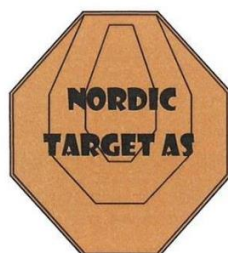

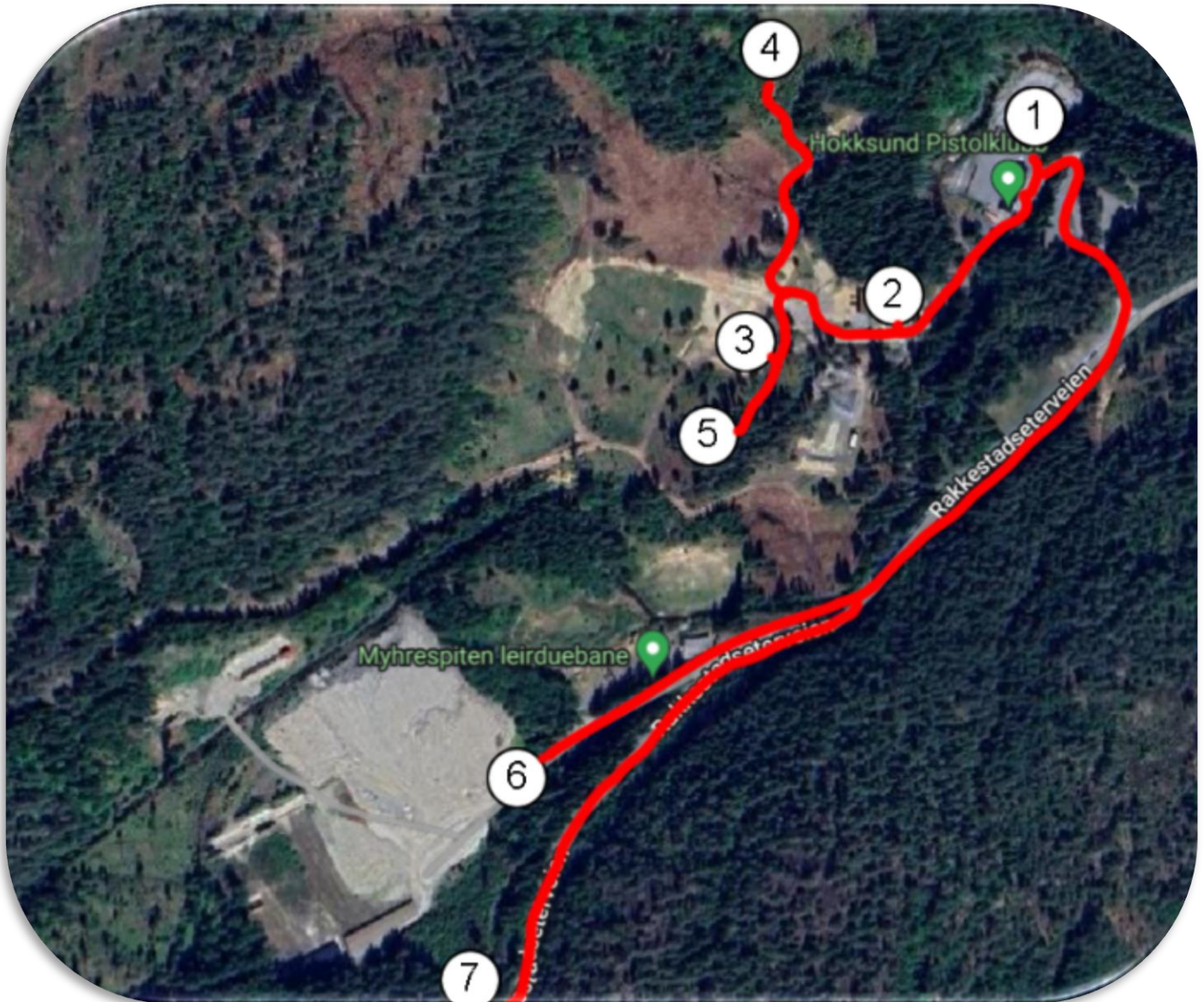
## Directions

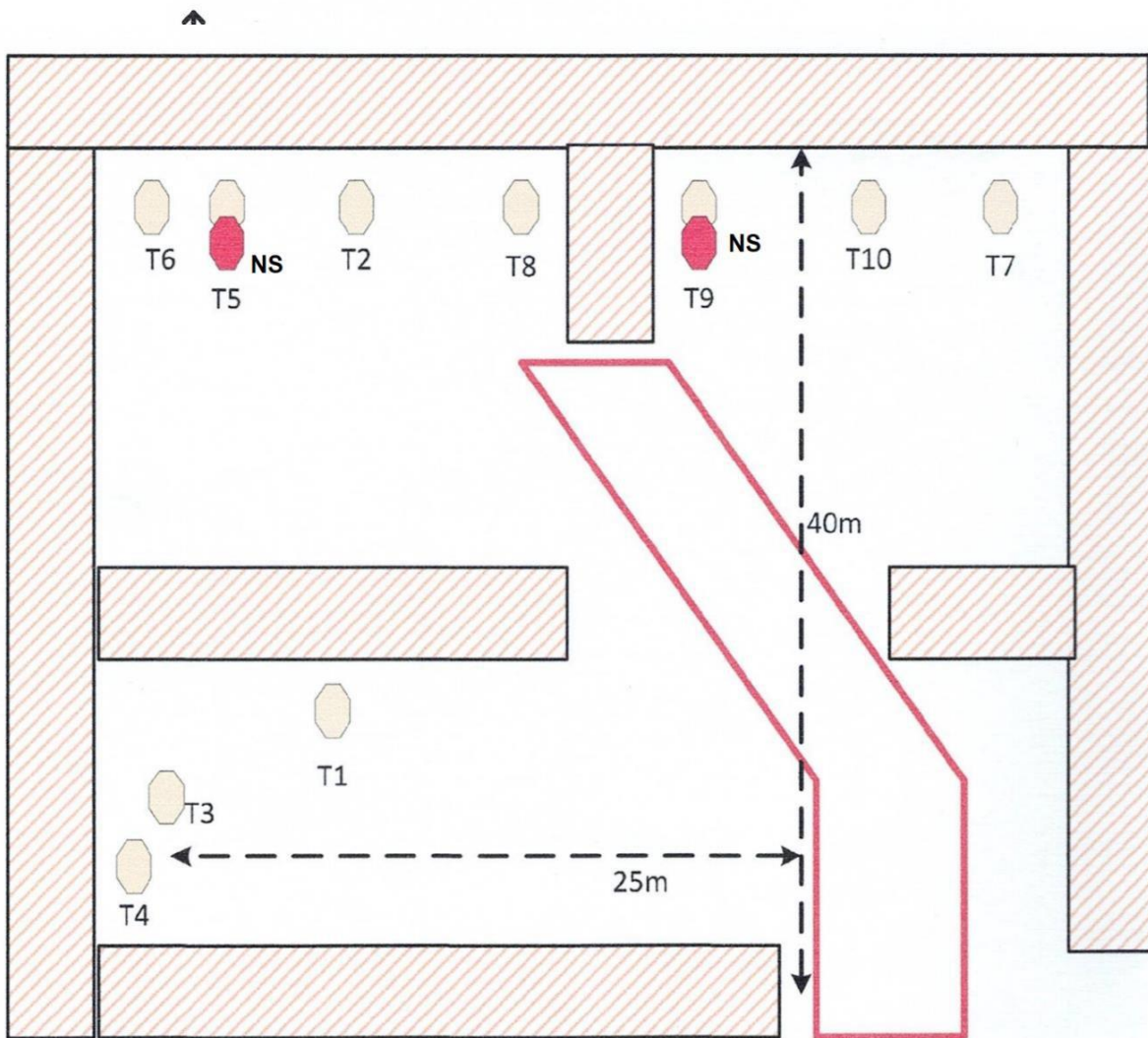

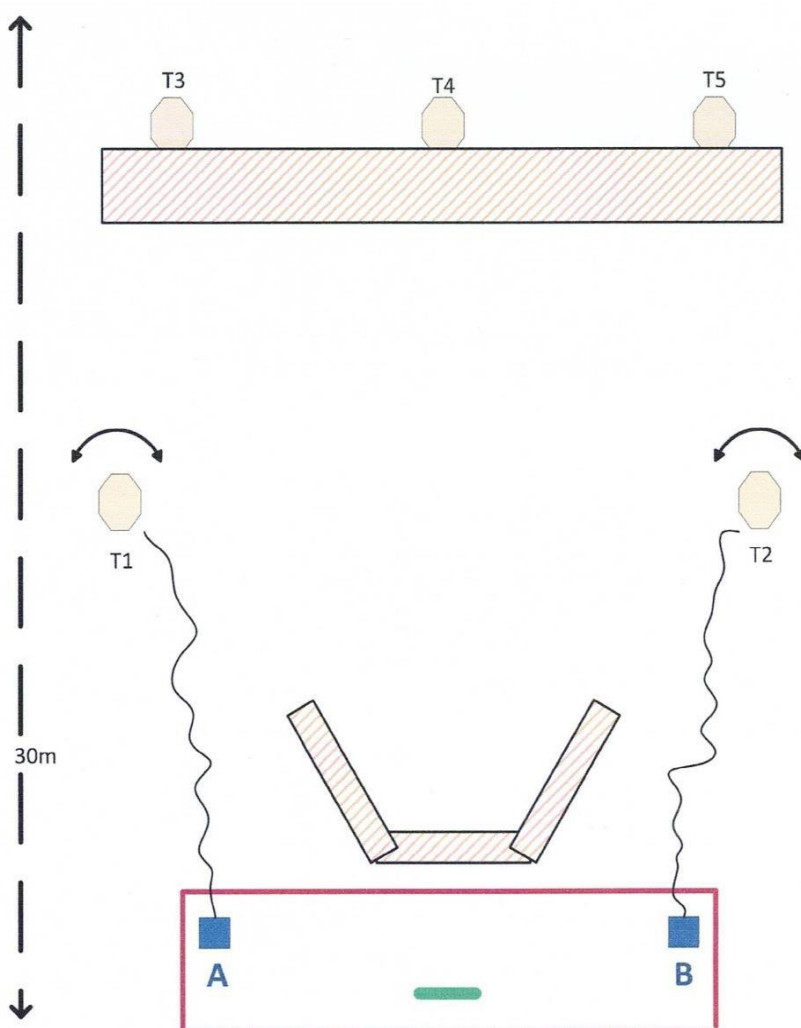

<b>Type of course</b>	Medium course
<b>Minimum rounds</b>	20, MAB 10
<b>Time starts</b>	On audible signal
<b>Targets</b>	10 IPSC paper targets and 2 no shoot targets
<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle in ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange and with the finger outside the trigger guard. (See Appendix E1)
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 1): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber loaded, hammer and/or sear cocked, and safety catch applied (if rifle is designed to have one)
<b>Distance</b>	5 - 40 m
<b>Safety angles</b>	Indicated with red sticks



