

Session during Race 1
Facts On the course of lap 1, Car #8 made several contacts with the rear of the Car #96 at MP24 and gained a position.
Offence Causing an incident as defined in Breach of Article 17.1 b) of the 2021 FIA WTCR Sporting Regulations and Article 2.d, Ch. IV, of the Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code
Penalty **Time penalty of 5 seconds** (to be added to the Driver's total time for the Race 1)
1 penalty point (3 in total)
Reason The Driver caused several contacts with disadvantage for another Driver This decision has been taken in accordance with Articles 17.3 d) and 19.3 of the 2021 FIA WTCR Sporting Regulations and Articles 11.9.3 a) and 12.4.1 h) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards in accordance with Art. 15 of the FIA International Sport Code and Art. 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
