Safety and Rules

Safety is paramount and everyone's responsibility. Anyone who observes an unsafe act or event, must/can call a "cease fire" (avbryt/stans skyting) at any time during the match.

- Treat all guns as if they are loaded
- Muzzle awareness is crucial. Keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction at all times. Either up or downrange.
- All movement with the rifle must be done with the bolt open
- Don't close the bolt until you're in position and have the rifle pointed towards the target
- If you are running a semi-auto, place the weapon on SAFE during transitions and say out loud "SAFE" before moving
- Keep your finger off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until you are ready to shoot
- We run a Cold Range, keep all rifles unloaded with the bolt open and chamber flag inserted until you're on the firing line and have been given the OK to load and make ready by the RO

You can touch all props during stage brief, but you cannot position your rifle or equipment on the props before your turn to shoot. There are no limitations in gear you can use during stage, but you need to start with everything at hand and up from the ground. All exercises start with magazine in, bolt in rear position, at marked position.

For match flow: Be ready with the rifle and equipment on the starting line as soon as the shooter before you is finished shooting. Please help picking brass unless the RO tells you otherwise on stage.

All stages are run as "Hit or miss", meaning that you shoot at the target with the intended rounds and move to next target or position.

Please verify target distances!

Stations 1-5 and approximate target map

Day 1

Station 1 - Stage 1

10 shots 105 seconds

Targets: E – 369m – Ø18
 R – 478m – 30x30, 20x20

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On the command, go to the first of **two prone positions**, and engage the targets with one shot each, in the following order:

Position 1: E, R (Large), R (small)

Position 2: R (small), R (Large), E

Position 1: E, R (Large), R (small), R (small)



Station 1 - Stage 2

10 shots 105 seconds

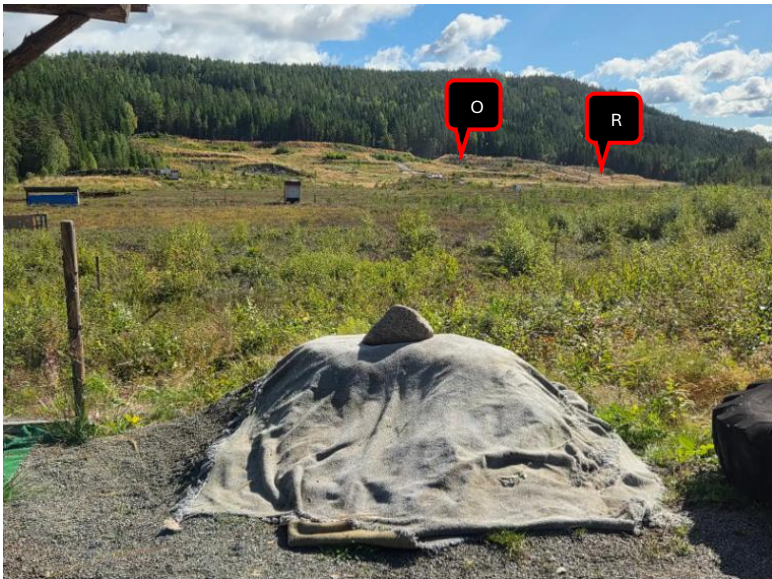
Targets: O – 490 m – 30x30, 25, 20, 15
 R – 478 m – 30x30, 20x20

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On the start command, go to the first of three positions, and engage each target with one shot in the following order:

Position 1: O – Large to small (4 shots/targets)

Position 2: R (Large), R (small)

Position 3: O – Large to small (4 shots/targets)



Station 2 - Stage 3

10 shots 105 seconds

Targets: A – 248m – 10x10
 H – 413m – Ø20, 15x15

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On the start command, go to 5 unique positions using both tank traps and engage the targets in the following order:

Position 1: H (large), H (small)

Position 2: A, A

Position 3: H (large), H (small)

Position 4: A, A

Position 5: H (large), H (small)



Station 2 - Stage 4

10 shots 105 seconds

Targets: C – 327m – TYL (8 targets)
 H – 413m – Ø20, 15x15

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On the start command, go to a prone position and engage the large and then the small target at H. Then proceed to target array C and engage each target with one shot.