## Stage 2 Hokksund

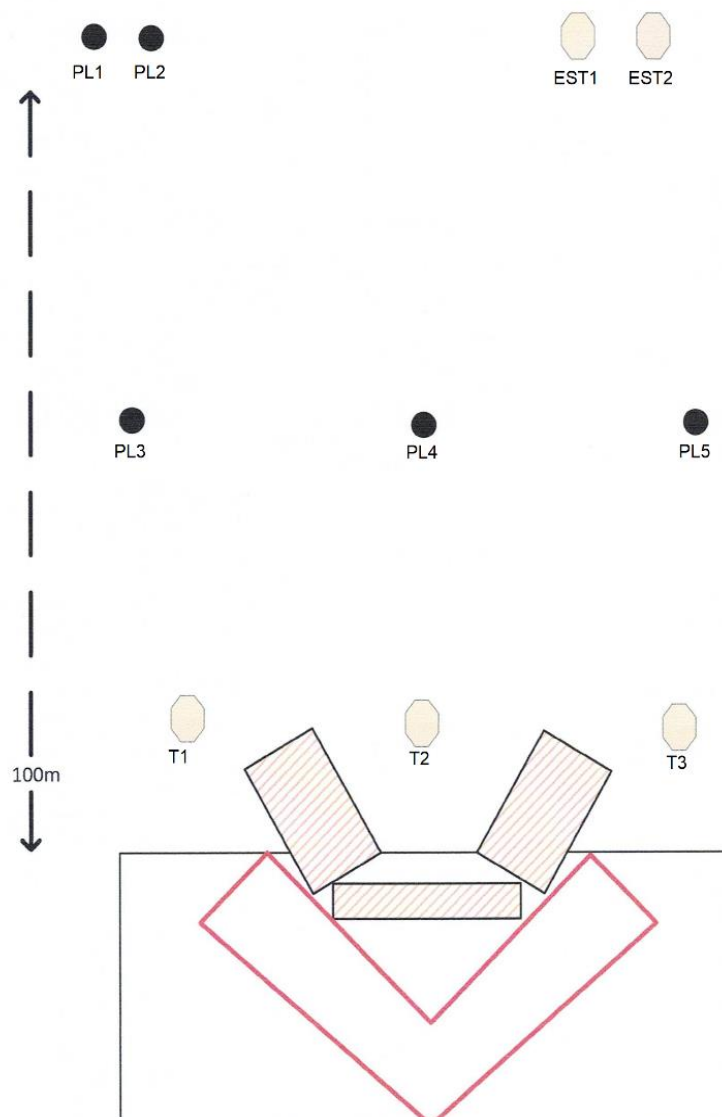
<b>Type of course</b>	Short course
<b>Minimum rounds</b>	10, MAB 5
<b>Time starts</b>	On audible signal
<b>Targets</b>	5 IPSC paper targets
<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle in ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange and with the finger outside the trigger guard. (See Appendix E1) Feet on mark as demonstrated
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets. Pulling rope A will release moving target T1, pulling rope B will release moving target T2. Moving targets are visible at rest
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 1): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber loaded, hammer and/or sear cocked and safety catch applied (if rifle is designed to have one)
<b>Distance</b>	20 - 30 m
<b>Safety angle</b>	Indicated with red sticks





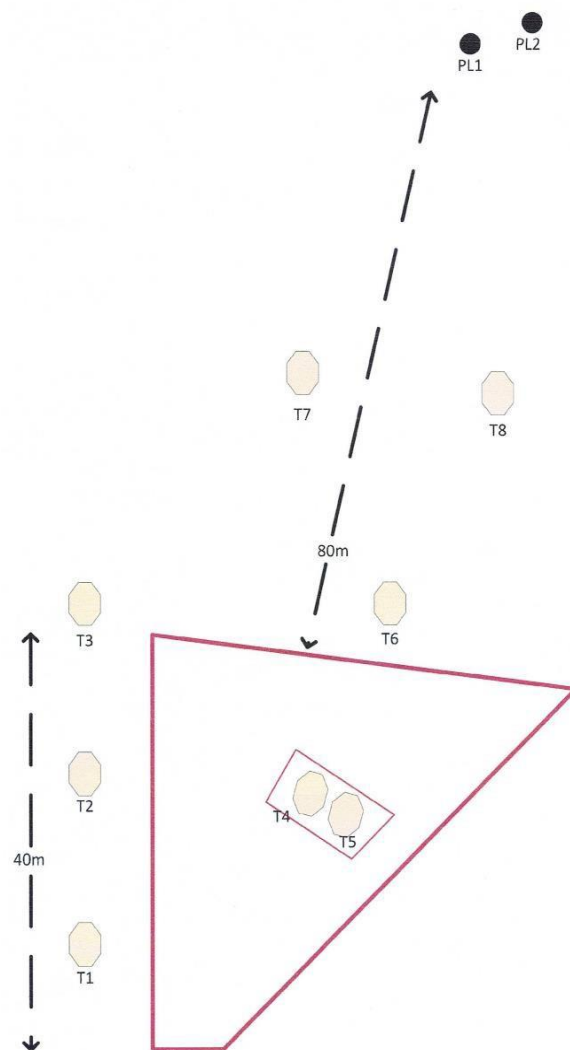

<b>Type of course</b>	Medium course
<b>Minimum rounds</b>	15, MAB 10
<b>Time starts</b>	On audible signal
<b>Targets</b>	2 IPSC Electronic Scoring Targets, 3 IPSC paper targets, 5 IPSC plates
<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle in ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange and with the finger outside the trigger guard. (See Appendix E1)
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets.
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 1): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber loaded, hammer and/or sear cocked and safety catch applied (if rifle is designed to have one)
<b>Distance</b>	10 - 100 m
<b>Safety angles</b>	Indicated with red sticks

