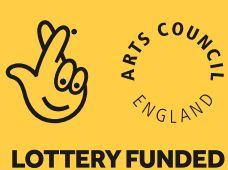

Unleash the power of your voice and help defeat the mischievous resident snake, STANLEY, in our interactive sound adventure, *Snake Attack!*

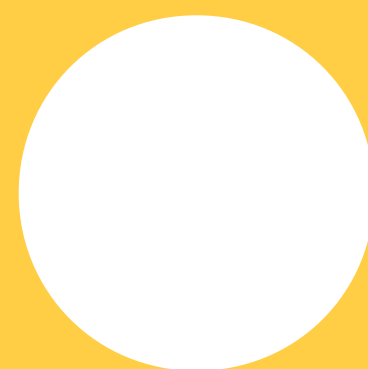
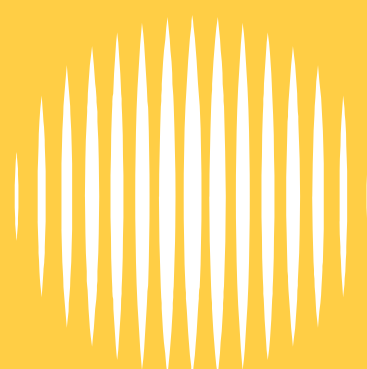

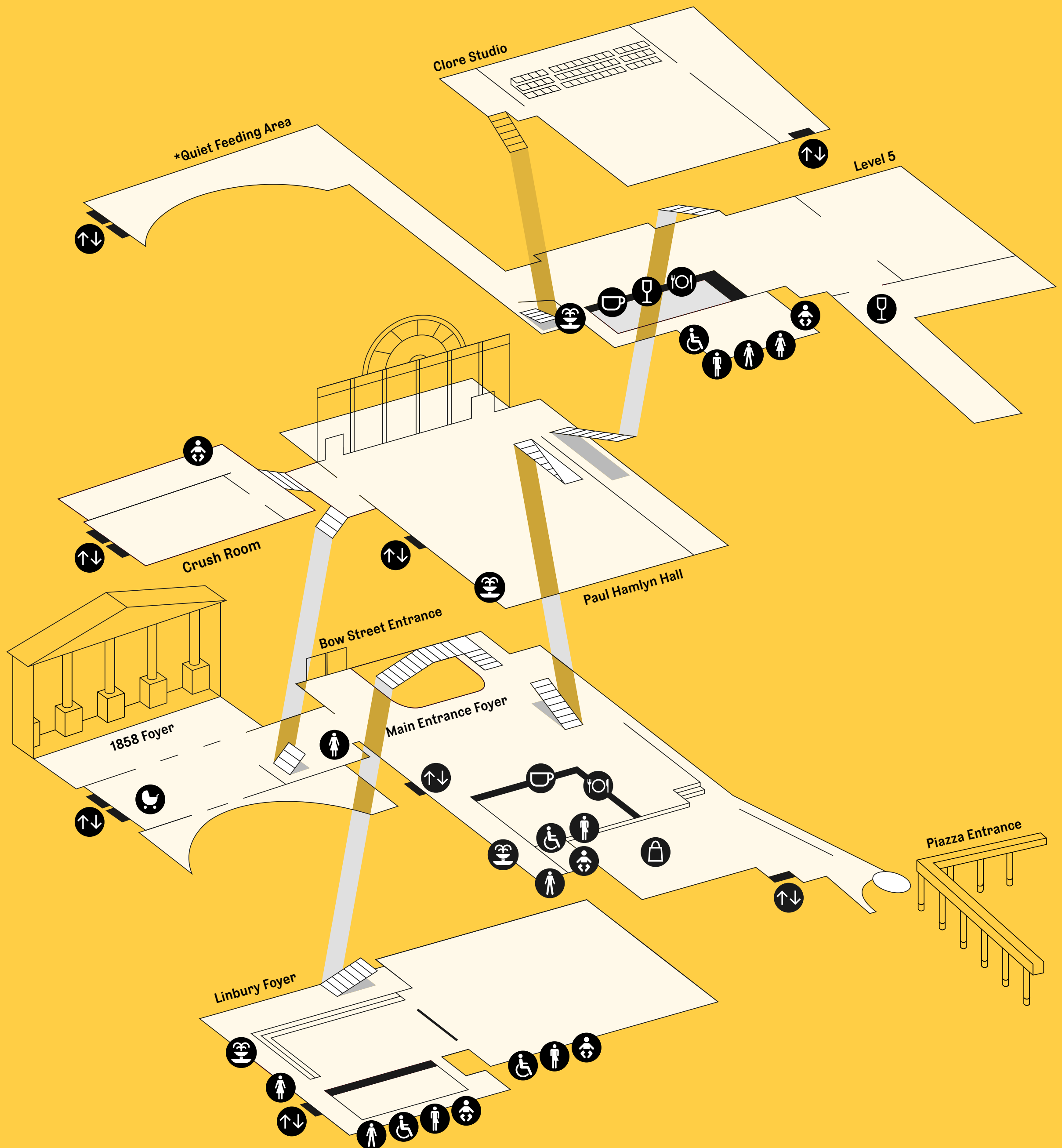
