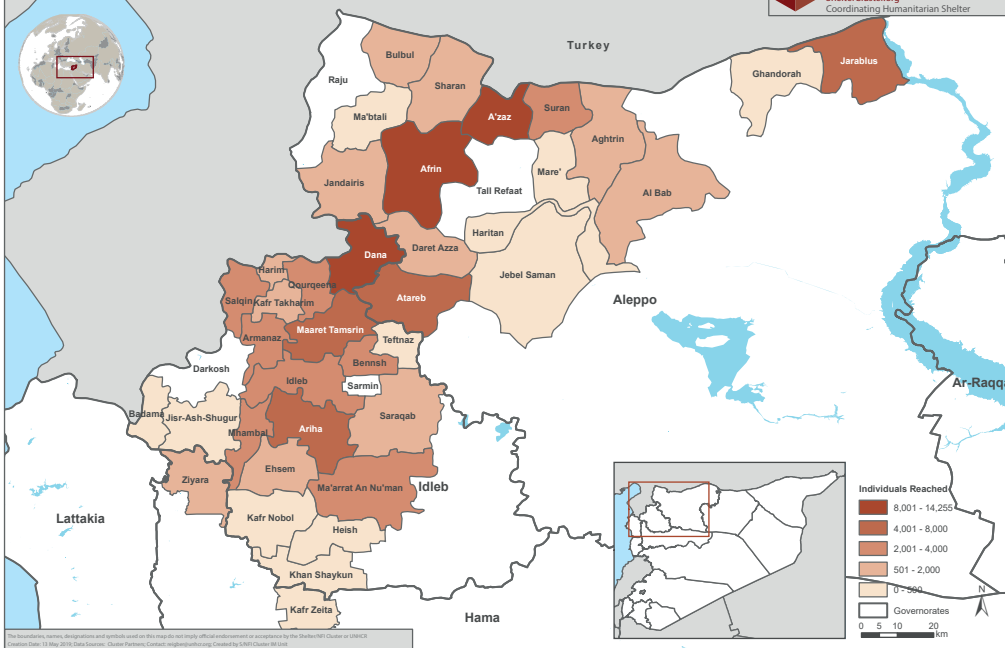


Shelter/NFI Cluster - XB Operations: Partner Coverage by Sub-District
Turkey Hub - Gaziantep - April 2019



The Shelter and NFIs Cluster, led by UNHCR, coordinates the efforts of 143 total member organizations of which 50 are active. The Cluster addresses the coordination of emergency Shelter and NFI needs and promotes household and community resilience. The Cluster supports people in need within displaced, hosting and non-displaced populations by ensuring that the different modalities of interventions (in-kind, non-conditional/conditional cash or voucher) abide by the do-not-harm principle.

The Cluster Coordination Team Activities

- The new SNFI Cluster Coordinator Alexandre Kolejda arrived in Gaziantep on April 12.
- The Cluster Coordination Team visited the IOM Burc Warehouse to discuss NFI Kit content current specifications of the items and quality feedback.
- The Cluster Coordination Team worked with the review board for the Contingency Stock on updating the guidelines and requirements for applicants in order to respond in a more structured manner to new requests.
- Due to heavy rains over 150 sites are affected by floods and the CCCM and SNFI Cluster in collaboration with their Members as well as UNHCR Partners are coordinating the immediate response.
- SNFI Cluster Meeting was held on 10 April 2019 at the UNHCR office in Gaziantep.
- The Cluster Coordination Team is briefing the new Cluster Coordinator on work of the Cluster for response, plans, challenges as well as monthly reporting and products.
- The Cluster Coordination Team met with ECHO's Shelter and WASH expert to discuss the current response and challenges of the Cluster.
- The Cluster Coordination Team of the SNFI and CCCM Cluster met with IOM and ECHO's Shelter and WASH expert to discuss the Emergency Contingency Stock Pipeline funded by ECHO.
- The Cluster Coordination Team met with the Cluster's Strategic Advisory Group (SAG) and Cluster Review Committee (CRC) in order to introduce the Cluster Coordinator and have a discussion on the current situation on the Cluster and the Partners response.
- The HF 1st Standard Allocation Strategic Review Session took place on Tuesday, 30 April 2019 - submitted project proposals for SNFI Cluster were evaluated and scored by the CRC members and the recommendations of the Cluster were provided on the Grant Management System (GMS) of HF.
- Meeting of SNFI and CCCM Cluster with IOM to discuss the Contingency Stock.
- Ongoing conflict in Northwest Syria was causing a large scale displacement as of April 29. The Cluster Coordination team monitors the situation closely.

Cluster Priorities

- Provide support and guidance to the Cluster Members in preparation for the 1st Standard Allocation of the Turkey Humanitarian Fund.
- Preparedness for possible emergencies in NW Syria.

Challenges/Gaps

- Limited Access in Northern Aleppo.
- Lack of enough cluster members with shelter rehabilitation experience.

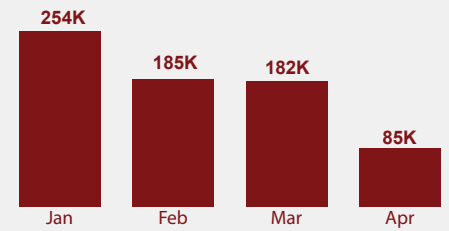

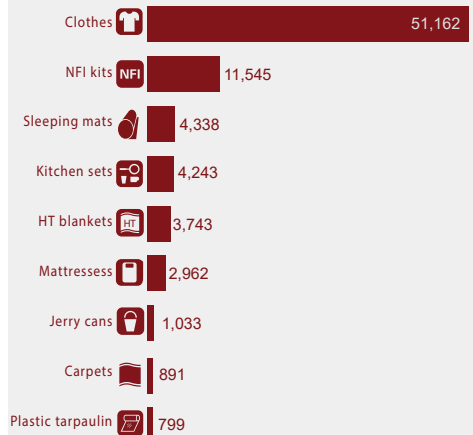
