<b>4</b>	<p><b>Naval academy eviction</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Around 600 families residing in AL Sayad settlement (Janzour Naval Academy) received an eviction notice to leave the academy by 20<sup>th</sup> May 2021.</li> <li>- According to reports from protection and SNFI actors, around 300 families are still in the academy as of April 21.</li> <li>- The eviction task force is currently prioritizing this eviction. HH level assessment will be carried out by Protection and SNFI sectors partners in the next 2 weeks</li> <li>- SNFI sector is mapping the capacity of partners to respond</li> </ul>	Refer to presentation for more details  <b>Partners are kindly requested to share details about their capacity to respond with the sector (if it hasn’t been shared already)</b>	
<b>5</b>	<p><b>Release from detention centers</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Potential release of 470 people from detention centers during the month of Ramadan (Abusliem, Al Bayda, Al kufra, Azzawya Abu Issa, Benghazi Ganfouda, Ghiryan Aburshada, Shahhat, Shara Zawya, Tobruk, Triq al Sika)</li> <li>- No details on the time and location of the release yet</li> <li>- Main needs include providing access to accommodation as well as NFI’s, dignity kits, hygiene kits and clothing items.</li> <li>- SNFI sector is mapping the capacity of partners to respond</li> </ul>	Refer to presentation for more details  <b>Partners are kindly requested to share details about their capacity to respond with the sector (if it hasn’t been shared already)</b>	
<b>6</b>	<p><b>Updates from Partners</b></p> <p><b>UNHCR</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Working on distributions in DC’s in the east. Yesterday there was a distribution in AL Kufra and Gamfouda DC’s</li> <li>- Regular distributions, had a meeting with Libaid. Distribution plan for all of Libya shall be shared soon</li> <li>- Planning a new round of HK distribution in the 8 IDP settlements in the east.</li> <li>- Shelter rehab of 95 HH in urban settings and IDP settlements through NRC (planned for 2021)</li> </ul>		



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Plans to rehabilitate infrastructure in Tripoli through NRC. Activities expected to start in May/June</li></ul> <p><b>DRC</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Start new grant under SDC targeting returnees and mixed migration in Tripoli.</li></ul> <p><b>CESVI</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- NFI distribution</li><li>- Winter clothing distribution on door2door basis</li></ul> <p><b>INTERSOS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Conducted a distribution of NFI's in April for 548 people in Sebha</li><li>- Distributed NFI's in 4 kits (home kit, sleeping mat cover sheet, kit for children, HK, people with special needs)</li></ul> <p><b>CEFA</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- No new activities to report in April 22, 2021</li><li>- Distribution of NFI's planned to start in June targeting 350 refugees, migrants and asylum seekers in Tripoli</li></ul> <p><b>NRC</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Distribution of NFI's to 1,700 individuals completed in Tarhouna</li><li>- Plans to rehabilitate 300 houses in Tripoli and 150 in Benghazi in 2020. Vulnerability assessments currently being carried out with works expected to start in June</li><li>- Plans to do 5-7 infrastructure projects in Tripoli in areas that have been damaged by the conflict mainly looking at power and water networks as well as health facilities in Abu Salim, Ain Zara and Gasr Ben Ghashir</li></ul>