Station 3 - Stage 5

10 shots 105 seconds

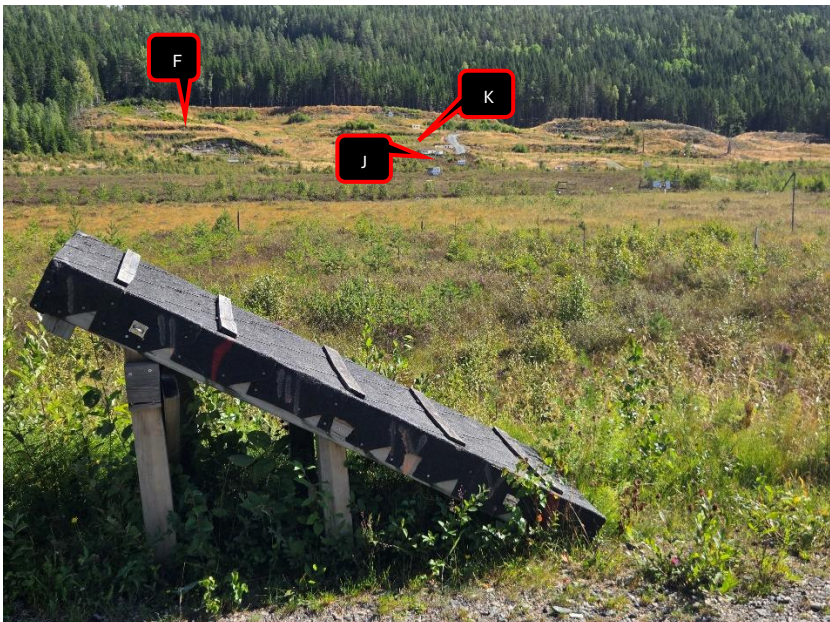
Targets: J – 292m - Squirrel
 F – 369m - Beaver
 K – 370m - Groundhog

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On the start command, the shooter will choose three unique positions on the barricade and engage the targets in the following order:

Position 1: J, F, K

Position 2: J, F, K

Position 3: J, F, K, K



Station 3 - Stage 6

10 shots 105 seconds

Targets: J – 292m - Squirrel
 K – 370m - Groundhog

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On command, shooter will go to 5 unique positions on the barricade. Engage targets from near to far with one shot each at every position.

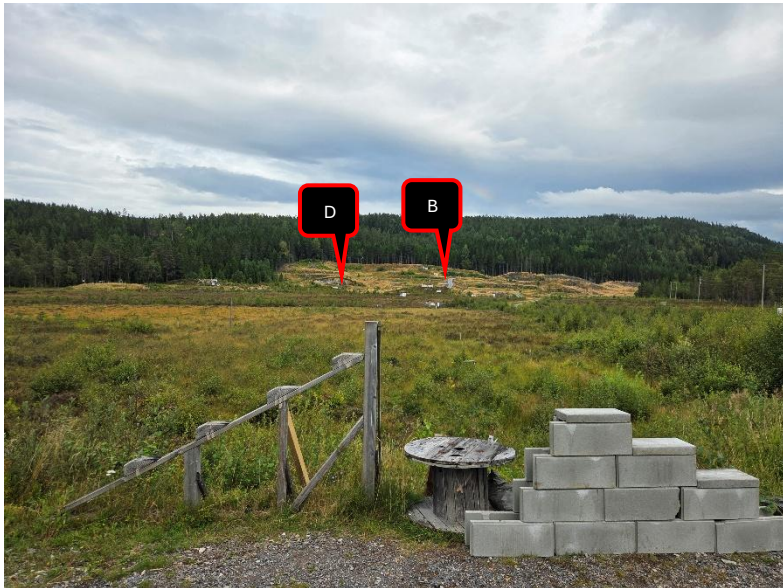


Station 4 - Stage 7

10 shots 105 seconds

Targets: D – 327m – 15x15
 B – 373m – Ø20

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On command, shooter will go to 4 unique positions on the barricade and engage target D and target B with one shot each. Finally, end the stage with two shots on target B from the blocks.



