

## Shelter/NFI Situation

Displacements continued in North West Syria (NWS) in November. For this month, HNAP has recorded 36,399 new IDPs, including 9,798 in Dana subdistrict. Dropping temperatures have intensified the need for fuel. Unfortunately, it is increasingly challenging to get fuel given its unavailability and rising prices. The devaluation of the Syrian Pounds is also affecting the purchasing power of the affected population. The situation is particularly difficult for the IDPs living in substandard buildings, tents and makeshift shelters.

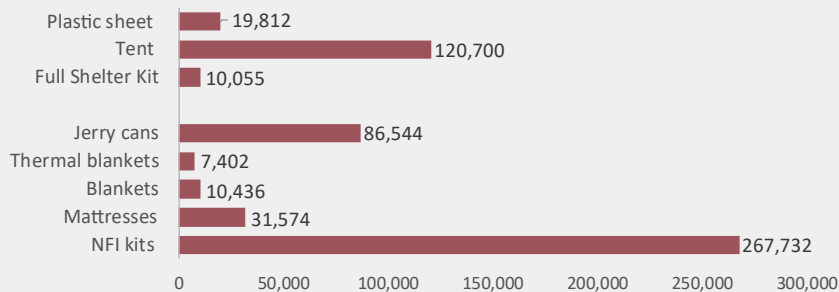
## SNFI Response

In November, most of the SNFI Cluster members focused on winterization. The objective of the Cluster is to reach the largest number of people in need before the end of December. In November, 261,144 people in need were assisted with shelter and/or NFI assistance. Despite the fuel crisis that delayed the fuel procurement, 195,396 people received with winter assistance by the end of November. Cluster members also assisted 56,401 people with shelter assistance, including 17,313 with emergency shelters, to respond to the new displacements. Long-term shelter support kept increasing, with 39,000 people reached with shelter rehabilitation.

## Preparedness plan and Gaps

The SNFI Cluster has kept NFI stock to assist more than 260,000 people and tents/shelter kits for 130,000 people who might be affected by displacement or floods. However, the probability of floods needs to be taken into consideration, as well as the fact that the quality of the shelters in the camps varies considerably, with some families having been living in old tents for more than two years. For these reasons, the SNFI Cluster is advocating for additional funding to replace or upgrade damaged tents. Moreover, even if the Cluster members are targeting 821,000 people with winter assistance, there are still some subdistricts without winter assistance such as Saran, Jandairis, Aghtarin and Sarmin.

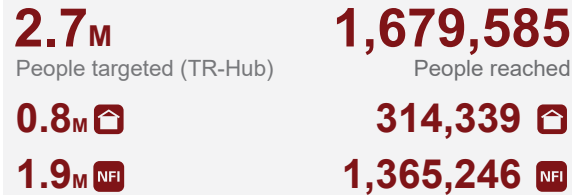

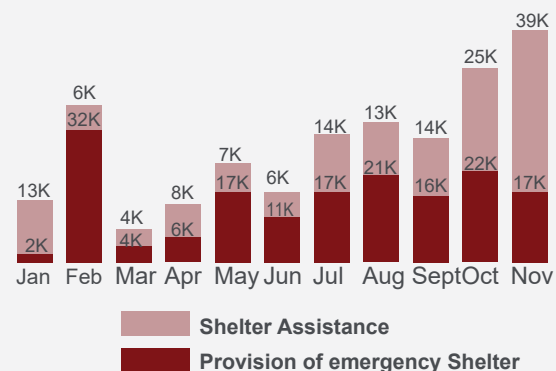
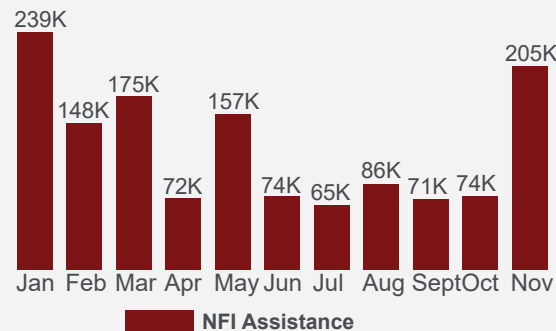
## Key progress indicators



