

HAUC(UK) Training and Accreditation Working Group (TAWG)

Purpose

To facilitate consultation and make representation to HAUC(UK) on matters relating to training and accreditation with regard to the New Roads and Streets Works Act 1991.

Terms of Reference

- Determine the assessment strategy for operatives working on the highway and supervisors responsible for the supervision of the street works
- Regularly review the assessment standards (The Standards) in the light of changes to:
 - Codes of Practice and HAUC(UK) Advice Notes relating to street works,
 - Excavation and reinstatement techniques/materials and
 - New technologies.
- Produce statistical analysis on registrations of operatives/supervisors
- Work with Awarding Bodies to ensure qualifications are assessed in line with legislation
- Report back to HAUC(UK) progress on all issues
- Provide support to the Awarding Bodies
- Provide advice to the industry
