

SIGOURNEY PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Sigourney is a close-fitting dress with separate bust cups and an open back. The dress is fitted with front and back waist darts and features a center back seam. The bust cups are lined and shaped with underwires. The neckline is V-shaped. The front features an exposed separating zipper and a slit. Sigourney is midi length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew this dress, choose dress-weight fabrics with the following properties:

- · medium weight, pliable, soft, medium stretch
- the fiber content can include natural fibers (cotton), blends (cotton + polyester), and synthetics (polyester)
 - · the following fabrics are recommended: gabardine, denim, fine wale corduroy

Attention! The chosen fabric must contain elastane.

For the bust cup lining, choose fabrics made of natural fibers (cotton) or blends (cotton + viscose).

The dress in the photo is made of denim. The fabric is medium weight, pliable, soft, and stretchy. The fiber content is a blend of cotton, polyester, and elastane. The fabric weight is 285 g/m².

The bust cup lining is made of poplin. The fiber content is 100% cotton. The fabric weight is 110 g/m^2 .

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- sewing machine for construction
- overlocker for finishing raw edges. This may be replaced with a stretch overlock stitch or a zigzag stitch on the sewing machine (overlock or zigzag stitch width 2–3 mm, stitch length 2.5 mm)
- · stitch-in-the-ditch foot for the sewing machine (optional)
- · one-sided zipper foot for the sewing machine

PATTERN PIECES LIST

1. From main fabric:

- front cut 2
- ∙ back cut 2
- front facing cut 2
- · center bust cup cut 2
- side bust cup cut 2
- back facing cut 1 on fold

2. From lining fabric:

- · center bust cup lining cut 2
- side bust cup lining cut 2
- · bust cup channel cut 2

3. From interfacing:

- front facing cut 2
- · back facing cut 1 on fold


IMPORTANT! Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.

SEAM ALLOWANCES

All pattern pieces include seam allowances as follows:

- garment hem allowance 3 cm (1 1/8")
- all other edges -1 cm (3/8'')

Take this into account when laying out pattern pieces on the fabric.




Stretch out the dart seam allowances on the back pieces while pressing. This will allow the darts to lie flat when pressed towards the center, without pulling along the seam.

Press the darts on the front and back pieces towards the respective center edges.



Press and steam the darts, shrink out the fullness at the dart points on a tailor's ham.



Press and steam the zipper tape to prevent it from shrinking in the finished garment.
