OLAF PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Olaf is a semi-fitted, hooded sleepsuit. The garment has two zippers transitioning into side seams at the front and an elasticated casing sewn on along the waistline at the back. The long raglan sleeves are finished with cuffs. There is a gusset at the crotch and elastic stitched above the covered feet at the back. The fully lined hood with decorative ears and a wrap-over elasticated front closes with open-ring snaps.

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- sewing machine for construction
- overlocker for construction and finishing raw edges. This may be replaced with a stretch overlock stitch or a zigzag stitch on the sewing machine (overlock or zigzag stitch width 2–3 mm, stitch length 2.5 mm)
- press tool for installing snaps

IMPORTANT! For knit projects, we recommend using special sewing needles for stretchy knit fabrics (e.g. STRETCH, SUPER STRETCH, JERSEY, etc.). When sewing, a ball-shaped needle point pushes the knit loops apart without piercing the threads.

PATTERN PIECES LIST

1. From main fabric:

- front cut 1 on fold
- back cut 1 on fold
- · sleeve cut 2
- · hood side panel cut 2
- hood center panel cut 1
- inner front placket cut 2
- gusset cut 1
- foot top cut 2
- sole cut 2
- ear cut 4

Attention! The sleepsuit is designed with 3 ear options — bunny, squirrel and bear.

2. From additional fabric (jersey knit):

- hood side panel cut 2
- hood center panel cut 1
- inner front placket cut 2
- back casing cut 1
- front neck facing cut 1

3. From additional fabric (ribbing):

- · cuff cut 2
- outer mitten cuff cut 2
- inner mitten cuff cut 2

Attention! The sleepsuit is designed with 2 options for cuffs.

IMPORTANT! Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.



Place the inner front placket pieces cut out of the main fabric and lining fabric in pairs, right sides together.

Align the inner curved edges, match the notches, and pin. Stitch on the sewing machine, backstitching at the beginning and end of the seam.



Trim the seam allowances down to 5 mm (just under 1/4").



Fold the placket lining right side up. Press the seam allowances towards the lining.
