

General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR) – Safety Information

This document provides general safety information in compliance with the UK and EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR) for a watch strap intended for consumer use. It is essential that the product is used only as intended and in accordance with the following guidelines to ensure safety and comfort.

✓ Intended Use

This watch strap is designed exclusively for use with wristwatches. It must be attached and adjusted following the manufacturer's instructions. It is not suitable for any other applications or modifications.

✓ Safety Precautions

- Ensure the strap is securely fastened to both the watch case and your wrist before wearing.
- Avoid overtightening, which may restrict blood circulation or cause discomfort.
- Do not use the strap if it shows visible signs of damage, cracks, or excessive wear.
- Remove immediately if skin irritation, rash, or allergic reaction occurs.
- Keep away from small children, as small parts may pose a choking hazard.
- Avoid exposing the strap to extreme heat, fire, or chemicals that may degrade the material.
- Do not modify the strap, as this may compromise safety and durability.

✓ Maintenance & Care

Regular maintenance will extend the lifespan of the strap. Clean with a damp cloth and mild soap if necessary. Avoid the use of harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive materials. For leather straps, avoid prolonged water exposure. Inspect regularly for signs of wear and replace when needed.

✓ Environmental & Disposal Information

At the end of its service life, dispose of the strap responsibly. Recycle materials where facilities exist, in accordance with local waste management regulations. Do not dispose of with household waste if recycling options are available.
