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PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Shelly is a loose-fitting single-breasted coat with a straight cut. It features a detachable hood and front patch pockets with pointed flaps that fasten with a button and buttonhole. The back features a yoke with a decorative button tab at the center. The coat has a drop shoulder and long, shirt-style, two-piece sleeves embellished with a tab at the hem, which fastens with a button and buttonhole. There are inseam pockets in the side seams and short slits at the hem. The coat has a turn-down collar with a collar stand and a center front button closure. The coat hem is curved and is longer at the back. Decorative topstitching accentuates the pocket flaps, sleeve tabs, back yoke tab, collar, yoke, inseam pocket openings, front edge, as well as garment hem and slits. The coat is fully lined and is below-hip length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew this coat, choose coating fabrics with the following properties:

- medium-weight, pliable, breathable, soft, non-stretch or low-stretch, opaque
- the fiber content can include natural fibers (wool, silk, cotton, linen), artificial (viscose), blends (wool + silk, wool + polyester, cotton + viscose, etc.), and synthetic (polyester, polyester + elastane)
- the following fabrics are recommended: wool coating, cashmere, tweed, Melton wool, bouclé, jacquard, ponte di roma, felted wool.

Attention! We do not recommend stretchy knit materials (jersey fabrics), or lightweight sheer fabrics (organza, chiffon, stretch lace).

For the lining, use lining fabrics made from artificial fibers (viscose), blends (viscose + elastane, viscose + polyester), or synthetics (polyester, polyester + elastane).

For the hood, use knit fabrics made from natural fibers (cotton) and blends (cotton + viscose, cotton + polyester). The following types of knit fabrics are recommended: French terry, sweatshirt fleece.

The coat in the photos is made of tweed coating. The fabric is medium-weight, pliable, soft, and low-stretch. The fiber content is wool + viscose. The lining is 100% viscose. The detachable hood is made of French terry.

IMPORTANT!

When purchasing fabric, please account for shrinkage and buy 5% more than required.

- 6. 11 buttons, 2.3 cm (7/8") in diameter
- 7. 13 transparent buttons, 1 cm (3/8") in diameter
- 8. Matching thread 2 spools
- 9. Matching topstitching thread (e.g. Madeira №35) 1 spool

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- sewing machine for construction
- buttonhole foot for the sewing machine
- edgestitch foot (optional)

PATTERN PIECES LIST

1. From main fabric:

- front cut 2
- back cut 1
- back yoke cut 1
- front facing cut 2
- top sleeve cut 2
- bottom sleeve cut 2
- undercollar cut 2
- upper collar cut 1
- collar stand cut 2
- top sleeve tab cut 2
- bottom sleeve tab cut 2
- pocket cut 2
- top pocket flap cut 2
- bottom pocket flap cut 2
- side pocket facing cut 2
- back yoke tab cut 2
- front hem facing cut 2
- back hem facing cut 1

2. From lining:

- front lining cut 2
- back lining cut 1
- back yoke lining cut 1 on fold
- top sleeve lining cut 2
- bottom sleeve lining cut 2
- pocket lining cut 2
- side pocket top lining cut 2
- side pocket bottom lining cut 2

3. From additional material:

- side hood cut 2
- inner side hood cut 2
- center hood panel cut 1
- inner center hood panel cut 1
- tie for channel cut 1 on fold

IMPORTANT!

Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.

4. From interfacing:


- front cut 2
- back cut 1
- back yoke cut 1
- front facing cut 2
- top sleeve (partly) cut 2
- bottom sleeve (partly) cut 2
- undercollar cut 2
- upper collar cut 1
- collar stand cut 2

- top sleeve tab cut 2
- bottom sleeve tab cut 2
- pocket cut 2
- top pocket flap cut 2
- bottom pocket flap cut 2
- side pocket facing cut 2
- back yoke tab cut 2
- front hem facing cut 2
- back hem facing cut 1









- one edge of the side pocket facing
- all edges and foldline of the patch pocket
- outer edges on sleeve tabs
- outer edges on the top pocket flap
- outer edges on the back yoke tab

The fusible tape should be placed at 8 mm (3/8") from the edge and not stretched.

Thread trace the following constructive lines:

- center front
- center back and center yoke
- patch pocket and flap stitching lines
- button and buttonhole placement
- notches

Important! It's better to use light color thread to avoid dying the fabric when steaming.
