Official Regulations VII Málaga Marathon

Article 1

Malaga City Hall, through Octagon ESEDOS SL organizes the VII Maratón Malaga on Sunday December 4th, 2016. By signing the registration form, participants declare and accept the rules.

Article 2

The VII Maratón Málaga, an urban running race of 42.195 meters, will allow the participation of all those who, regardless of having a federation license or not, are over 18 years of age and comply with the RFEA and IAAF rulebook. The circuit is run in asphalt and through the city (urban circuit), and is authorized by the RFEA and AIMS, having all the kilometric points properly indicated. The race is included as part of the International Calendars of the RFEA and of the AIMS.

The participation is limited to 5.500 runners, by order of registration. Each runner taking part in the VII Maratón Málaga competes at his/her own risk and has the physical condition and good health necessary to face the race.

The organization recommends all runners to undergo a medical examination previous to the competition. All participants have to accept the risk associated with sport activity.











Article 3

The race will start at 09:00 and runners will be placed according to their expected time. The race will finish at 15:00, being this the maximum time given to finish the race with official time. The race's time control will close when the runners pass through the following kms: 5, 10, 20, 30, 40 and finish line in a maximum time of 47 min, 1h25, 2h50, 4h15, 5h40 and 6h respectively. When a participant exceeds the excepted closing time, he/she will be passed by the vehicle that indicates the race's end, and the participant will either have to abandon the race or continue at his own risk and responsibility, complying with traffic's rules and regulations, like any other person in the street.

(*) These prices do not include the day license (7€), which is mandatory for runners who do not hold a valid national license (RFEA), Andalusian regional license (FAA) or Runner Plus license.

The amounts shown in the above list are prices of the entry fees. In no case will the type of the discount applied result in a 0€ fee.

- Spanish Unemployed: Photocopy of the "Tarjeta de Paro" updated to the day of the entry, photocopy of the National ID.
- **Disabled people**: Photocopy of certificate, showing the degree of disability, which must be 33% or higher. An ID stating the degree of disability and / or the disability payrolls will also be valid documents of proof.
- Spanish Retiree: Photocopy of the Retiree ID.

Only people with a disability, without a job, or Retiree at the time of registration will quality for the corresponding discount

To be able to complete the ON-LINE inscription, it will be necessary to send the documentation to inscripciones@maratonmalaga.com. The original documents will have to be provided physically the day of the marathon number pick-up.











Failure to meet any of the requirements stated above will not allow the person to receive any discount.

Registrations will not be accepted after the mentioned date.

Article 5

Registration can be completed as follows:

Through the website maratonmalaga.com

The organization can close the registration period when they consider it convenient.

Article 6

Cancellation Insurance Policy:

It is compulsory to hire the insurance at the moment of registering. The amount fee for the insurance is not nonrefundable. Ownership changes will not be allowed. There are three options:

- 1. I do not want insurance.
- 2. Insurance: 70% of the entry fee will be returned until June 30th, or 50% of the entry fee will be returned from July 1st to September 30th. Price is 5€.
 - o You have to contract cancellation insurance at the time of registration.
 - o The amount of the insurance is not refundable.
 - No change in ownership will be accepted.

The race is controlled by the Committee of Judges of the FAA, having time controls along the course. Runners not using the time chip and the marathon race number handed by the organization will not appear in the race results. It is the runner's responsibility to check the proper functioning of his/her chip on the timekeeper booth at the Marathon Expo.

The marathon race number and timing chip will be handed exclusively at the MARATHON EXPO at Palacio de Deportes Jose Maria Martin Carpena, C/Miguel Mérida Nicolich, 29004 Málaga on Friday December 2nd, from 3PM to 9PM and Saturday December 3rd from 10AM to 8PM.

If you are not able to pick them up in person, a third party can pick them up for you if he/she brings a signed authorization as well as the necessary documentation (photocopy of ID and proof of payment).

No marathon race numbers will be handed out to those who do not meet these requirements.

Under no circumstances will marathon numbers be collected the day of the event

Article 8

The Marathon race number is personal and not transferable. Failure to comply with this section will be reason for disqualification.

Other reasons of disqualification:

- Providing false information when registering (age, residence, etc.)
- Not doing the complete course.













- Not going through the checkpoints located through the course.
- Not having the marathon number visible at the front or hiding/altering any of its elements.
- Running with the number and/or time chip from any other runner.
- Running without a race number.
- Not following the instructions of the judges and/or staff of the Organization.
- Refusing to pass a drug test.
- Having unsportmanship behavior.
- Not complying with any issue stated by the RFEA regulations.
- Entering the finish line accompanied by persons or animals foreign to the organization.

Disqualified runners will have no option for awards or trophies.

Article 9

According to IAAF rules, a Feed Station will be located every 5kms, and between them hydration stations.

Likewise, health services and ambulances will be located in strategic places of the course, closing the race and at the finish line.

