

The Shelter and NFIs Cluster, led by UNHCR, coordinates the efforts of 145 total member organizations of which 47 are active. The Cluster addresses the coordination of emergency Shelter and NFI needs and promotes household and community resilience. The Cluster supports people in need within displaced, hosting and non-displaced populations by ensuring that the different modalities of interventions (in-kind, non-conditional/conditional cash or voucher) abide by the do-not-harm principle.

### The Cluster Coordination Team Activities

- Ongoing technical review of project proposals that were revised by the applicant organizations to the THF 1st Standard Allocation.
- Activation of Emergency Response Tools for the CCCM & SNFI Cluster to respond to the ongoing displacement from North Hama and South Idlib.
- Joint CCCM & SNFI Emergency Cluster Meeting for the displacement from North Hama and South Idlib / 08 May 2019.
- The emergency response due to the displacements from North Hama and South Idlib is still ongoing. The situation in these areas has not calmed down and the movement of IDPs is therefore very fluid. This creates a challenge for the Cluster's in identifying the real need per geographical location. The response is managed with the activated emergency response tools which relies on partner plans and response submitted to the Clusters (SNFI & CCCM). Assessments conducted in the first week were in many cases out of date and the Cluster was coordinating actively with its Members to encourage re-assessing the situation on the ground and if necessary, shifting the response to areas with newly identified needs.
- The Clusters (SNFI & CCCM) are working with its Cluster members on possible identification of new land/sites or camp extensions for additional tents. For these locations tents are released as quickly as possible depending on the CCCM Cluster's requirements and documentation for the establishment of new tents. Tent establishments are complemented with NFI distributions also coming from the Contingency Stock.
- Meetings and discussions about MSNA preparation and questionnaire drafting on NW and WoS level.

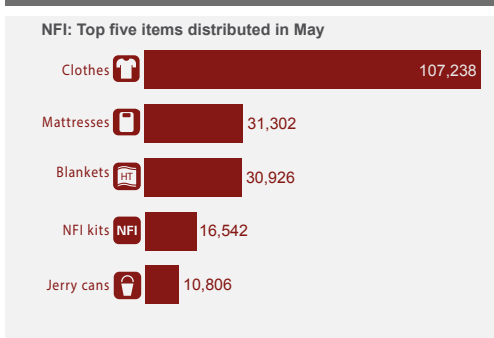
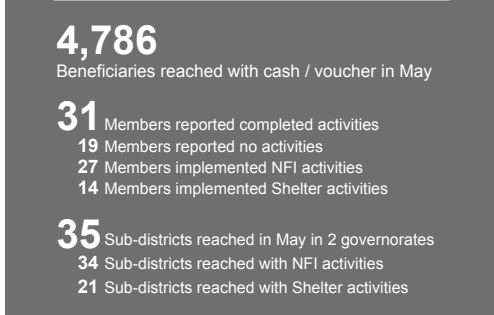
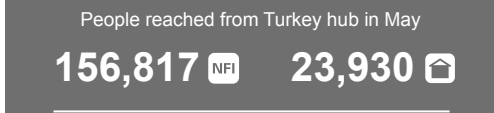
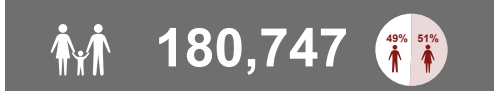
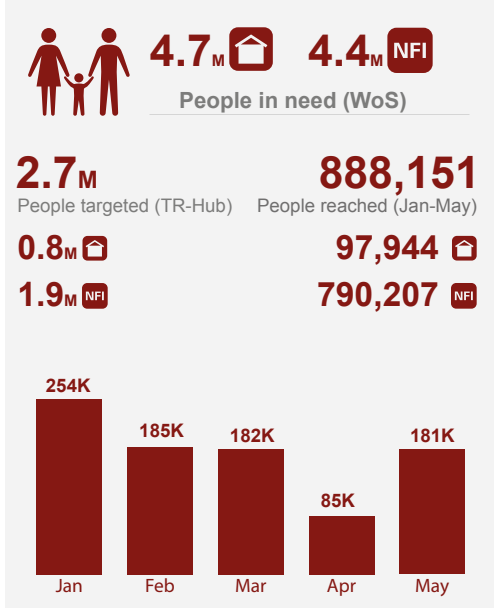
### Cluster Priorities

- Close collaboration with the CCCM Cluster to respond to the shelter needs due to the large scale displacement.
- HPC Kick-Off and MSNA (Multi Sectoral Needs Assessment) planning.

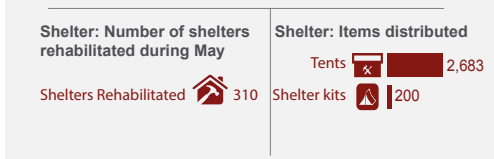
### Challenges/Gaps

- The Cluster Coordinator finished his assignment at the end of February – the replacement for his position has been identified, but the recruitment is still ongoing.
- Limited Access in Northern Aleppo.
- Lack of enough cluster members with shelter rehabilitation experience.
