THE COMPETITION

- DRESS** **Group colours**
- DRESSAGE** **50m x 25m arena** RDA Dressage test 2016, circles
 25metres to go through x. Markers will be equidistant.
- CONES** Cones will take place in the arena with the obstacle driving. Cones to be driven and scored first followed by two obstacles.
Please state carriage width on attached entry form.
Outdoor arena may be used as a warm up arena.
- OBSTACLES** Two obstacles will be driven by the Novice and Intermediate classes and four for the Open.
- CLASSES** **Assisted Whip** (non qualifier)
- Novice** - For newcomers and novice drivers.
- Intermediate** - Drivers who have been placed 1st in the Novice class at the National Championships at Hartpury.
- Open** - Drivers who have been placed 1st at the National championships in the intermediate class or have competed in the open class at Hartpury or drive with a backstep groom.

THE RULES

To be run strictly to RDA Carriage Driving Safety Code.
All competition vehicles must have been assessed.
Each horse/pony may compete twice only.

Size of horse/pony is immaterial in either class, but width of carriage determines running order.

Please bring passports with up to date inoculations

Hats of coaches, drivers and grooms need to be checked and tagged.(please bring when you collect your numbers
