#### ► Background

Some 40 households were reported to be displaced to Shagara, Shangil Tobaya, Gouz Maraka and Abuzeriga IDP camps in EL Fasher, Dar ElSalalm, Mellit and Kalemendo localities respectively in North Darfur. This was due to the destruction of their shelters by fire. Some 36 households were verified during the reporting period and received ES/NFIs from the common pipeline through OXFAM, DDA and SAG.

## West Darfur

Displacement due to Conflict: None Reported

### Renewal Distributions:

#### ► Background

The UNHCR/ESNFI team in coordination with HAC and SRCS verified 520 extremely vulnerable IDPs in Jabal Moon Locality based on vulnerability assessment conducted in March 2016. Assistance was delayed due to a shortage of ES/NFIs as a result of UNHCR CP shipments being held at the Port, awaiting customs clearance. Once the warehouse in EI Geneina was replenished, ES/NFIs were provided from the Common pipeline, and distributed by SRCS based on the verifications conducted.