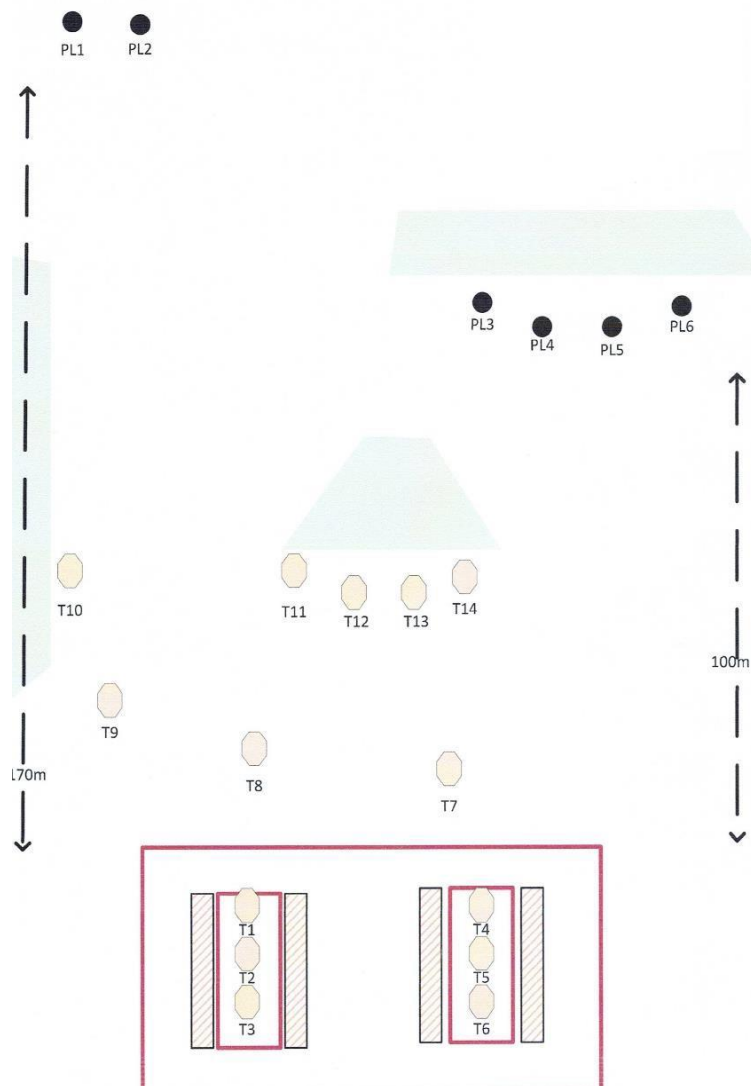

<b>Time starts</b>	On audible signal
<b>Targets</b>	8 IPSC paper targets, 2 IPSC plates
<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle in ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange and with the finger outside the trigger guard. (See Appendix E1)
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets.
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 1): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber loaded, hammer and/or sear cocked, and safety catch applied (if rifle is designed to have one)
<b>Distance</b>	5 - 80 m
<b>Safety angles</b>	Indicated with red sticks





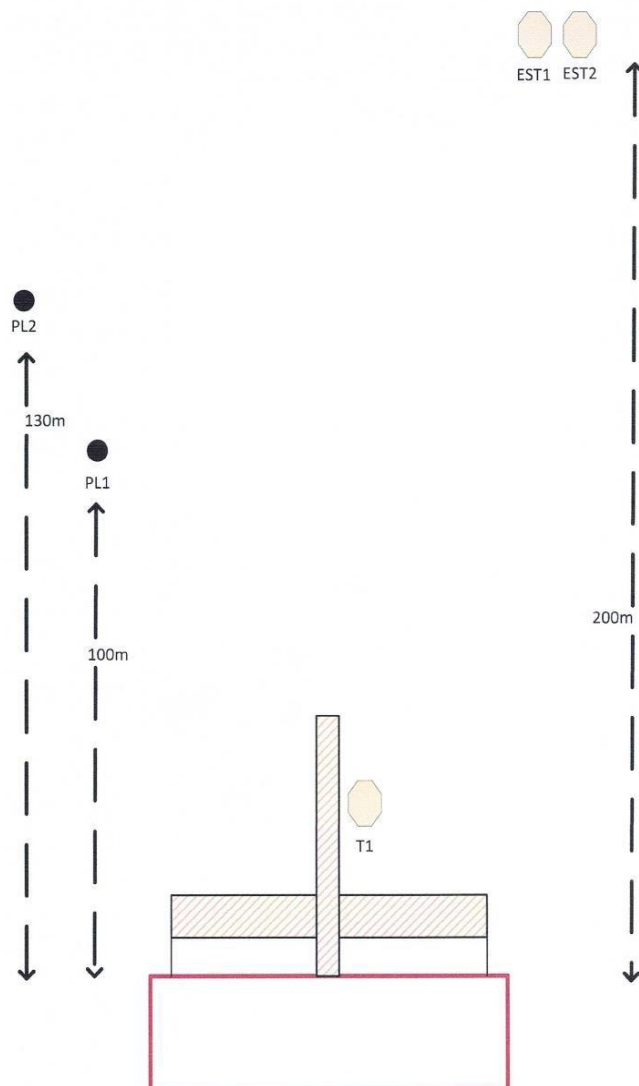

<b>Time starts</b>	On audible signal
<b>Targets</b>	14 IPSC paper targets, 6 IPSC plates
<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle in ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange and with the finger outside the trigger guard. (See Appendix E1)
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets.
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 1): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber loaded, hammer and/or sear cocked, and safety catch applied (if rifle is designed to have one)
<b>Distance</b>	1 - 170 m
<b>Safety angles</b>	Indicated with red sticks



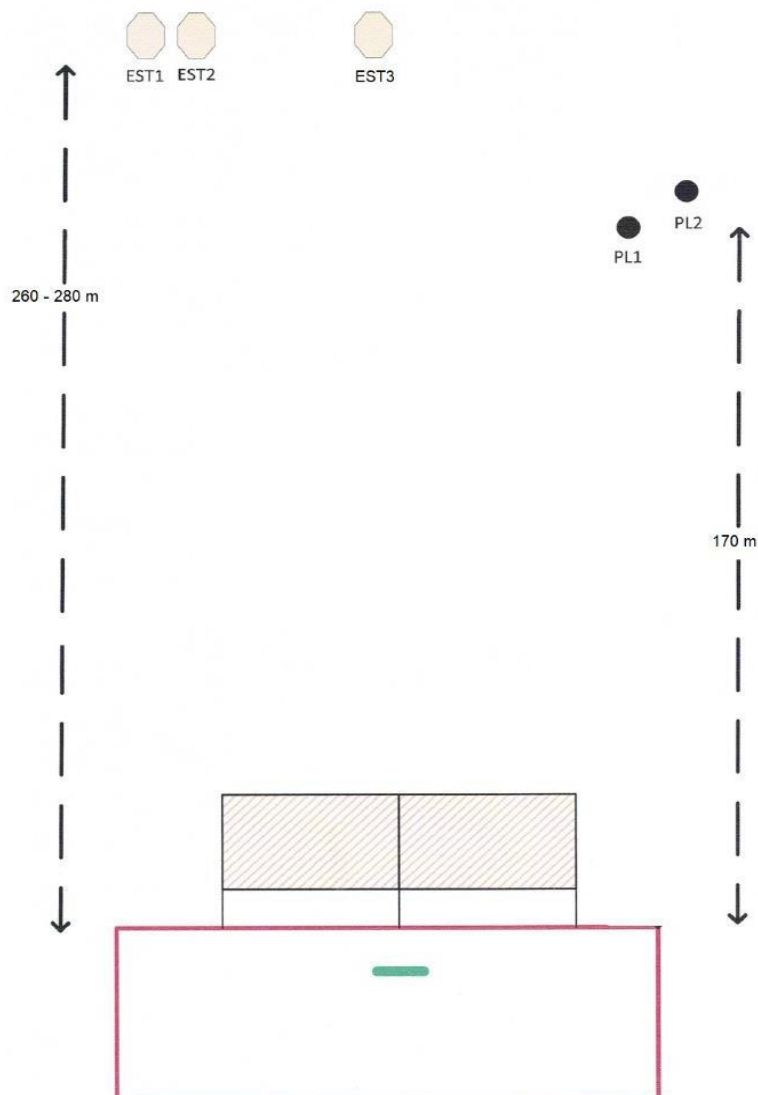

<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle in ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange and with the finger outside the trigger guard. (See Appendix E1)
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets.
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 1): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber loaded, hammer and/or sear cocked and safety catch applied (if rifle is designed to have one)
<b>Distance</b>	10 - 200 m
<b>Safety angles</b>	Indicated with red sticks



