

Binky is a close-fitting lined hat. It has a rounded crown with decorative ears, as well as a wide cuff and ears with ties.

#### SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew this hat, choose knit fabrics with the following properties:

- · medium weight, soft, breathable, stretchy
- the fiber content can include natural fibers (cotton), artificial fibers (viscose), and blends (cotton + polyester, cotton + elastane, etc.)
  - · the following fabrics are recommended: rib knits, lightweight French terry
  - · for the lining, we recommend knit fabrics: jersey knits, interlock knits

The hat in the photo is made of rib knit fabric. The fabric is soft and has good stretch. The fiber content is a blend of cotton (95%) and spandex (5%). The fabric weight is  $420 \text{ g/m}^2$ .

The lining is made of jersey knit fabric. The fabric is soft and has good stretch. The fiber content is a blend of cotton (97%) and elastane (3%). The fabric weight is  $300 \text{ g/m}^2$ .

## FABRIC AND NOTIONS REQUIREMENTS

1. Main fabric, 100 cm wide, in meters: Main fabric, 39" wide, in yards:

Size	Length	Size	Length
40-42	0.3	40-42	3/8
44-46	0.3	44–46	3/8
48-50	0.35	48-50	3/8

*IMPORTANT!* When purchasing fabric, please account for shrinkage and buy 5% more than required.

- 2. Lining fabric, 100 cm (39") wide, for all sizes 0.2 m (1/4 yd)
- 3. Matching thread 4 spools (1 spool for the sewing machine + 3 spools for the overlocker)



Match up the dart legs on the wrong side of the front and back pieces. Pin and stitch on the overlocker using a 3-thread narrow overlock stitch. When stitching, keep either side facing up.

**Attention!** You can replace the overlocker with a stretch or zigzag stitch on your sewing machine.



Leave long thread tails, tie them into a knot, and then hide them inside the seam allowance using a large-eye needle.



Press the seam flat.