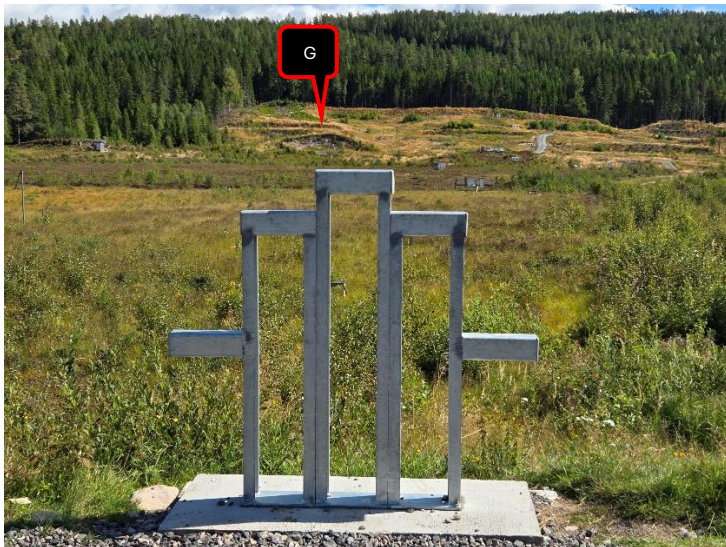
Station 4 - Stage 8

10 shots 105 seconds

Targets: G – 370m – Ø20, 15x15

Timed Tie-Breaker Stage

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On command, shooter will go to 4 positions on the barricade and engage the large and the small target with one shot each. After the 4th position and target engagement, the shooter will reuse one of the previously used positions for a 5th engagement.



Station 5 - Stage 9

10 shots 105 seconds

Targets: P – 336m – 20x20
 M – 411m – 30x30, 20x20

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On command, shooter will go to the given positions and engage the targets in the following order:

Position 1: M (large), M (small) – Two shots on each

Position 2: P, M (large), M (small) – 1 shot on each

Position 3: P, M (large), M (small) – 1 shot on each



Station 5 - Stage 10

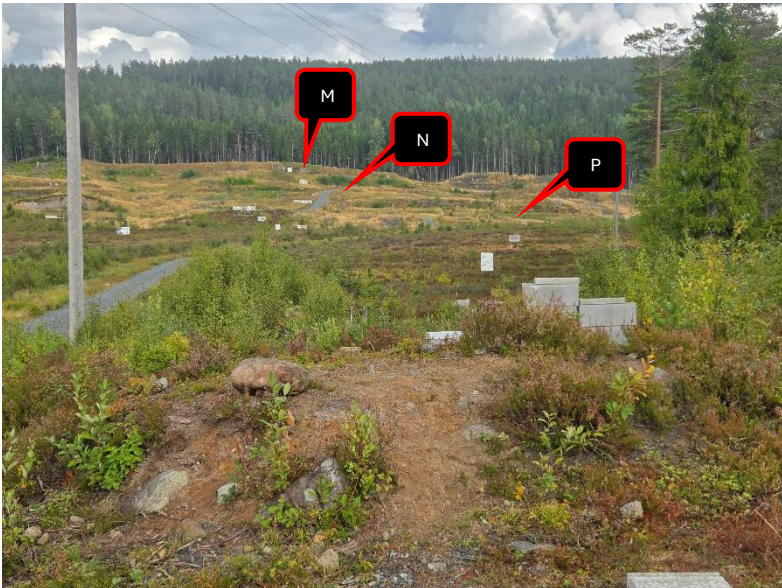
10 shots 105 seconds

Targets: P – 336m – 20x20
 N – 400m – Ø20
 M – 411m – 30x30, 20x20

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On command, shooter will go to the given positions and engage the targets in the following order:

Position 1: P, N, N, M (large), M (small)

Position 2: P, N, N, M (large), M (small)