### Turkey Hub - Cumulative (Jan - Nov)



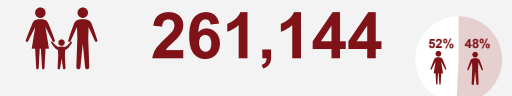
### Total individuals reached by NFI - Per month

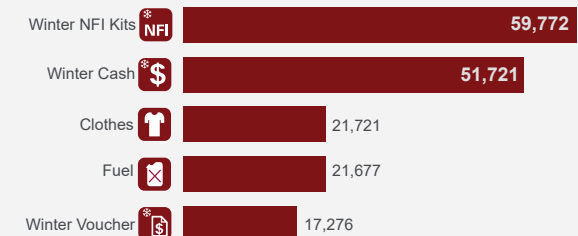

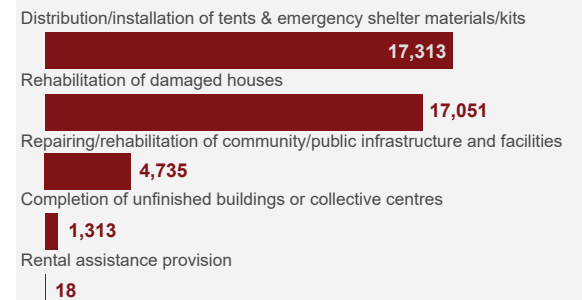

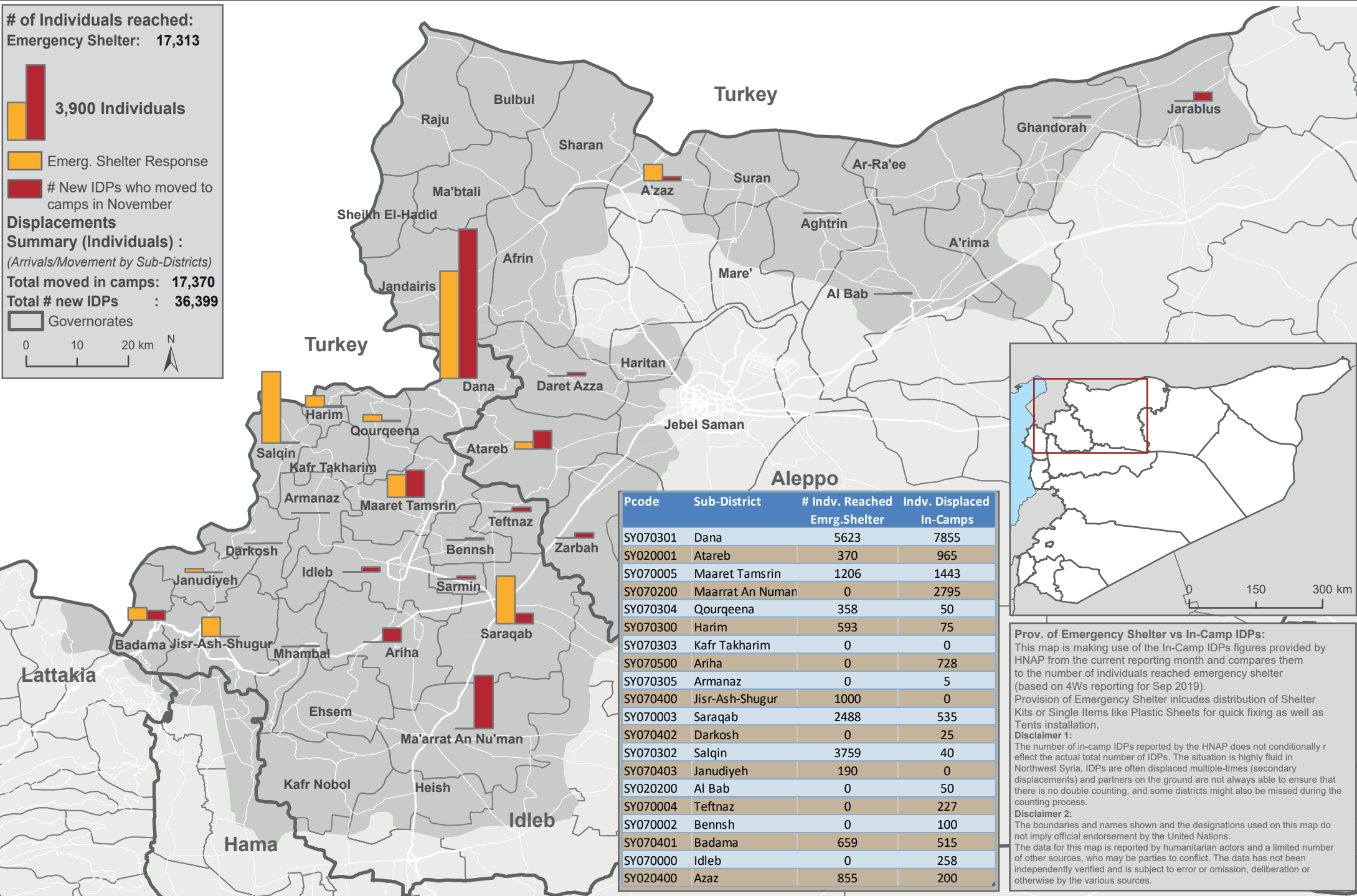

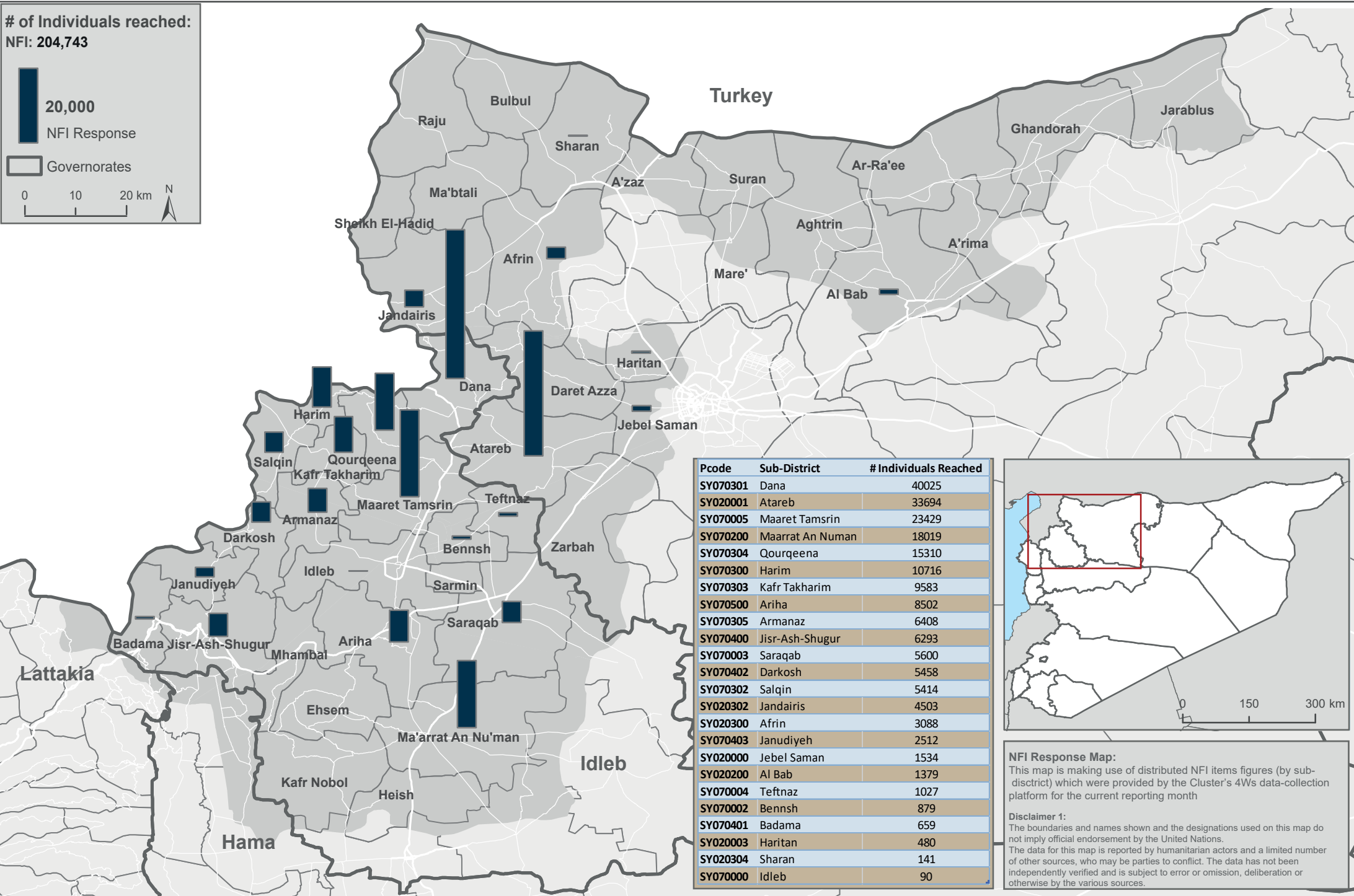
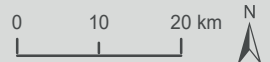


