

Crochet Chicken Bag!

1. Start with red yarn, chain 8
2. Turn, and Back Loops Only HDC 7, chain 1 turn
3. Repeat step 2 until you have 39 rows
4. On Row 40, slip stitch row 39 to row 1
5. With red yarn, HDC Increase in each row
6. Switch to colored yarn, and HDC in each stitch
7. Continue until you have about 30 rows
8. Slip Stitch the front layer to the back layer and tie off
9. For the arms: Create a magic circle of 4 stitches
10. HDC increase in each stitch
11. Continue with rows until arm is desired length and repeat for 2nd arm
12. Sew arms onto bag, and Embroider eyes and Beak however you desire (To each their own, I just use a straight stitch for the Eyes and I combine diagonal stitches and horizontal stitches for the beak)
13. Thread red yarn into a large needle
14. On the side you want the drawstring, push needle straight through (between the BLO ribbing and the first row of red HDC increases), and pull until there is about 4 inches left on the outside
15. Turn the bag inside out, and then thread the red yarn through the stitch below the red HDC Increase row
16. Once you have reached the spot where you started, push the needle through and turn the bag right side out
17. Holding both ends on the yarn, about an inch away from the bag tie an overhand knot
18. Personally, I finish off with a tassel to cover the knot!
