

PRS Finale Norway

Safety and Rules:

Safety is paramount and everyone's responsibility. Anyone who observes an unsafe act or event, must/can call a "cease fire" (avbryt/stans skyting) at any time during the course of a match.

- 1. Treat all guns as if they are loaded
- 2. Muzzle awareness is crucial. Keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction at all time, either up, towards the firing line or in the safezone on each station
- 3. All movement with the rifle must be done with the bolt open
- **4.** Don't close the bolt until you're in position and the have the rifle pointed towards the target
- **5.** If you are running a semi-auto, place the weapon on SAFE during transitions and say out loud "SAFE" before moving
- **6.** Keep your finger off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until you are ready to shoot
- 7. The chamber flag is mandatory and must be in the camber until the RO tells you to remove it

- **8.** Cheating equals match DQ
- Unsportsmanlike conduct may result in a warning, a stage DQ or match DQ. The assessment is up to the RO and/or the MD and not up for discussion

Equipment/behavior:

Binoculars, spotting scopes and range finders can be used at all times.

It's allowed to start the stage with tripods deployed.

For match flow: Be ready with the rifle and equipment on the starting line as soon as the shooter before you is finished shooting. Please help out picking brass unless the RO tells you otherwise on stage.

All targets beyond 600m will be equipped with T1000 hit indicators.

"Hit to move" means = You must hit the first target before you move on to the next target. If you miss the first shot on the first target, you shall fire the second shot at same target until you hit.

If you have concerns regarding other shooters behavior, bring this up with the RO/MD as soon as possible. Not after the price ceremony..

All RO's will be equipped with a shot timer from Shooters Global sponsored by Brownells.


There will be food available at the clubhouse for purchase. Toilets can also be found here. Price ceremony and match brief is at the clubhouse.

DAY 1:

Station 1 - Stage 1: Ammoboxes

Number of rounds: 10 Range: 211m - 301m Time: 1:40 min Targets: 2 targets:

A: Ø10cm – 211m (0,47mil) – right targets are spare targets B: Ø20cm – 301m (0,66mil) – right target is a spare target

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage the targets near to far from prone position. After two shots prone, move one ammobox to the marked position and engage the targets near to far from the top of the ammobox. Rifle must be leaning on the ammobox. Repeat this process, building 4 ammoboxes on top of each other with two shots from each box.

Station 1 - Stage 2: Skillstage 2

Number of rounds: 8

Range: 301m Time: 1:30 min Targets: 1 target:

B: ø20cm – 301m (0,66mil) – right target is a spare target

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage the target with two shots from each of the four positions on the barricade. This is a tiebrake stage.



Station 2 – Stage 3: Tanktrap in the horizon

Number of rounds: 12 Range: 296m - 333m Time: 2:00 min

Targets: 2 targets:

C: Ø20cm – 296m (0,67mil) D: Ø25cm – 333m (0,75mil)

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage target C with two shots and then target D with two shots from 3 of the 4 positions on the tanktrap. Hit or miss.

Station 2 - Stage 4: Bench

Number of rounds: 9 Range: 296m - 392m Time: 1:30 min Targets: 3 targets:


C: Ø20cm - 296m (0,67mil) D: Ø25cm - 333m (0,75mil) E: Ø25cm - 392m (0,64mil)

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage the targets in the order C, D and E with one shot each (hit or miss) from 3 marked positions on the bench.







Station 3 - Stage 5: Antlers

Number of rounds: 10

Range: 358m Time: 1:40 min Targets: 1 target:

F: 20cm x 20cm - 358m (0,56mil)

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage the target with two rounds from 5 different positions on the antlers. Move to the next position after two shots are fired. Hit or miss

Station 3 - Stage 6: Fox hunt trail

Number of rounds: 12 Range: 337m - 520m Time: 2:30 min Targets: 2 targets:

G: Fox 40cm x 25cm - 356m - 337m H: Fox 40cm x 25cm - 520m - 502m

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage the fox targets with one shot each from near to far from 6 different marked positions. Hit or miss



Station 4 - Stage 7: Two magazines

Number of rounds: 12 Range: 349m - 511m

Time: 2:00 min Targets: 3 targets:

I: 20cm x 20cm - 359m - 349m (0,57 - 0,56mil) J: 25cm x 25cm - 408m - 398m (0,61 - 0,63mil) K: 30cm x 30cm - 511m - 501m (0,59 - 0,60mil)

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage two shots on each target from near to far on the two boulders. Shooter must do a mandatory magazine change between the two boulders.

