## 2021 FIA WTCR – RACE OF ITALY

COMTOYOU TEAM AUDI SPORT

The Stewards, having received Report #8 from the FIA Race Director, reviewed video evidence, have heard from the Competitors and the Drivers concerned, considered the following matter, and determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the Competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

**No / Driver** 16 / G. Magnus  
**Competitor** COMTOYOU TEAM AUDI SPORT  
**Session** During Race 2  
**Time** 12:19  
**Facts** On the course of lap 1, Car #16 made a side contact with Car #11 at the apex of T3, but then made two other contacts at the exit of T3 forcing Car #11 off the track.  
**Regulation** Alleged breach of Article 17.1 of the 2021 FIA WTCR Sporting Regulations  
**Decision** No further action  
**Reason** After considering the matter extensively, the Stewards determine that the Driver of Car #16 was not predominantly to blame for Car #11 going off the track.

Competitor is reminded of the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards in accordance with Art. 15 of the FIA International Sport Code and Art. 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
