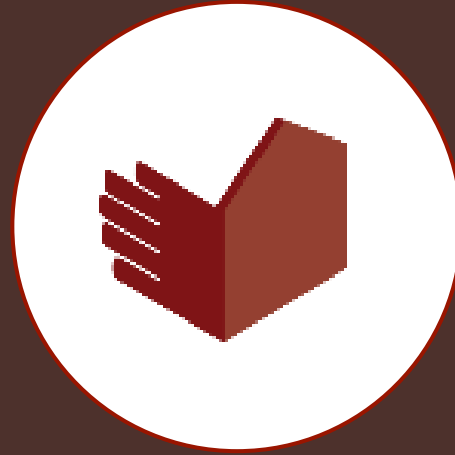

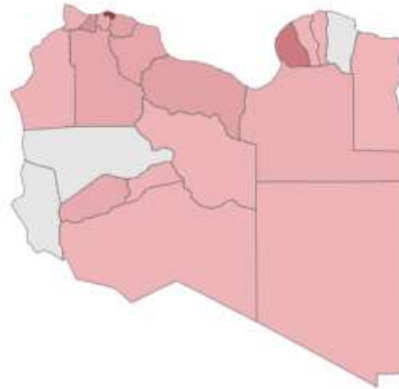

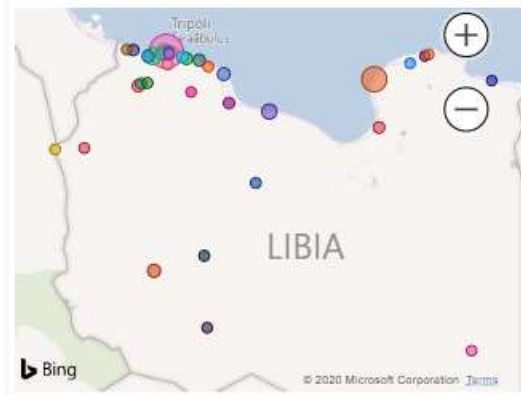


Shelter & NFI Sector 4W Dashboard

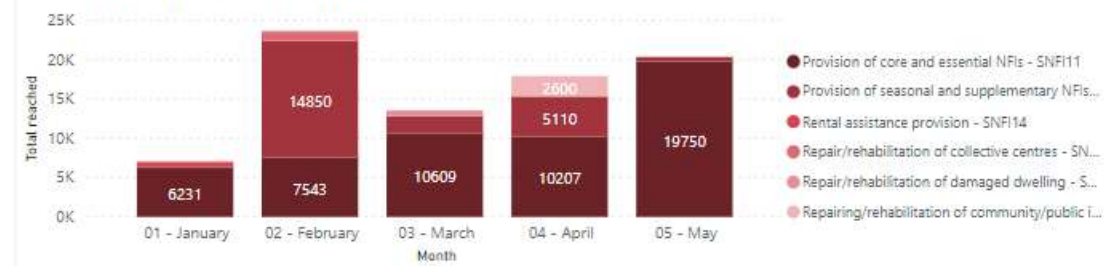

EAST response to new IDPS from Tarhuna – (completed, on going, planned up to 2 July)

The East-based Ministry of Social Affairs have already distributed NFIs to **150** families in **Albrayga**, **150** families in **Harawa**, **264** families in **Alabyar** and **800** families in **Ejdabia**.

- **Benghazi:** 1,905 HH (1,245 HH IOM – 350 HH NRC – 270 HH UNHCR – 40 HH ACTED)
- **Ejdabia:** 623 HH (300 HH IOM – 173 HH UNHCR – 150 HH NRC)
- **Bayda:** HH 120 IOM
- **Shahat:** 384 HH IOM
- **Abjar:** 380 HH (216 HHH IOM – 164 HH UNHCR)
- **Tubruk:** 145 HH IOM
- **Al Bydah:** 120 HH IOM
- **Al Marj:** 117 HH UNHCR
- **Al Brayga:** 111 HH UNHCR
- **Touka:** 112 HH IOM, 94 - HH UNHCR
- **Zweitina/Sultan:** 192 HH UNHCR
- **Soloug:** 153 HH IOM
- **Geminis:** 146 HH IOM

GAPS up to 2 July (reported by local authorities)

- **Ejdabia – 500 families;**
- **Albrayga – 144 families; 111 HH assessed by UNHC & IPs**
- **Geminis – 146 families; covered by IOM**
- **Solouq – 153 families; covered by IOM**
- **Benghazi – 1,963 families**



SIRT PREPARADNESS – SNFI PARTNERS CAPACITY TO RESPOND

- **IOM** ready to provide RRM (HKs, NFIs, Food basket) accordingly two scenarios:
 - Scenario 1: stocks available in Benghazi only, RRM partners 'capacity to assist 1000 families.
 - Scenario 2: If deconfliction and access is granted to move supplies from Tripoli to Sirte, 2000 families.
- **UNHCR** is sending 1000 NFI to Benghazi to assist the new potential displaced people in the East
- **NCR** has no capacity in Sirt, but is available to join any assessment in the East
- **IMC** has no presence in Sirt, but can assist new potential displaced in Benghazi accordingly their capacities
- **TDH** is active in the west of Sirt (Alweshka and Abughrain) developing a response plan in coordination with local council of Misurata and the sector, no capacity, however willing to support in joining assessments, receiving and distributing.

