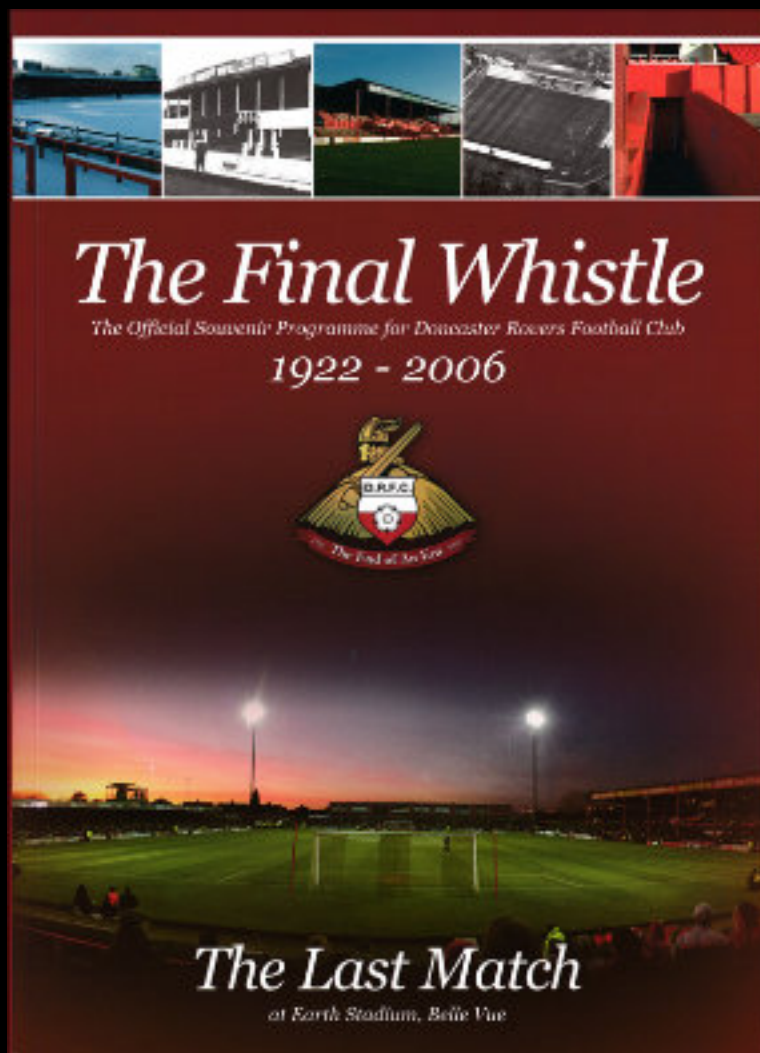

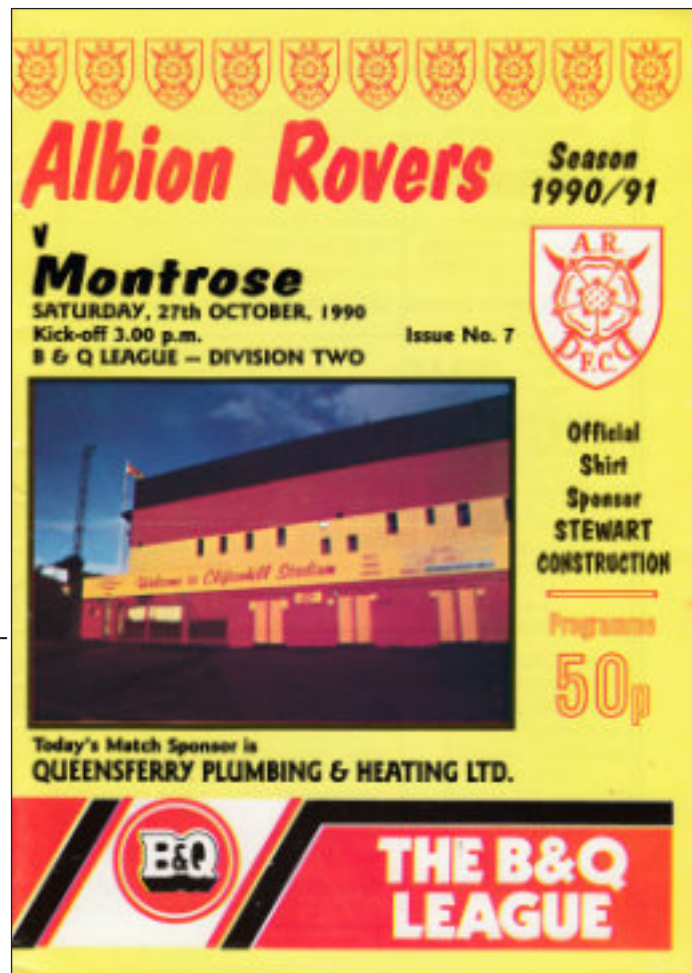

Covered

I began collecting programmes with images of football grounds on the cover accidentally over twenty years ago. I had opened a small Club Shop at Crockenhill FC and gathered a small stock of old programmes to sell. I had no intention of collecting myself, other than programmes from games I'd seen, but pulled out one or two programmes which appealed to me. My interest in the history of football grounds had taken another turn.

The annual New Year programme fairs in London proved to be an excellent source as did the regular catalogues from Sports Programmes. The term groundview became the word I searched for as I scanned the many pages of the catalogues.

The programmes included in this book may not be ones which other collectors would buy. Some have had holes punched to enable storing in folders, other have scores on the covers or are creased. My criteria was that if the image was of interest then I was happy to buy.

Around the same time I began publishing books focusing on football grounds and it became clear that these programmes would provide an excellent source of material for a future volume. Little did I realise that it would take so long to finally find the time to edit the book.

