

Asya is a close-fitting dress with an accentuated waist. The dress features a waist seam and adjustable straps. The bodice and skirt are fitted with bust and waist darts. There is an invisible zipper and a slit in the center back seam. Asya is midi length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew this dress, choose fabrics with the following properties: medium weight, soft, non-stretch or low-stretch. The fiber content can include natural fibers, artificial fibers, blends, or synthetics.

The following fabrics are recommended: silk, viscose, challis, sateen, poplin, dress-weight denim.

Attention! We do not recommend stretchy knit fabrics.

The dress in the photo is made of artificial silk. The fabric is soft, thin, non-structured, a bit sheer, and has no stretch.

The fiber content is 100% polyester. The fabric weight is 150 g/m².

FABRIC AND NOTIONS REQUIREMENTS

1. Main fabric, 140 cm wide, with a directional print/nap, in meters:

Main fabric, 55" wide, with a directional print/nap, in yards:

IMPORTANT! When purchasing fabric, please account for shrinkage and buy 5% more than required.

- 2. Lightweight interfacing, knit or woven, 140 cm (55") wide, for all sizes in all heights 0.65 m (3/4 yd)
- 3. Stitched straight-grain fusible stay tape, 1 cm (3/8") wide 1.2 m (1 1/4 yd)
- 4. One invisible zipper, 50 cm (19 5/8") long, for all sizes in all heights
- 5. One set of accessories for straps: 2 sliders and 2 rings
- 6. Matching thread 5 spools (1 spool for the sewing machine + 4 spools for the overlocker)

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- · sewing machine for construction
- overlocker for finishing raw edges. This may be replaced with a stretch overlock stitch or a zigzag stitch on the sewing machine (overlock or zigzag stitch width 2–3 mm, stitch length 2.5 mm)
- · invisible zipper foot for the sewing machine
- · one-sided foot for the sewing machine
- · loop turner

PATTERN PIECES LIST

1. From main fabric:

- front bodice cut 1 on fold
- · center back bodice cut 2
- · side back bodice cut 2
- front facing cut 1 on fold
- back facing cut 2
- · strap cut 2
- front skirt cut 1 on fold
- back skirt cut 2

Additionally, cut the following pieces from the main fabric:

- a square piece with 4 cm (1 5/8") sides to reinforce the top of the slit
 a rectangular piece, 5×3 cm (2"×1 1/8"),
- to cover the invisible zipper end

2. From interfacing:

- front facing cut 1 on fold
- back facing cut 2

Additionally, cut the following pieces from interfacing:

- two strips, 1.5 cm (5/8") wide (length according to the pattern), to interface the slit section of the center back seam allowances
- four strips, 1.5 cm (5/8") wide (length according to the pattern), to interface the zipper section of the center back seam allowances

The interfacing strips should be cut on the straight grain (parallel to the selvedge).

IMPORTANT! Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.

SEAM ALLOWANCES

All pattern pieces include seam allowances as follows:

- garment hem allowance 2 cm (3/4")
- center back seam allowances 1.5 cm (5/8")
- all other edges 1 cm (3/8")

Take this into account when laying out pattern pieces on the fabric



Press the seam allowances towards the center back bodice piece.



Place the front and back bodice pieces right sides together. Align the side edges, match the notches and pin. Stitch on the sewing machine, backstitching at the beginning and end of the seam.



Press the seams flat.
