CARLA PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Carla is a pair of close-fitting trousers, flared from the knee down. The trousers do not have a waistband, the waist is finished with a facing. The front features side panels that imitate slash pockets. There are waist darts at the back. In place of the front waist darts, there are vents that serve as closures. The trousers close with buttons and buttonholes and are floor-length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew these trousers, choose suiting fabrics with the following properties:

- · medium-weight, pliable, soft, with good stretch
- the fiber content should include elastane or spandex and can also include natural fibers (wool, cotton), artificial fibers (viscose), blends (wool + silk, wool + polyester, cotton + viscose, etc.), and synthetics (polyester, polyamide)
 - the following fabrics are recommended: wool suiting, gabardine.

Attention! We do not recommend fabrics without elastane or very stretchy materials (knits).

The trousers in the photos are made of wool suiting. The fabric is medium-weight, pliable, soft, with stretch. The fiber content is a blend of wool and elastane.

IMPORTANT! When purchasing fabric, please account for shrinkage and buy 5% more than required.

- 2. Lightweight interfacing, knit or woven, 140cm (55") wide, for all sizes and heights 0.25m (1/4yd).
- 3. Stitch-reinforced fusible stay tape, 1cm (3/8") wide 1.7m (1 7/8yd).
- 4. Eight buttons, 2–2.2cm (3/4–7/8") in diameter.
- 5. Matching thread 5 spools (1 spool for the sewing machine + 4 spools for the overlocker).

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- sewing machine for construction
- overlocker for finishing raw edges. This may be replaced with a stretch overlock stitch or a zigzag stitch on the sewing machine (overlock or zigzag stitch width 2–3mm, stitch length 2.5mm)
- · buttonhole foot for the sewing machine
- · edgestitch foot for the sewing machine (optional).

PATTERN PIECES LIST

1. From main fabric:

- front leg cut 2
- back leg cut 2
- side front cut 2
- · back facing cut 1 on fold
- side front facing cut 2
- · center front facing cut 1 on fold
- placket cut 2.

IMPORTANT! Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.

2. From interfacing:

- · back facing cut 1 on fold
- side front facing cut 2
- · center front facing cut 1 on fold
- placket cut 2.

Additionally, cut the following from interfacing:

- \cdot 2 strips, 2.5cm (1") wide and as long as the seam allowance for attaching the side front piece on the front leg
- 2 strips, 2×5 cm ($3/4\times2''$) each, to interface the point of the dart used to construct the vent on the front leg.

SEAM ALLOWANCES

Pattern pieces include the following seam allowances:

- hem allowance 4cm (1 5/8")
- all other edges 1cm (3/8").

Take this into account when laying out pattern pieces on the fabric.



Machine-stitch the darts, backstitching at the beginning of the seams (at the base of the darts). At the tip of the dart, tie the thread ends into knots and hide them between the fabric layers.



Press the dart flat.



Steam-press the darts, shrink out the fullness at the dart point on a tailor's ham. Press the darts toward the center seam.
