Currently working on technical assessments. In Abu Salim, Al Awaniya</li> </ul> <p><b>UNHCR-</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continue to provide support to refugees in urban settings through CESVI – distributing hygiene kits and solar lamps</li> <li>Hygiene kits provided to 110 individuals in Ajdabia DC</li> <li>Distribution of mattresses, blankets and hygiene kits in DC’s to 1,138 individuals</li> <li>Planned distributions with Libaid in DC’s in Shahat and Tobruk</li> </ul> <p><b>NRC-</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Rehab of 40 houses completed in hay Al Sukar Ajdabia 30 shelters in Ajdabia camp completed</li> <li>Rehabilitation of 30 shelters in Garyounis camp completed</li> <li>Infrastructure works in 4 IDP settlements completed</li> <li>Planned rehabilitation works in 150 houses in Al Sabri and Benina in Benghazi. HNO 2021 recap</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The major baseline of HNO, MSNA and DTM has been recalled with focus on needs and gaps.</li> <li>Intersectoral severity indicators and thresholds were presented</li> <li>PIN estimates. Some discrepancies between sector numbers and OCHA ones. Partners are kindly requested to share any evidence or data that highlight the figures in their areas of operations</li> </ul> <p><b>3.
