

Standard Event FAQs

Will the event go ahead in the rain?

Hooray for the great British weather! We hope to run the event in all weather conditions but if the weather becomes particularly hot, windy or wet we may need to cancel. In the case of adverse weather please check our socials and website before setting off for the event. Please dress for the weather and bring a drink of water with you.

Can you leave the performance early?

The performance is set on a circular route starting and ending at the same place. You may leave at any point but will need walk back to your starting point.

Toilets

Toilets are located at the start and end of the trail. There are no toilets on the route.

Stopping points

There is a rest point about halfway through the trail, confectionery and drinks will be available to purchase.

Lunch

We recommend eating before or after the event as there is nowhere to eat lunch on the trail.

Dogs

Well behaved dogs are welcome. Please clean up after your dog.

What do I do if I miss my slot?

We encourage everyone to try their best to keep to their time slot. If you miss it, it may be possible to add you onto another time slot if there is availability but we cannot guarantee this.

Accessibility

Can I bring my pushchair?

Lakeside Country Park

Most of the Lakeside route follows pathways and should be suitable for most pushchairs. Please be aware that some surfaces may vary depending on the weather.

Boorley Green

Some of the Boorley route is more uneven, with a section that includes steps, so it may not be suitable for all pushchairs.

Is the route wheelchair friendly?

Lakeside Country Park

Most of the Lakeside route follows pathways and may be suitable for some wheelchair users. There is one section that you may need to leave the route and enter further along – this will depend on weather and ground conditions.

Boorley Green

The Boorley route includes uneven ground and a section with steps, so it is not suitable for wheelchair users.