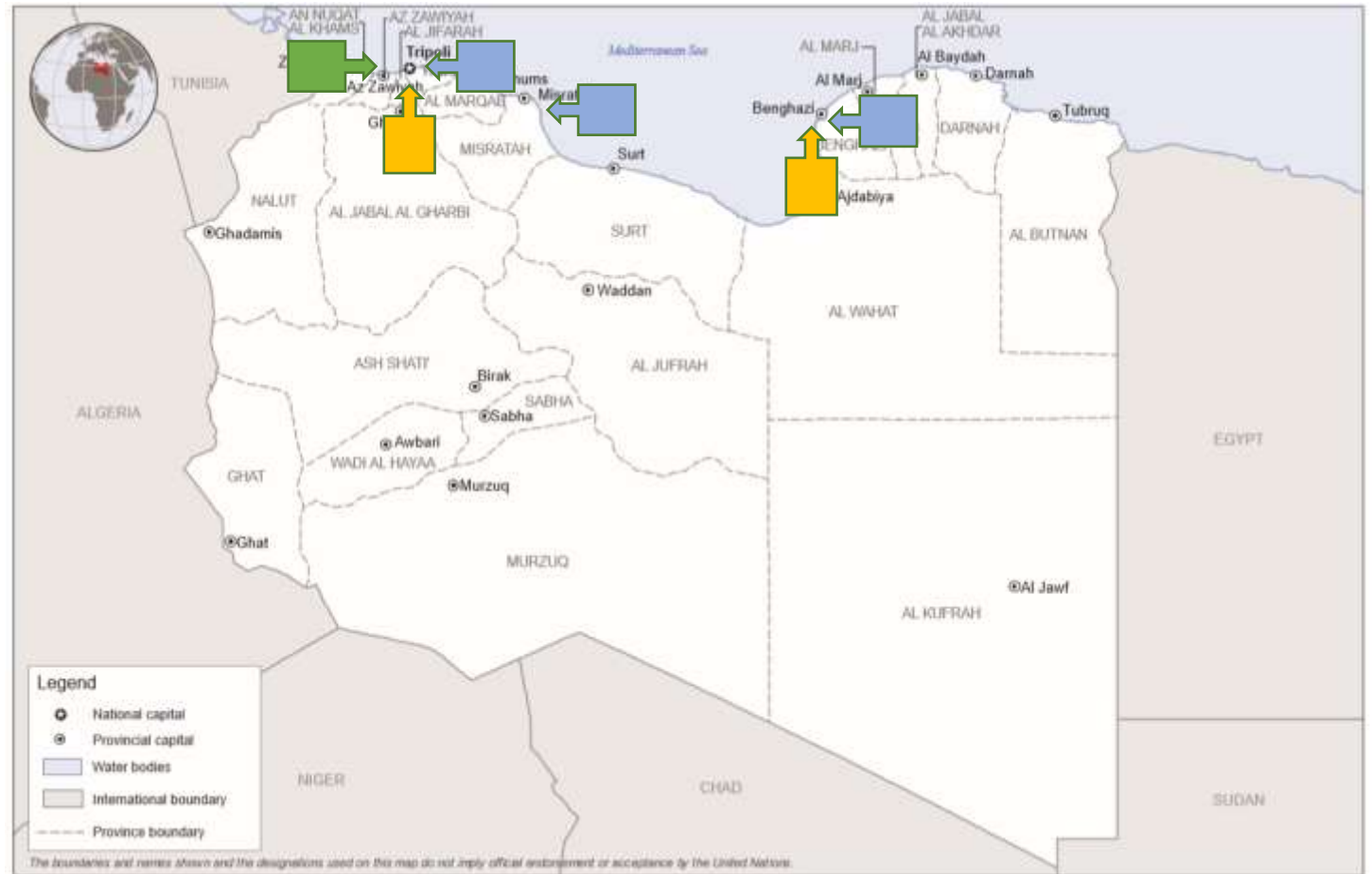

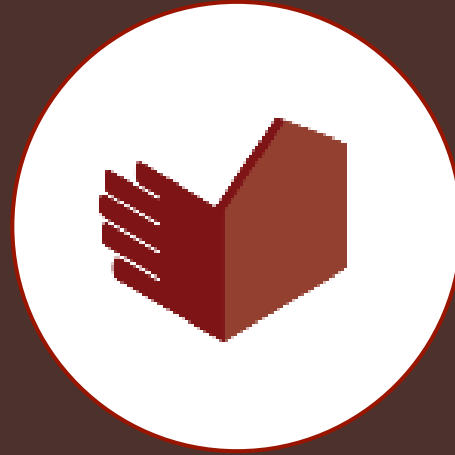
