2018/19 has been defined by the hiatus caused by the lack of a devolved government in Northern Ireland and the shadow of Brexit. It would be naive to suggest this does not impact on the charitable sector. Start360, just like our colleagues and competitors across the sector, has been scanning the external environment and making the necessary adjustments to ensure we continue to offer the right services, at the right time, in the right place, to our service users. Quality has always been and remains our central tenet while we continue to hold fast to our core vision, mission and values.

Working collaboratively together in an authentic and meaningful way provides the best possible services for our service users. Start360 champion this approach and continue to build '**real' partnerships** with our public, private and CVS colleagues. During 2018/19 we have spent time building and expanding these partnerships while also creating new ones. BITC, PAF and PBNI are examples of new partnership working.

Conditions of collaborative working need to be paramount to any partnership and fully understood by all. Here in Start360 the service user is central to all we do – so partnership working has to underpin this fundamental premise. Partnership is about problem solving together, agreeing shared outcomes and strengthening the services we provide. Partnership has to be about adding **value**.



Start360 continue to develop new and different models to deal with the more diverse and complex behaviours presented by our service users. EDGES, ADJUST and AD:EPT2 are prime examples of this (See our Website for Learning Reviews and Evaluation). These successful and transformational delivery models are tinged with disappointment as the funding models, Earliest Intervention Transformational Programme (EITP) and National Lottery Community Fund, are not picked up centrally after piloting, despite the success and learning that occurs. This is a fundamental and reoccurring issue which needs new and different thinking if we are to best serve the vulnerable and needy in Northern Ireland during the coming years of likely austerity. It is cultural change that is required both in the external and internal contexts. We all know culture eats strategy for breakfast – Start360 is focusing on our **culture** as we continue to deliver on our strategy.

Start360 believe in earliest intervention and providing support to family members/ relevant others too, if at all possible. No individual should be expected to change in isolation – **everyone needs support**. We deliver a needs-based approach, addressing the underlying causes of presenting issues, whilst always aware a lot of our service users can be both victims and perpetrators. This takes time. Start360 believe time is our most important resource.



Measuring outcomes and learning as we go provides Start360 with the evidence base we need to provide flexible and adaptable services. Ensuring our staff are equipped with the **skills and tools** to deliver these services in this way is also key.

There are difficult times ahead of us in Northern Ireland – without question. Start360 is committed to protecting its front-line services while retaining quality and competitiveness. This will require a programme of substantial change which we will deliver predicated on the understandings that **change** is the only constant, success breeds success and the hope for a better future for all.

The Board and staff remain very **ambitious** for Start360. The organisation continues to be made up of a diverse range of people, skills, abilities and expertise within the leadership, staff team and Board. Moreover, the commitment, loyalty, dedication, drive, flexibility and enthusiasm they all invest in Start360 deserves note. This wonderful dynamic is omnipresent – it permeates the organisation. PUBLIC BENEFIT REPORTING

Start360 provides a range of interventions to young people, adults and their families – including those who have issues with substance use, who are isolated from their communities, who face barriers to employment or who experience other forms of disadvantage.



Our activities include one-to-one work, group work, mentoring and counselling. We take young people away on 'time out', we run challenge residentials and creative writing residentials, we arrange diversionary activities, we deliver play therapy and qualifications and crisis support.

The achievements of our services are detailed in the body of the Annual Report.

Our beneficiaries are disadvantaged young people, adults and families. They have one or more of the following issues in their lives – substance use by themselves or family members, mental ill health, unemployment, being in and/or leaving custody, coming to the attention of the PSNI or social services, or general disengagement from the local community. The communities of our service users and the wider public also benefit as we realise substantial savings to the public purse.

Start360 does not charge any fees. No harm comes from our purposes and no private benefit occurs. The trustees of Start360 have had due regard to the public benefit statutory guidance.