**Prov. of Emergency Shelter vs In-Camp IDPs:**

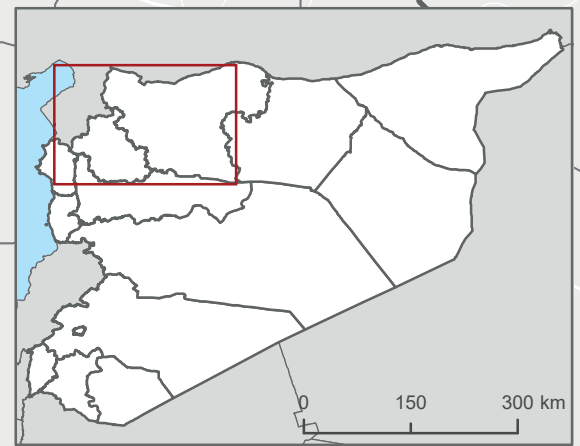
**Disclaimer 1:**

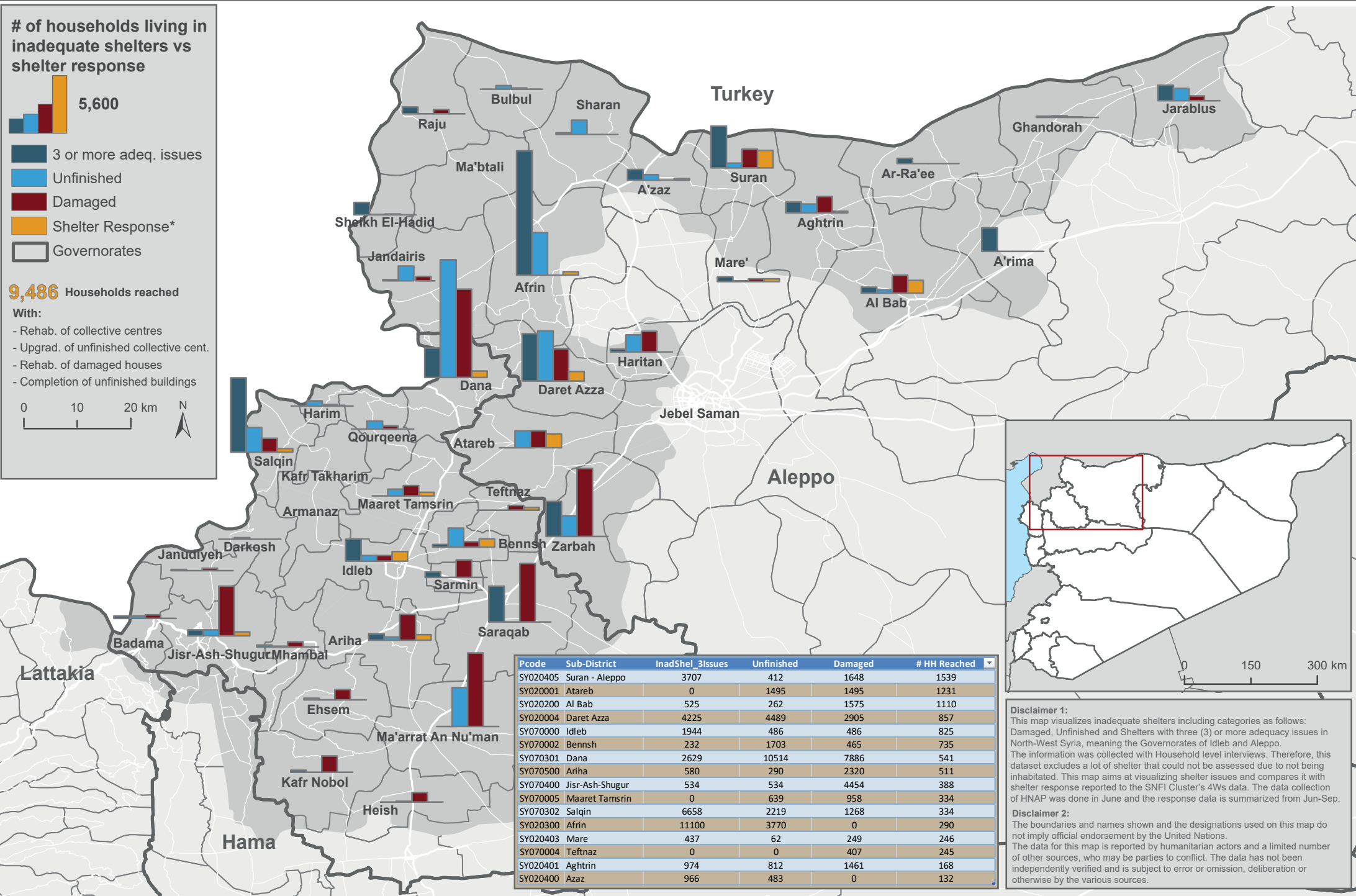

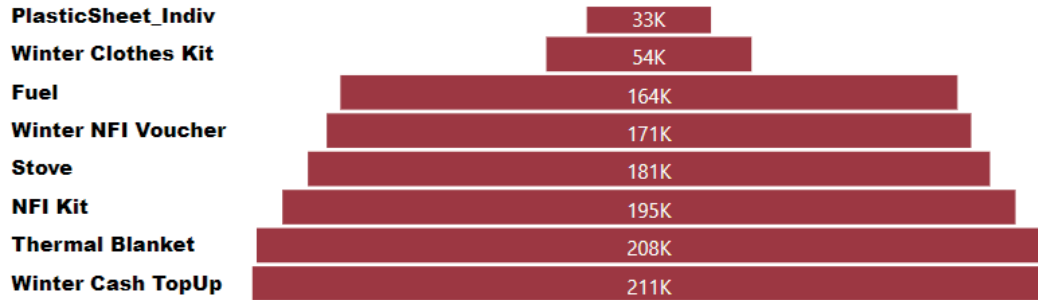

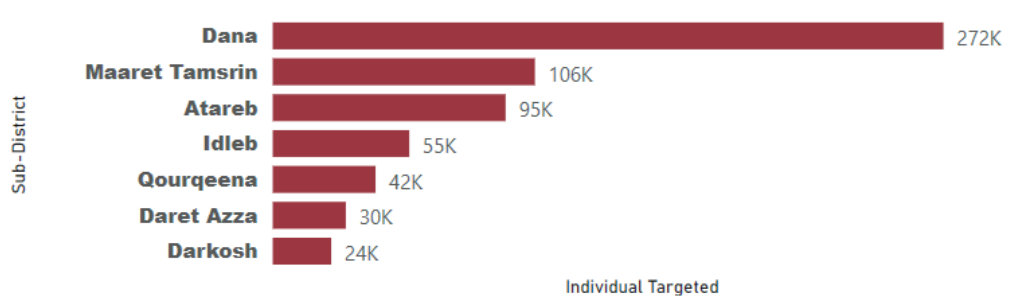
# North-West Syria: # of households assessed living in inadequate shelters vs shelter response from June - To - November 2019



