BECKY PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Becky is a semi-fitted trapeze dress finished with a free-hanging lining. The dress features a deep square neckline and fastens with an invisible zipper in the center back seam. The front is fitted with bust darts transferred to the side seams while the back features shoulder darts transferred to the neckline. The long set-in sleeves are made up of two pieces. Becky is above-knee length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew this dress, choose dress-weight fabrics with the following properties:

- · medium weight, pliable, soft, non-stretch or with very little stretch, opaque
- the fiber content can include natural fibers (wool, silk, cotton, linen), artificial fibers (viscose), blends (wool + silk, wool + polyester, cotton + viscose, etc.), and synthetics (polyester, polyester + elastane)
 - the following fabrics are recommended: dress-weight suiting, dress-weight wool, wool crepe, gabardine

Attention! We do not recommend stretchy knit fabrics and lightweight sheer fabrics (chiffon, organza, stretch lace).

For the lining, choose lining fabrics made of artificial fibers (viscose), blends (viscose + elastane, viscose + polyester), or synthetics (polyester, polyester + elastane).

The dress in the photo is made of suiting fabric. The fabric is medium weight, pliable, soft, and structured. It stretches slightly and resists wrinkles. The fiber content is 80% viscose and 20% spandex. The lining is 100% viscose.

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- sewing machine for construction
- overlocker for finishing raw edges. This may be replaced with a stretch overlock stitch or a zigzag stitch on the sewing machine (overlock or zigzag stitch width 2–3 mm, stitch length 2.5 mm)
- stitch-in-the-ditch foot for the sewing machine (optional)
- · invisible zipper foot for the sewing machine
- · one-sided foot for the sewing machine to attach the zipper

PATTERN PIECES LIST

1. From main fabric:

- front cut 1 on fold
- ∙ back cut 2
- top sleeve cut 2
- · bottom sleeve cut 2

2. From lining fabric:

- front cut 1 on fold
- ∙ back cut 2

IMPORTANT! Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.

Additionally, cut two interfacing strips, 2 cm (3/4") wide, to interface the zipper seam allowances. The interfacing strips should be cut on the cross grain (perpendicular to the selvedge).

SEAM ALLOWANCES

All pattern pieces include seam allowances as follows:


- garment hem allowance 4 cm (1 5/8")
- sleeve hem allowance 2.5 cm (1")
- center back seam allowance 1.5 cm (5/8")
- all other edges 1 cm (3/8")

Take this into account when laying out pattern pieces on the fabric.




Machine-stitch, starting at the wide end and moving towards the dart apex.

Backstitch at the beginning of the seam only. At the tip of the dart, tie the thread ends into knots and hide them inside the dart bulk using a hand sewing needle.



Press the darts flat.



Press the dart seam allowances upwards on the front piece. On the back pieces, press the dart seam allowances towards the center back.

Press and steam to shrink out the fullness at the dart points.