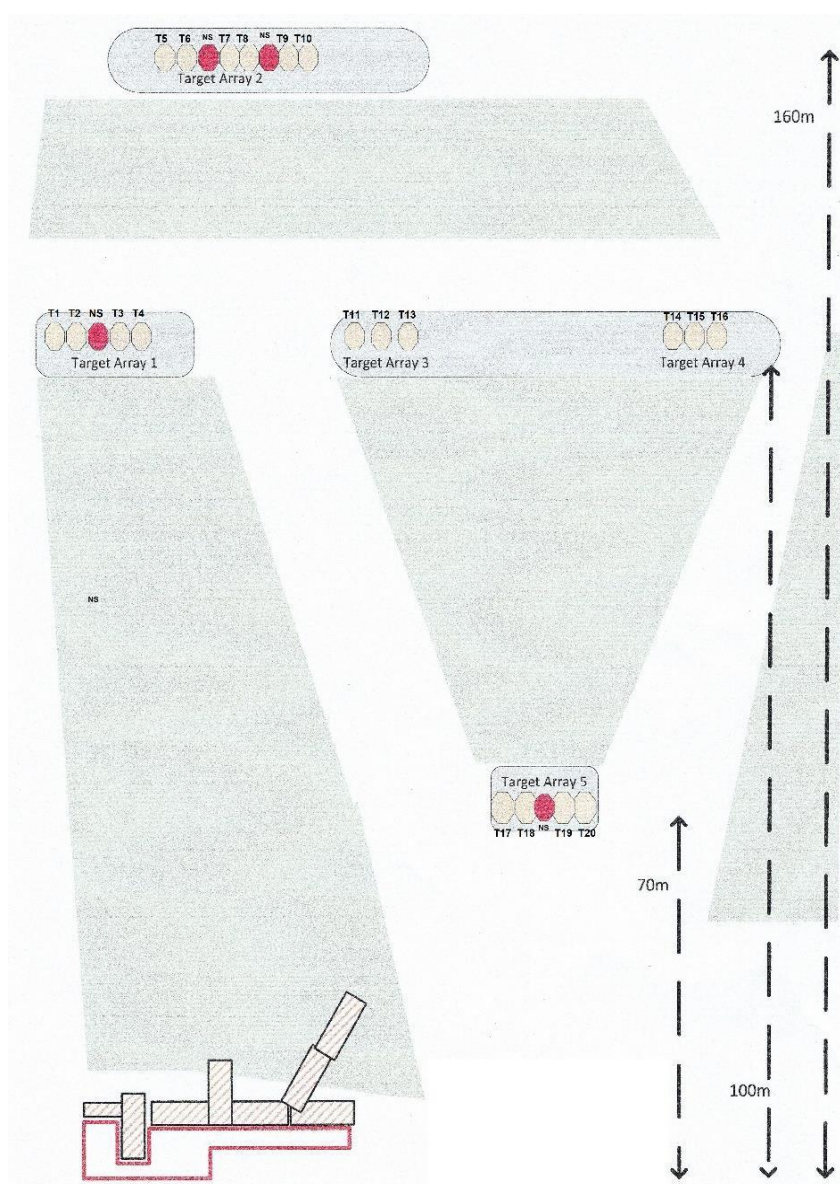

<b>Targets</b>	3 IPSC electronic scoring targets, 2 IPSC plates
<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle in ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange and with the finger outside the trigger guard. (See Appendix E1) Feet touching mark
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets.
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 1): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber loaded, hammer and/or sear cocked and safety catch applied (if rifle is designed to have one)
<b>Distance</b>	160 - 280 m
<b>Safety angles</b>	Indicated with red sticks