Information of medical interest (allergy, special attentions, etc.) recommended by the organization will be located in the back of the marathon number



According to the rules of the RFEA, the following categories, both male and female, and depending on the date of birth, will exist:

Men / Women

- (Juniors) Born in 1998 (before December 4)
- (Promises) Born in 1995, 1996 or 1997
- (Seniors) Born in 1994 and prior to veteran
- (Veterans A) 35-39 years old
- (Veterans B) 40-44 years old
- (Veterans C) 45-49 years old
- (Veterans D) 50-54 years old
- (Veterans E) 55-59 years old
- (Veterans F) 60-64 years old
- (Veterans G) 65-69 years old
- (Veterans H) 70 years old or more
- Disabled Wheelchair (Mixed)
- Disables Physical/Intellectual (Mixed)

Article 11

Trophies and awards will be given to:

- The male champion and the female champion of the Marathon. Ceremony will be at 11:30h
- The three first classified absolute male and female Ceremony will be at 11:45h

The following categories will have their Ceremonies after 15.00 h.

- The three first classified male and female of every category (can be accumulated with absolute classifications).
- The first three wheelchair disabled persons, if they have properly communicated their state at the moment of registering.
- The first three physical / intellectual disabled persons, if they have properly communicated their state at the moment of registering.

Any trophy not picked up the day of the event, can be requested by e-mail to info@maratonmalaga.com until January 9th 2017, and will be sent by Certified Mail in a COD (Collect on Delivery) format. After this day, the organization will not send more trophies, assuming the winners renounce to them.

All runners reaching the finish line will get a commemorative medal.

- Fifth 500 €











Men with a finishing time higher than 2h 15 ' 00 "and women higher than 2h 40 ' 00 ", will receive 50% of the prize.

RFEA licensed athletes (Men and Women):

- First 700 €
- Second 500 €
- Third 300 €

These prizes will be fully paid if the marks are less than 2h 20 ' 00 " in men and 2h 45 ' 00 " in women.

Men with a finishing time higher than 2h 20 ' 00 "and women higher than 2h 45 ' 00 ", will receive 50% of the prize.

These awards are cumulative with any other.

Athletes with a FAA license (Men and Women):

- First 500 €
- Second 300 €
- Third 100 €

These prizes will be fully paid if the marks are less than 2h 25' 00 " in men and 2h 55' 00 " in women.

Men with a finishing time higher than 2h 25' 00 "and women higher than 2h 55' 00 ", will receive 50% of the prize.











These prizes are cumulative with any other.

Athletes with a D.M.A. license (Malaga Athletics Delegation) (Men and Women):

First 500 €

These prizes will be fully paid if the marks are less than 2h 25' 00 " in men and 2h 55' 00 " in women.

Men with a finishing time higher than 2h 25' 00 "and women higher than 2h 55' 00 ", will receive 50% of the prize.

These awards are cumulative with any other.

Race Record (Men and Women):

- Men: John Kipkorir Mutai (KEN) 2:13:10 (2014)
- Women: Ndunsu Pennina Wanjiru (KEN) 2:37,46 (2015)

Because the Marathon is included in the National and International Calendar of the RFEA and of AIMS, anti-doping control is mandatory. If any runner designated to pass this control, refuses to do so, he/she will automatically disqualified in all categories, and will not be eligible to receive any prizes. The decision will be immediately denounced to the corresponding parties of the RFEA. All athletes who are submitted to antidoping control, will have to await the results before receiving the corresponding prize money.











All cash prizes will be subject tax payments marked by the Law. Once RFEA has validated the results and marks of the race, and the results of the anti-doping control has been received, prize money will be paid by bank transfer or check. After the event, the organization will have 90 days to pay the amount of the prizes.

NOTE: All runners that win prize money must present their ID, passport or similar and fill in the appropriate form. Anyone who fails to fulfill this rule will lose all rights to claim their prize money.

Any changes, new prizes or new amounts, which may occur after the issue of this policy, shall be promptly published on the website of the organization, becoming the valid information to be taken into account the day of the race.

The wheelchairs category will not have cash prizes for qualifying or record.

Article 13

The only authorized vehicles to follow the race will be those appointed by the Organization. It is strictly forbidden to follow the race with motorcycle, bicycle, in skates or any other wheeled vehicle. To avoid accidents, local Police and Judges will take them out of the race.

Article 14

The Organization declines any responsibility for the damage, prejudices or injuries that the participants in this race could suffer by fault of any third party. The participant's insurance will cover all accidents or incidents that are strictly related to the race.

All claims will have to be fulfilled orally to the race's Judge, not later than 30 minutes after the results are officially communicated. If they are not approved by him, it will be possible to present a written claim and accompanied by a 100 € deposit to the Appeal Juror. In case the resolution is approved and favorable, the 100€ deposit will be returned. If there is no Appeal Juror, the Races Judge's decision will be final.

Article 16

By entering the VII Maratón Málaga, all participants consent Octagon ESEDOS SL, as themselves or through third parties, to use their personal data automatically and purely for sporting promotional, or trade purposes.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: This race belongs to the official calendar of the RFEA (Royal Spanish Federation of Athletics) and, at the moment of registering, the runner consents expressly that his basic data will be transferred to this entity so they can handle all the compulsory insurances, Civil Responsibility, and one-day licenses that need to be processed with the insurance company. In any case and as the protection law of Information establishes, the interested party can exercise in the future his rights of access, rectification, cancellation and opposition by means of writing or e-mail to the Royal Spanish Federation of Athletics. 
