Facts Pit Lane Incident: Staff working on a car without an armband
Alleged Offence Alleged breach of Article 32.2 of the 2020 FIA WTCR Sporting Regulations
Penalty **No further action**
Reason After evaluating all of the information and possible evidence, the Stewards determined that the staff member with no visible armband was the Team Manager and the Team Manager is a known person for the pit lane officers/marshals. Furthermore, no one requested him to show his armband. Therefore, the Stewards determine that there was no clear breach of the aforementioned article.

The Competitor is reminded of his right to appeal in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code.