Day 2

Station 1 - Stage 11

12 shots 120 seconds

Targets: E – 369m – Ø15
 O – 490 m – 25, 20, 15x15
 R – 478m – 30x30, 20x20

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On the start command, go to the first of three positions, and engage each target with one shot in the following order:

Position 1: E
 O2, O3, O4 – the three smallest targets
 R (Large), R (small)

Position 2: E
 O2, O3, O4 – the three smallest targets
 R (Large), R (small)



Station 2 - Stage 12

12 shots 120 seconds

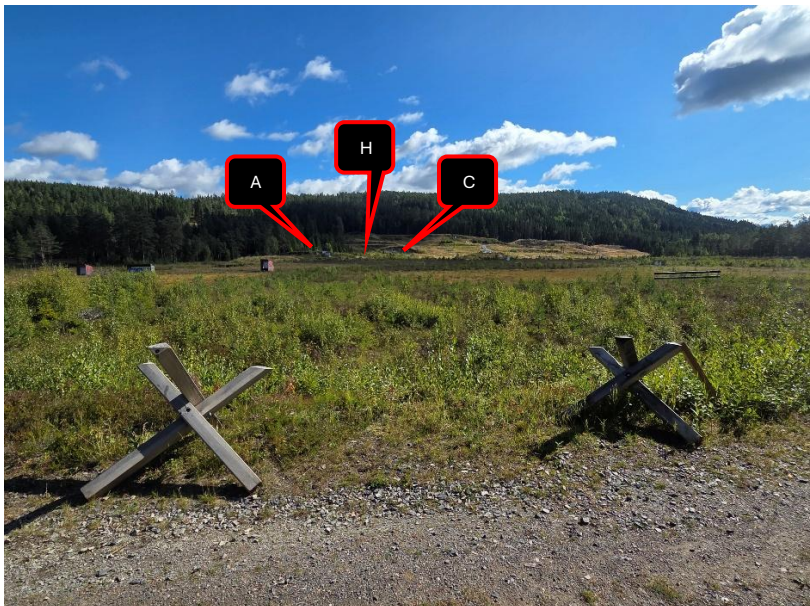
Targets: A – 248m – 10x10
 C – 327m – TYL (8 targets)
 H – 413m – Ø20, 15x15

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On command, the shooter will enter the following positions and engage the targets accordingly with one shot each:

Tank Trap 1: A, H (large), H (small)

Prone: C2, C3, C4, C5 – Targets 2 to 5 from the left

Tank Trap 2: A, H (large), H (small)



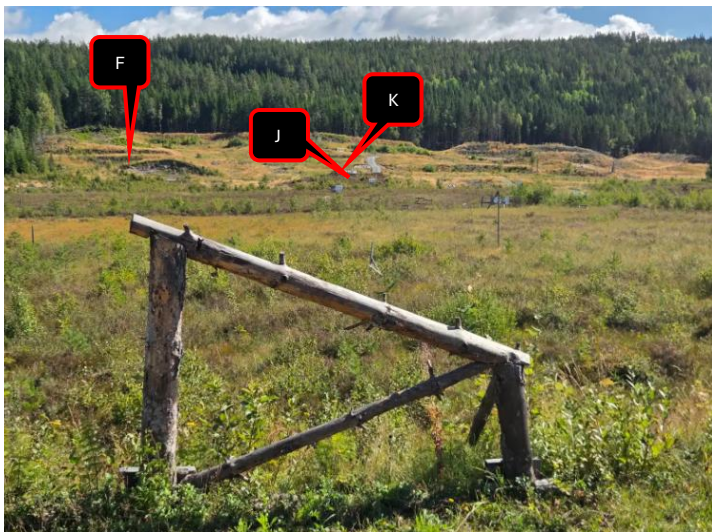
Station 3 - Stage 13

12 shots 120 seconds

Targets: J – 292m - Squirrel
 F – 369m - Beaver
 K – 370m - Groundhog

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On command, shooter will go to 6 unique positions on the barricade and engage the targets in the following order with two shots each.

