Facts On the course of lap 1, Car #69 went over the apex of Turn 3 and, consequently, making contact with Car #3 that then collided with Car #19, which went off the track into the run-off area.
Offence allegedly caused an incident as defined in Art. 17.1 of the 2021 FIA WTCC Sporting Regulations
Penalty **No further action**
Reason The Stewards determine that the collision was the result of several previous contacts between a lot of cars and not the fault of the Driver of Car #69.

Competitor is reminded of the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards in accordance with Art. 15 of the FIA International Sport Code and Art. 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