Club names in alphabetical order provided a starting point for the layout. In order to feature clubs with more than one programme of interest this is not completely consistent. Ground names identify each programme, with details of the match or publication as appropriate. Club names at the time of the programme's publication have been used.

Most clubs have at some stage had sufficient pride in their ground to feature it on the cover, often showing key developments such as covers for terraces, stands or floodlights. Others are aerial views which are probably of most interest to ground enthusiasts. It has been possible to include other clubs where matchday photos have been taken using a suitably wide-angled lens so that ground features are seen behind the action. Graphical representations are included as a last resort.

I leave the reader to investigate each image to see what key aspects of the grounds are shown. Many grounds have long-since been demolished and few of the stands seen still survive. The covered terrace is often a distant memory and the open terrace even rarer. For me these views and the design of the programme covers takes me back to my earliest days of watching football in a way which I doubt the matchday magazines of today will in the future.

I aim to gather together any historical notes and observations of readers either by email, on social media through Grounds Frenzy @MikeFloate on Twitter or by post for future publication in a magazine article.

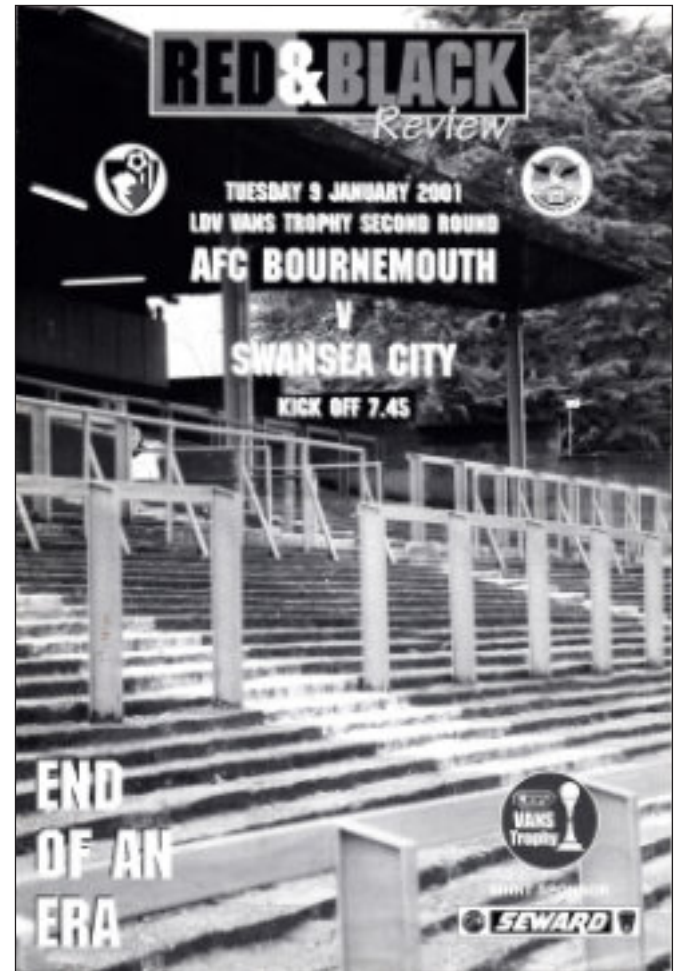
