Iliana is a close-fitting sheath dress. It features a one-piece long raglan sleeve with a shoulder dart. The deep V-neckline is finished with a rawedged binding. Iliana is midi length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew this dress, choose knit fabrics with the following properties:

- · Medium weight, soft, breathable, malleable, stretchy (with elastane)
- The fiber content can include natural fibers (wool, cotton), artificial (viscose), blends (wool + polyester, cotton + polyester, cotton + elastane, etc) and synthetic (polyester, polyester + elastane)
 - · The following fabrics are recommended: sweater knits, ponte di roma, knits, double knits, rib knits

Attention! We do not recommend lightweight sheer fabrics (chiffon, organza, stretch lace).

The dress in the photo is made in ponte di roma. This fabric is medium weight, malleable, and stretchy.

The fiber content is a blend of cotton + viscose + elastane.

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- Sewing machine for construction
- Overlocker for construction and for finishing raw edges. This may be replaced with a stretch overlock stitch or a zigzag stitch on the sewing machine (overlock or zigzag stitch width 2-3mm, stitch length 2.5mm)
- Coverstitch or coverlock machine for finishing the garment hem. If such a machine is not available, you may finish the hem with a twin needle on a home sewing machine with a zigzag function
 - · Ballpoint needles suitable to your fabric

IMPORTANT! For knit projects, we recommend using special sewing needles for stretchy knit fabrics (e.g. STRETCH, SUPER STRETCH, JERSEY, etc.). When sewing, a ball-shaped needle point pushes the knit loops apart without piercing the threads.

PATTERN PIECES LIST

- 1. From main fabric:
- Front cut 1 on fold
- · Back cut 1 on fold
- · Sleeve cut 2
- Neckband cut 1

IMPORTANT! Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.

SEAM ALLOWANCES

All pattern pieces include the following seam allowances:

- Garment hem 2cm (¾")
- · Sleeve hems 2cm (34")
- All the other edges 1cm (%")

Take this into account when laying out pattern pieces on the fabric.



Press the seams flat, then press the seam allowances towards the back.



Insert the sleeves into the armscyes with right sides together, matching the edges and all notches. Pin, baste (hand baste at 1.2-1.5cm [½"-¾"]) from the edge so that the basting thread doesn't get caught in the machine stitching), and stitch the sleeves on the overlocker with the garment side facing up. Use a stitch width of 7mm (¾") and trim off 3mm (¾") while overlocking.



Press the seams flat, then press the seam allowances towards the sleeve.