Station 4 - Stage 8: Timber

Number of rounds: 12 Range: 353m - 505m Time: 1:40 min

Targets: 3 targets:


I: 20cm x 20cm - 353 (0,57mil) J: 25cm x 25cm - 402m (0,62mil) K: 30cm x 30cm - 505m (0,59mil)

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage the targets, near to far from 4 different positions. Hit or miss.







Station 5 – Stage 9: Troopline

Number of rounds: 14 Range: 167m - 796m

Time: 2:00 min Targets: 8 targets:

1: 10cm x 10cm - 167m (0,60mil) - right target is a spare target

2: Ø15cm - 225m (0,67mil) – right target is a spare target

3: 35cm x 35cm - 535m (0,65mil) 4: 35cm x 35cm - 627m (0,56mil) 5: 35cm x 35cm - 644m (0,54mil)

6: Hog: 50cm x 30cm - 709m (0,70mil x 0,42mil) 7: Hog 50cm x 30cm - 767m (0,65mil x 0,39mil) 8: Wolf 60cm x 40cm - 796m (0,75mil x 0,50mil)

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage targets near to far with one shot on target 1 and 2, then two shots on the rest. Hit or miss

Station 5 – Stage 10: Far to Near

Number of rounds: 12 Range: 167m - 709m

Time: 1:45 min **Targets**: 6 targets:

1: 10cm x 10cm - 167m (0,60mil) - right target is a spare target

2: Ø15cm - 225m (0,67mil) - right target is a spare target

3: 35cm x 35cm - 535m (0,65mil) 4: 35cm x 35cm - 627m (0,56mil) 5: 35cm x 35cm - 644m (0,54mil)

6: Hog: 50cm x 30cm – 709m (0,70mil x 0,42mil)

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage the targets 6, 5, 4 and 3 (far to near) with two shots each from the boulder. Move forward to the next position and engage targets 2 and 1 (far to near) with two rounds each. Hit or miss.

Station 1 – Stage 11: Tables and chairs

Number of rounds: 10 Range: 211m - 301m Time: 1:45 min

Targets: 2 targets:

A: Ø10cm – 211m (0,47mil) – right targets are spare targets B: Ø20cm – 301m (0,66mil) – right target is a spare target

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage the targets near to far from each of the 5 given positions.

Station 2 - Stage 12: Javelin

Number of rounds: 9 Range: 296m - 392m Time: 1:45 min Targets: 3 targets:


C: Ø20cm – 296m (0,67mil) D: Ø25cm – 333m (0,75mil) E: Ø25cm – 392m (0,64mil)

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage targets in order C, D, E, D, E, C, E, C and D with one shot each from the Javelin case. Hit or miss.







Station 3 - Stage 13: KYL

Number of rounds: 12

Range: 495m Time: 2:00 min Targets: 6 targets:

L: 30cm x 30cm - 495m (0,61mil) L: 25cm x 25cm - 495m (0,51mil) L: 20cm x 20cm - 495m (0,40mil) L: 18cm x 18cm - 495m (0,36mil) L: 15cm x 15cm - 495m (0,30mil) L: 10cm x 10cm - 495m (0,20mil)

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage the targets with two shots each from left to right. Hit or miss.

Station 4 - Stage 14: Rock trail

Number of rounds: 12 Range: 356m - 498m

Time: 2:00 min **Targets**: 2 targets:

I: 20cm x 20cm - 359m (0,56mil)
I: 15cm x 15cm - 356m (0,42mil)
J: 25cm x 25cm - 406m (0,62mil)
J: 20cm x 20cm - 403m (0,49mil)
K: 30cm x 30cm - 498m (0,60mil)
K: 25cm x 25cm - 498m (0,50mil)

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage the targets with two rounds on each of the 5 positions. On the first position engage the large target on I. Second position, engage small target on I. Third position engage large target on J. Fourth position engage small target on J. Fifth and final position engage two shots on the large target on K and two shots on the small target on K.



Station 5 - Stage 15: Bear with me

Number of rounds: 12 Range: 167m - 709m

Time: 2:00 min Targets: 6 targets:

1: 10cm x 10cm - 167m (0,60mil) - right target is a spare target

2: Ø15cm - 225m (0,67mil) – right target is a spare target

3: 35cm x 35cm - 535m (0,65mil) 4: 35cm x 35cm - 627m (0,56mil) 5: 35cm x 35cm - 644m (0,54mil)

6: Hog: 50cm x 30cm - 709m (0,70mil x 0,42mil)

Course of fire:

Shooters will start standing with the rifle in hand, bolt open. At the timer beep, engage the targets in the following order: 1,6,2,5,3,4,4,3,5,2,6,1 with one hit each.
