

## TOSHIE PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Toshie is a pair of fully lined slippers made of faux fur. They feature an outsole made of faux leather, a foam-padded upper, and a removable faux fur insole. The top edge of the slippers is finished with bias binding.

#### SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew these slippers choose medium-pile fur made of natural, artificial, synthetic fibers, or blends.

The slippers in the photo are made of faux fur. This fabric is medium-weight and non-stretch. The fiber content is a blend of polyester and wool. The fabric weight is 400 g/m<sup>2</sup>.

## FABRIC AND NOTIONS REQUIREMENTS

1. Main fabric (faux fur), 140 cm (55") wide, 350–400 g/m<sup>2</sup>, to be cut in one direction:

Size EU	35–37	38-43
meters	0.3	0.35
yards	3/8	3/8

2. Lining fabric (matte satin or Peau de Soie), 140 cm (55") wide, 170 g/m<sup>2</sup>:

Size EU	35–36	37-43
meters	0.3	0.35
yards	3/8	3/8

3. Interfacing, 140 cm (55") wide, 70 g/m<sup>2</sup>: 4. Foam, 3 mm (1/8") thick, 50 cm (19") wide:

Size EU	35-41	42-43
meters	0.3	0.35
yards	3/8	3/8

Size EU	35-37	38-43
meters	0.3	0.35
yards	3/8	3/8



Fold the padded upper piece right sides together, align the center back edges, and pin. Stitch on the sewing machine, backstitching at the beginning and end of the seam. Use a 2.5 mm stitch length and machine-stitch twice, with the second stitching line going exactly over the first one. This ensures a stronger seam.



Press the seam flat.

Trim the foam within the center seam allowances, as shown in the photo.



Press the seam allowances open on a tailor's board.