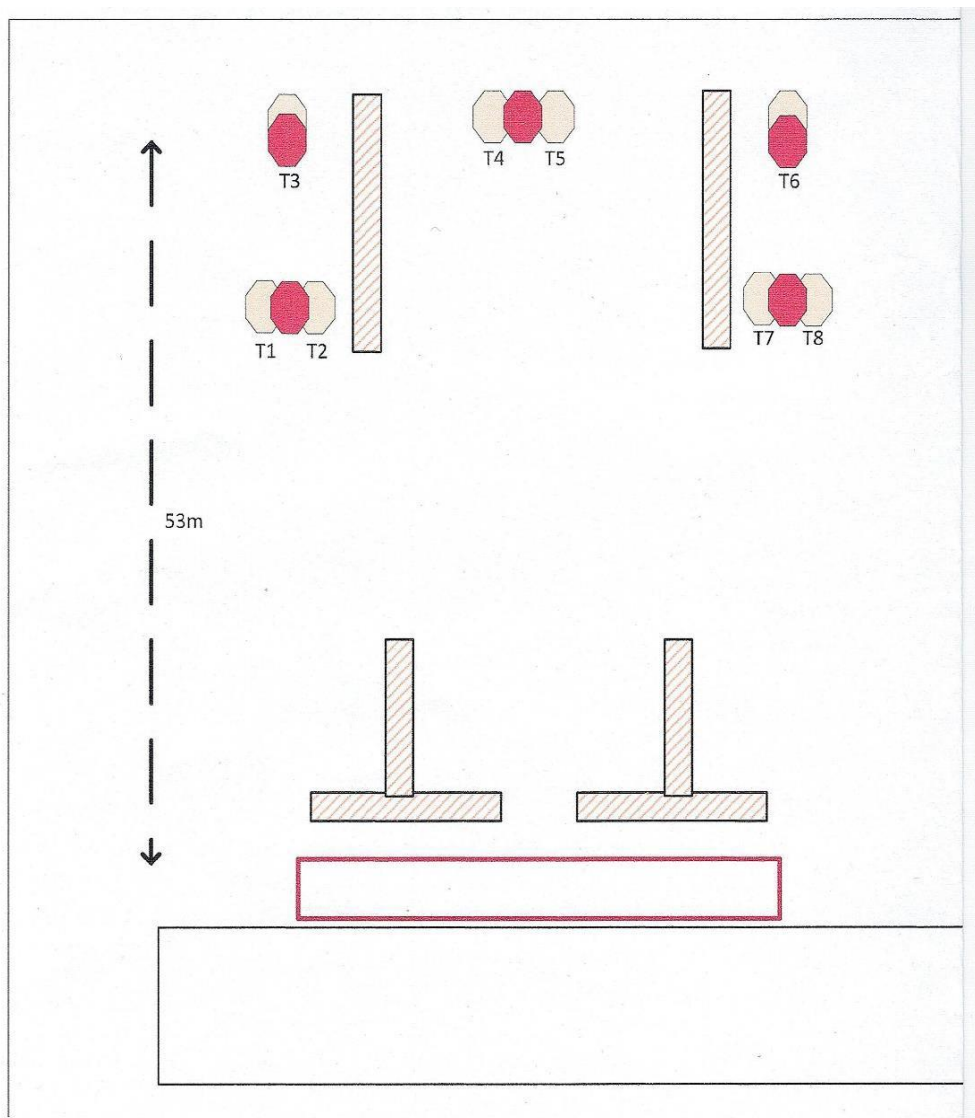

<b>Minimum rounds</b>	40, MAB 20
<b>Time starts</b>	On audible signal
<b>Targets</b>	20 IPSC paper targets, 4 no shoot target
<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle in ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange and with the finger outside the trigger guard. (See Appendix E1)
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets.
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 1): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber loaded, hammer and/or sear cocked, and safety catch applied (if rifle is designed to have one)
<b>Distance</b>	70 - 160 m
<b>Safety angles</b>	Indicated with red sticks





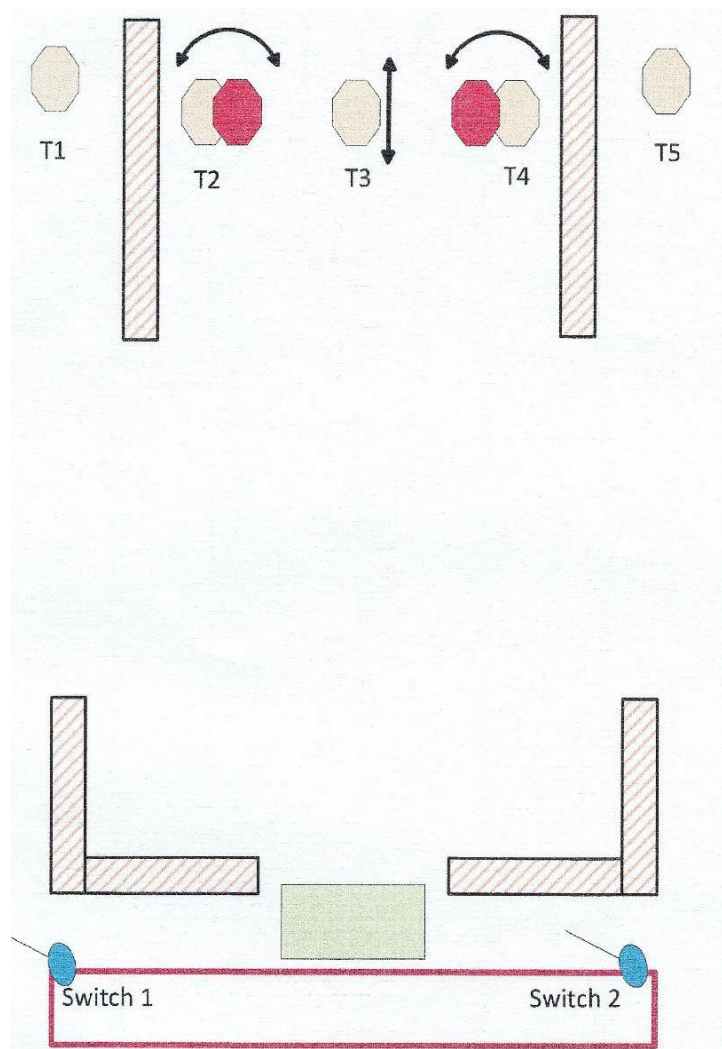

<b>Time starts</b>	On audible signal
<b>Targets</b>	8 IPSC paper mini targets, 5 no shoot target
<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle in ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange and with the finger outside the trigger guard. (See Appendix E1)
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets.
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 1): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber loaded, hammer and/or sear cocked, and safety catch applied (if rifle is designed to have one)
<b>Distance</b>	49 - 53 m
<b>Safety angles</b>	Indicated with red sticks



