
FROM THE FOUNDER OF THE #VIKISEWS BRAND

LUANA PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Luana is a fully lined dress with an accentuated waist. It has a corset-style, close-fitting bodice with front and back princess seams reinforced with boning. The semi-fitted skirt is flared from the waist down thanks to triangular panels in the princess seams. The dress has a deep square neckline and closes with an invisible zipper in the center back seam. All the princess and panel seams feature decorative topstitching. Luana is above-knee length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew this dress, choose dress-weight fabrics with the following properties:

· medium weight, structured, opaque and non-stretch

• the fabric content can include natural fibers (silk, cotton), artificial fibers (viscose), blends (silk + polyester, cotton + viscose, etc.), and synthetics (polyester)

• the following fabrics are recommended: matte satin (Peau de Soie), taffeta, jacquard.

Attention! We do not recommend lightweight, soft, stretchy fabrics (chiffon, organza, stretch lace).

For the lining, we recommend lining fabrics made of artificial fibers (viscose), blends (viscose + polyester), and synthetics (polyester).

The dress in the photo is made of matte satin (Peau de Soie). The fabric is medium weight, structured and non-stretch. The fiber content is 100% polyester. The fabric weight is 170 g/m².

The lining is 100% viscose, 50 g/m².

PATTERN PIECES LIST

1. From main fabric:

- \cdot center front cut 2
- mid front cut 2
- \cdot side front cut 2
- \cdot front panel cut 2
- \cdot center back cut 2
- \cdot mid back cut 2
- \cdot side back cut 2
- back panel cut 2.

2. From lining fabric:

- \cdot center front lining cut 1 on fold
- mid front lining cut 2
- \cdot side front lining cut 2
- \cdot center back lining cut 2
- mid back lining cut 2
- \cdot side back lining cut 2.

IMPORTANT! Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.

3. From interfacing:

- \cdot center front cut 2
- \cdot mid front cut 2
- \cdot side front cut 2
- \cdot front panel cut 2
- \cdot center back cut 2
- \cdot mid back cut 2
- side back cut 2
- \cdot back panel cut 2.

Attention! Interface (block fuse) the main fabric prior to cutting the pieces.

SEAM ALLOWANCES

All pattern pieces include seam allowances as follows:

- hem allowance 3.5 cm (1 3/8")
- \cdot center back seam allowance 1.5 cm (5/8")
- \cdot all other edges 1 cm (3/8").

Take this into account when laying out pattern pieces on the fabric.





Press the seam allowances toward the mid front (mid back) piece.

On the right side, topstitch the seam allowances with topstitching thread to the mid front (mid back) piece at 7 mm (1/4") from the seam. Use a 4 mm stitch length.

Press the seam.
