



FORMENTERA RECYCLES!

Free family fun day organised by the Foundation for the Conservation of Ibiza and Formentera

The **Foundation for the Conservation of Ibiza and Formentera** (IbizaPreservation) and **Ibiza Blue Challenge** are proud to present *Formentera Recycles!*, a community event designed to engage and entertain, taking place on **Saturday 17th May**, in celebration of **World Recycling Day**. The event will be held at **Illetas Beach in Formentera**, in partnership with the Consell of Formentera and local businesses.

This year's challenge will centre around the theme of the **circular economy**, in recognition of the anniversary that coincides with the event..

BASIC INFORMATION

THAT: A popular, family-friendly, non-federated race that consists of an orienteering style trail hunt using a map. The objective is to complete the route, identify and solve the 12 hidden clues in the shortest time possible.

WHEN: Saturday 17th May from 11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

WHERE: Illetas beach and surrounding areas, Formentera

WHO: Teams of between 2 and 3 people made up of at least one adult. It is suitable for all ages as each team can adapt its pace to its own level.

AS: The organisers will set you off from the [starting point](#) on Illetas beach, near Sa Sèquia, with a map and instructions, and from there competitors run or walk to the areas where the clues are hidden.

DURATION: Between 45 minutes and 2 hours.

COST: Sign up for free via [Sportmaniacs.com](https://www.sportmaniacs.com).

RULES

Article 1: Registration

Registration is free and can be completed online via the following link until 11am on Friday 16th May or until all 100 available team spots are filled:

When registering, please give the name of the first adult and then the system will ask you to indicate the names of the remaining members of the team (i.e. additional adult + minor or 2 minors).

Your registration includes accident insurance, a race bib, map and small gift for all teams that complete the course.

Article 2: Timings

- 11:00 competition opens & first competitors depart
- 13:30 last entries
- 15:00 competition close

You can arrive at any time between 11:00 and 13:30. On arrival at the organisers' tent, participants will receive their bib number and map to start the race.

Article 3: Prizes and categories

The race will consist of a single circuit of 12 questions. In the event that a question is skipped, the team will receive a penalty of 6 minutes. In the event that an answer is not correct, the penalty will be 1 minute per incorrect answer.

The prizes will be as follows:

- Local product finisher gift for all teams that complete the course
- A basket of local produce for the three fastest teams
- A prize draw among all competitors

Article 4: Eco-rules

It is strictly forbidden to throw any kind of wrapping or packaging along the route outside the containers that the organisers have set up for this purpose.

The refreshment point will be located in the finish area, with recycling containers and a water refill station provided.

Article 5: Necessary material

All participants should wear trainers and comfortable sports clothes.

Please avoid bringing single-use plastic water bottles and instead bring your own refillable bottle, plus any other supplies you consider necessary. It is advisable to carry a small backpack per team.

It is compulsory to carry one mobile phone per team and provide this number to the organisers when registering (in the *emergency contact number* field).

Article 6: Responsibility

This event takes place on roads, streets and forest paths and the circuit is open to traffic so you must follow the rules of the road at all times and exercise extreme caution. The adult shall be responsible for the minor(s) with whom they form a team; they must exercise constant vigilance in order to avoid any incidents.

Article 7: Photos

With their registration, the responsible adult authorises by default the capture of images/photographs in which they may appear individually or in a group, and that of the people for whom they are legally responsible (minors, legal guardians, etc.), with the purpose of being published on the website, social networks and other channels of Ibiza Blue Challenge and/or IbizaPreservation, in addition to the transfer of images to media outlets. The latter may also be present and capture their own images during the course of the test.