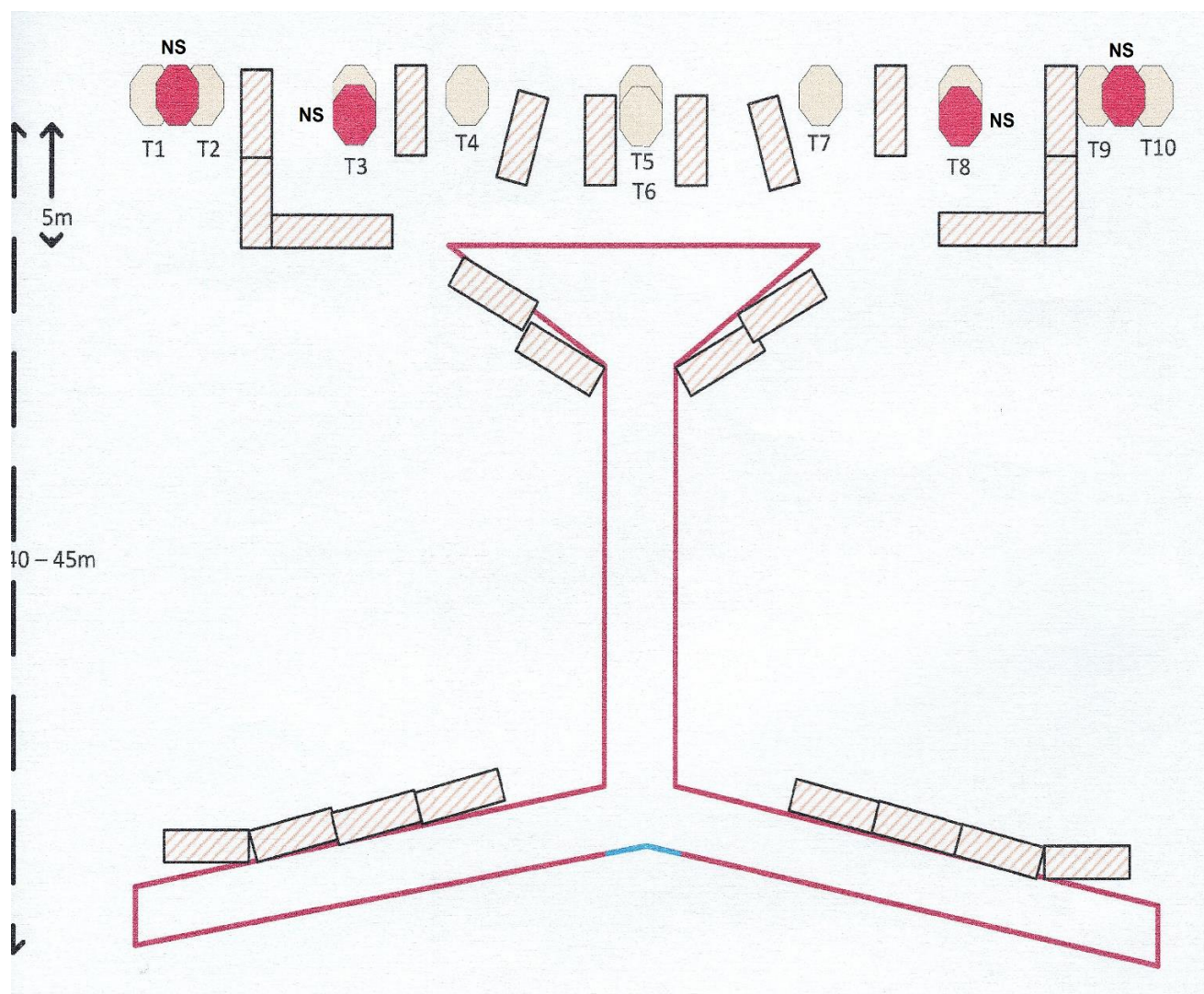
## Stage 10 - Bane 5 - Ringerike

<b>Type of course</b>	Short course
<b>Minimum rounds</b>	10, MAB 5
<b>Time starts</b>	On audible signal
<b>Targets</b>	5 IPSC paper mini targets, 2 no shoot target
<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle lying flat on mark on table.
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets. Pressing switch 1 to OFF, will activate moving target T2 and T3. Pressing switch 2 to OFF, will activate moving target T4. Moving targets will be visible at rest
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 2): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber empty and action closed
<b>Distance</b>	49 - 53 m
<b>Safety angles</b>	Indicated with red sticks



## Stage 11 - Bane 6 - Ringerike

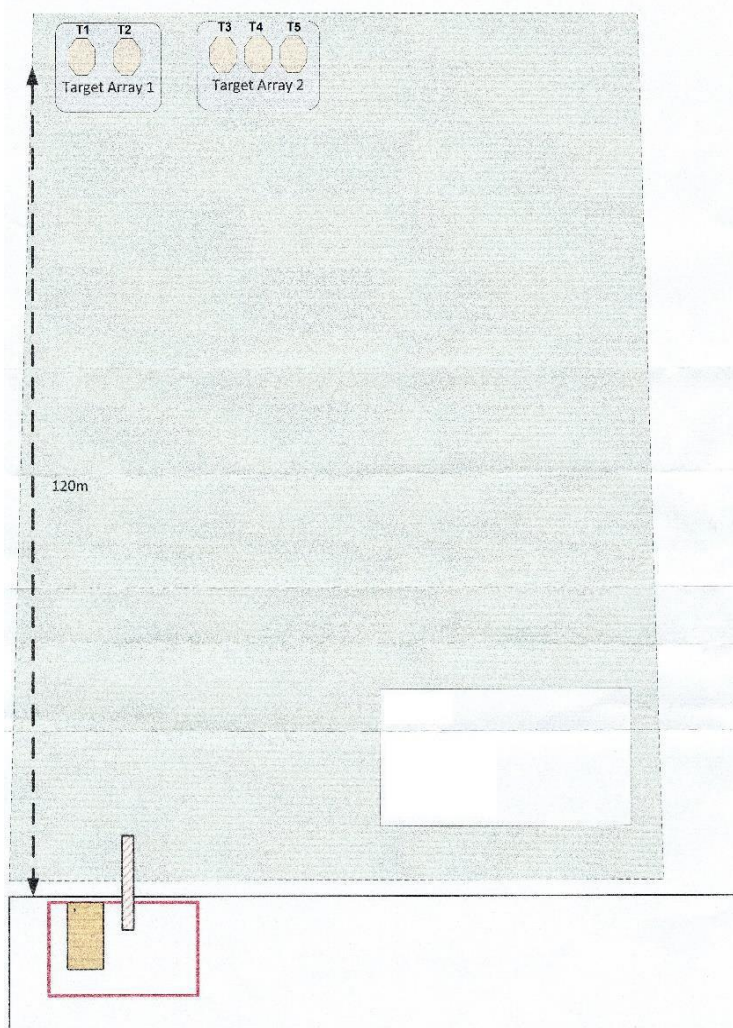
<b>Type of course</b>	Medium course
<b>Minimum rounds</b>	20, MAB 10
<b>Time starts</b>	On audible signal
<b>Targets</b>	10 IPSC paper mini targets, 4 no shoot target
<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle in ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange and with the finger outside the trigger guard. (See Appendix E1) Heels touching mark.
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets.
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 2): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber empty and action closed
<b>Distance</b>	5 - 45 m
<b>Safety angles</b>	Indicated with red sticks