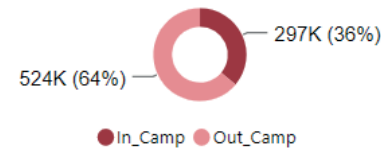
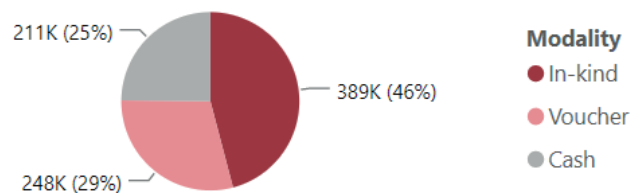
### S/NFI Planned Response by Individual



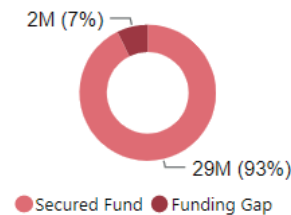
### Targeted Individuals by Sub-District



### Planned response by Modality

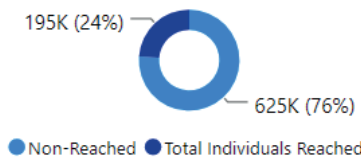

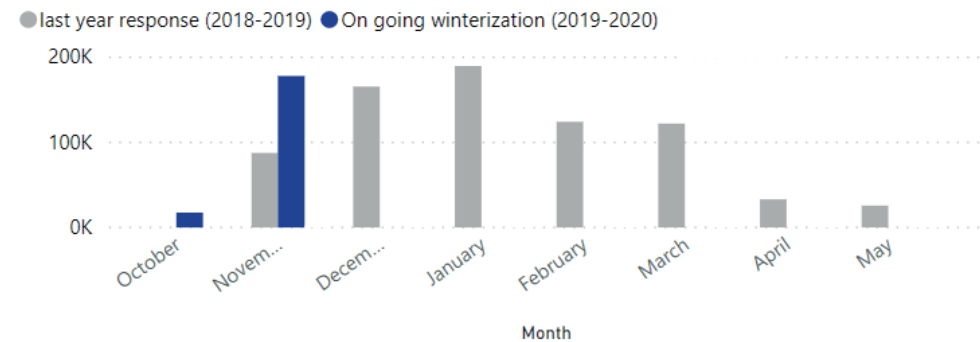

### Current Winter Response



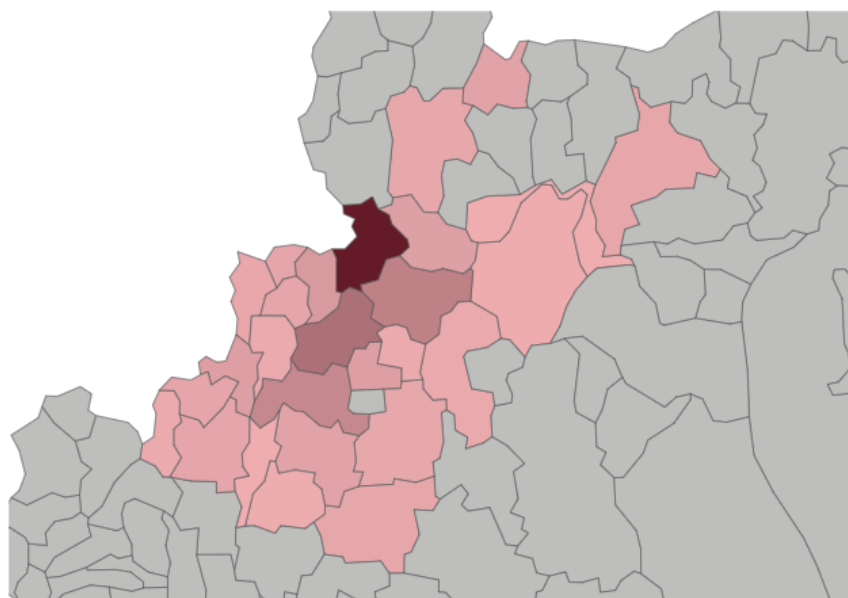
