Updates / presentations form the sector from the sector

- Selected members for the SAG and TWIG announced. First meeting for each of the groups will be called for by the sector coordinator in the coming 2 weeks.
- SNFI dashboard for libya is populated and available online. The dashboard is meant to improve visibility transparency of the sector work in Libya.
- Preparedness for Sirt – the sector is trying to map out the capacity of the partners to respond in case of possible displacement from Sirt towards the east, Partners are encouraged to share any details regarding their capacity with the sector.
- OCHA will move to activity info quite soon, OCHA will prepare a Kobo survey and then a training session will be held for all partners on how to move from 4W's to Activity info. The SNFI sector has also requested OCHA's support in providing a similar platform for the planned activities.

Updates from partners

DRC

- No major activities/updates for this month
- looking at continuing providing handwashing kits pending funding and negotiations with Donor
- Distribution of kits for new arrivals in Gergarish
- Plans to distribute 400 hygiene kits next month

NRC

- provided hygiene kits to long term displaced families in Benghazi (COVID response)
- provided NFI and Hygiene kits 500 families in Benghazi and Ajdabia (Tarhouna response)
- resumed registration and assessment activities for housing rehab intervention targeting 160 families in urban areas in Benghazi and Ajdabia as well as 70 families in IDP settlements

CESVI

- Distributions activities are completed end of May
- Working now on assessing needs and identifying new families
- Distribution and outreach activities suspended for now due to COVID-19
- Case management and cash assistance still ongoing

Points of discussion / follow up needed

- Need to coordinate assistance and planned response vs risk of sharing beneficiaries' data and violating data protection rules. partners are highly encouraged to share planned and targeted geographical areas with the sector to facilitate coordination and reduce the risk of duplication of assistance.
- Stockpile reconciliation – only 3 partners have updated the stockpile sheet so far. A kind reminder to all partners to update the sheet if it's not done yet
- Complaint and Feedback to be presented by WFP in the next meeting