## Stage 12 - Bane 9 - Ringerike

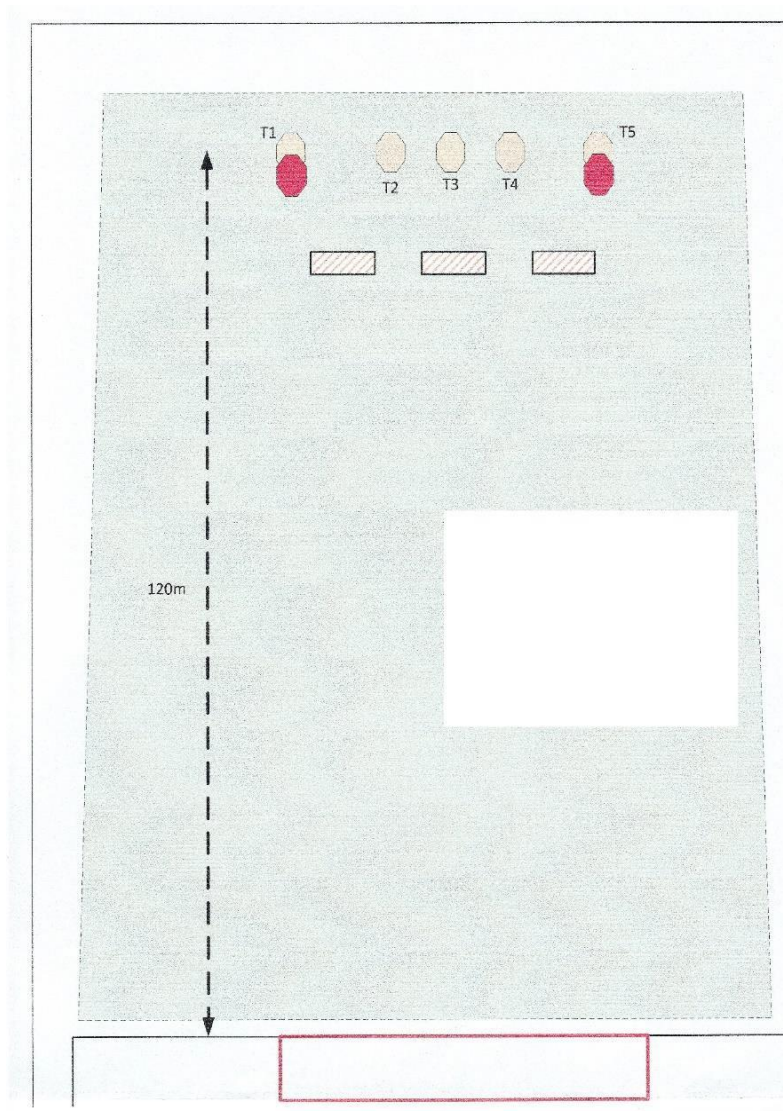
Type of course	Short course
Minimum rounds	10, MAB 5
Time starts	On audible signal
Targets	5 IPSC paper targets, 2 no shoot target
Start position	Competitor sitting on chair, hands on knees. Rifle lying flat on mark on table.
Procedure	After start signal engage targets. Target T1 and T2 must be engaged from left side of the wall. Target T3-T4-T5 must be engaged from right side of the wall.
Rifle ready condition	Unloaded (Option 3): Fixed magazine must be empty, detachable magazines removed and chamber must be empty. The action may be open or closed.
Distance	120 m
Safety angles	Indicated with red sticks





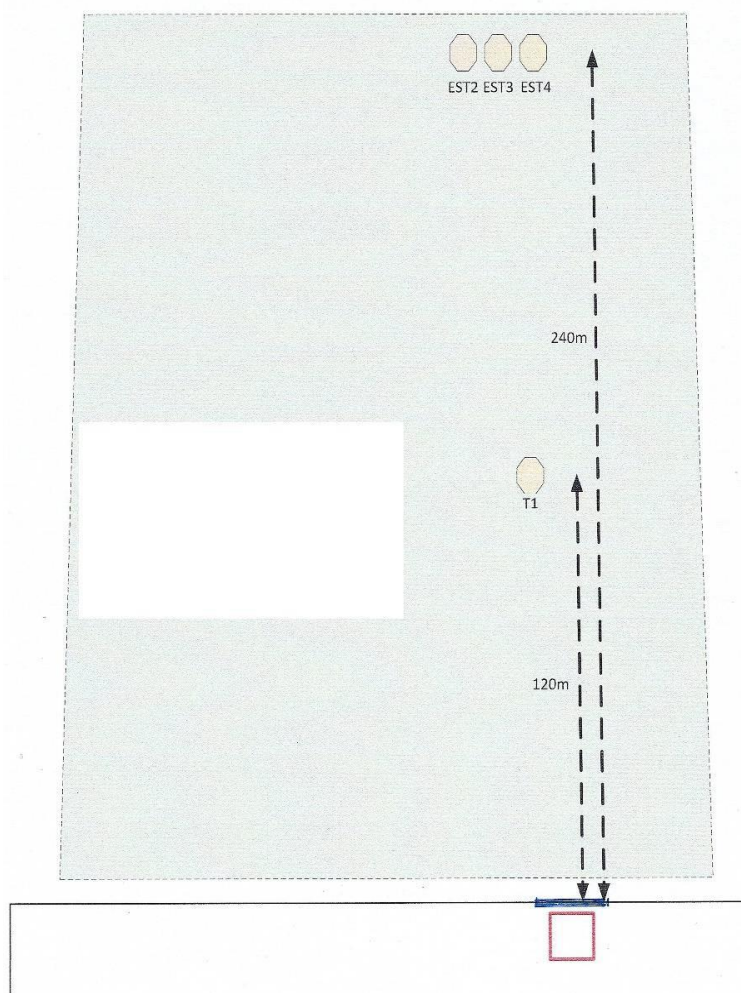

<b>Minimum rounds</b>	10, MAB 5
<b>Time starts</b>	On audible signal
<b>Targets</b>	5 IPSC paper targets.
<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle in ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange and with the finger outside the trigger guard. (See Appendix E1)
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets.
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 1): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber loaded, hammer and/or sear cocked and safety catch applied (if rifle is designed to have one)
<b>Distance</b>	70 m
<b>Safety angles</b>	Indicated with red sticks

<b>Time starts</b>	On audible signal
<b>Targets</b>	3 IPSC Electronic Scoring Targets, 1 IPSC paper targets.
<b>Start position</b>	Competitor standing erect, with rifle in ready condition, held in both hands, stock touching the competitor at hip level, barrel parallel to the ground, trigger guard downwards, muzzle pointing downrange and with the finger outside the trigger guard. (See Appendix E1)
<b>Procedure</b>	After start signal engage targets.
<b>Rifle ready condition</b>	Loaded (Option 1): Magazine filled and fitted (if applicable), chamber loaded, hammer and/or sear cocked and safety catch applied (if rifle is designed to have one)
<b>Distance</b>	120 - 240 m
<b>Safety angles</b>	Indicated with red sticks