Position 1: J
Position 2: K
Position 3: K
Position 4: F
Position 5: F
Position 6: J



Station 4 - Stage 14

12 shots 120 seconds

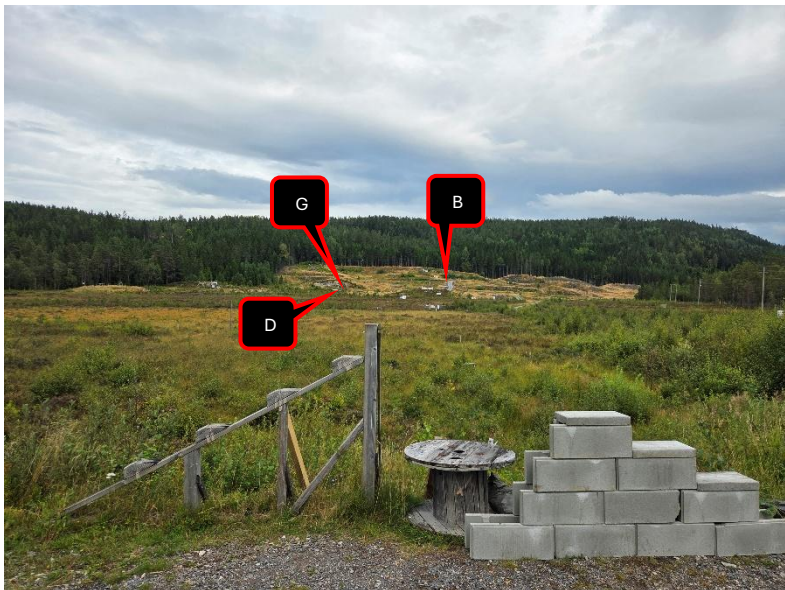
Targets: D – 327m – 15x15
 G – 370m – Ø20, 15x15
 B – 373m – Ø20

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On command, shooter will engage the following targets with one shot each from the given positions

Position 1: D, G (large), G (small), B

Position 2: B, G (small), G (large), D

Position 3: D, G (large), G (small), B



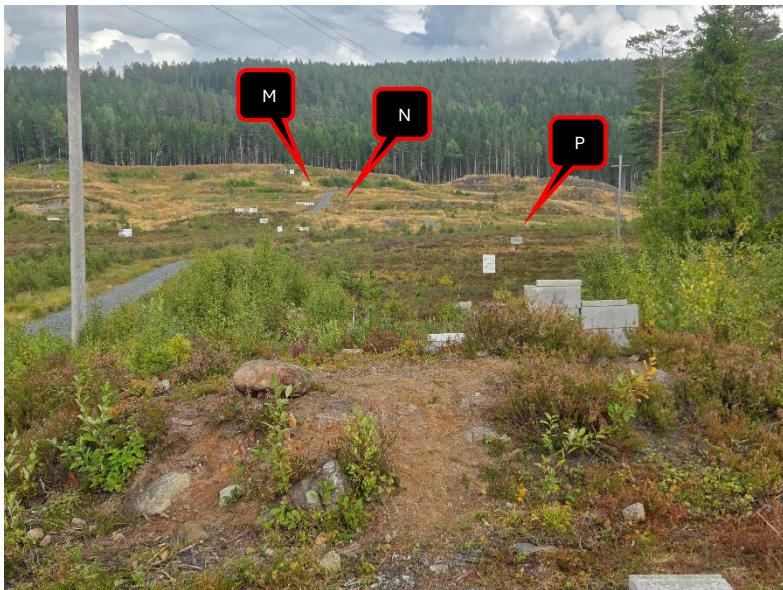
Station 5 - Stage 15

12 shots 120 seconds

Targets: P – 336m – 20x20
 N – 400m – Ø20
 M – 411m – 30x30, 20x20

Shooter will start standing, mag in and bolt back. On command, shooter will go to the given positions and engage the targets in the following order:

Position 1: P, N, M (large), M (small)
Position 2: M (large), M (small)
Position 3: M (large), M (small)
Position 4: P, N, M (large), M (small)
