Returnees

► Background

UNHCR led an Inter-Agency Assessment mission to Sudanese refugee return areas in Kornoi locality from 9-16 December. The team visited eight villages and determined to assess the situation of the returnees and identify needs. Returnees cited improvements in the security situation and scaling back of services in Chad as their primary reasons for returning to Sudan. In the return areas, the mission identified the need for urgent assistance in terms of NFIs, water, food, health and education. Rehabilitation of water sources is particularly critical.

Following appropriate assessments by partner SAG, 3000 returnee households in Garajeem and Hilalia willages were assisted with ES/NFI kits village in North Darfur
