#### **FAYTHE PATTERN DESCRIPTION**

Faythe is a pair of loose-fitting, straight-cut pants. The upper edge of the grown-on elasticated waistband sits at the natural waistline. The waistband features a casing formed by topstitching lines and a cord threaded through it. The side seams have pockets in them and are decorated with piping and topstitching. An elastic cord with a stopper is threaded through the casing at the garment hem. The pants are ankle-length.

#### **SUGGESTED FABRIC**

To sew these pants, choose medium-weight, non-stretch or low-stretch fabrics made of natural fibers, artificial fibers, blends, or synthetics.

The following fabrics are recommended: outerwear fabrics, thick French terry, thick sweatshirt fleece. The pants in the photo are made of outerwear fabric. The fabric is medium weight and has very little stretch. The fiber content is 100% polyester. The fabric weight is 280 g/m<sup>2</sup>.

IMPORTANT! When purchasing fabric, please account for shrinkage and buy 5% more than required.

- 2. Lightweight knit or woven interfacing, 140 cm (55") wide, for all sizes in all heights 3 cm (1 1/8")
- 3. Stitched bias-cut fusible stay tape with stitch reinforcement, 1.5 cm (5/8") wide 0.4 m (3/8 yd)

4. Elastic, 4 cm (1 5/8") wide, for all heights (including seam allowances):

9. Matching thread — 5 spools (1 spool for the sewing machine + 4 spools for the overlocker)

### TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- sewing machine for construction
- overlocker for finishing raw edges. This may be replaced with a stretch overlock stitch or a zigzag stitch on the sewing machine (overlock or zigzag stitch width 2–3 mm, stitch length 2.5 mm)
- · buttonhole foot for the sewing machine
- · one-sided foot for the sewing machine to attach the piping
- · elastic threader (may be replaced with a safety pin)

#### PATTERN PIECES LIST

- 1. From main fabric:
- back leg cut 2
- front leg cut 2
- pocket lining cut 4
- · loop cut 1

#### Cut the following from interfacing:

 $\cdot$  six 3×3 cm (1 1/8×1 1/8") square pieces to interface the buttonhole areas on the front and back leg pieces.


IMPORTANT! Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.

#### **SEAM ALLOWANCES**

All pattern pieces include seam allowances as follows:

- garment hem allowance 3 cm (1 1/8")
- all other edges -1 cm (3/8")

Take this into account when laying out pattern pieces on the fabric.



Insert a pin at the end of each buttonhole to protect the edge from being cut and then carefully cut the buttonholes open with a seam ripper.



Press the finished buttonholes.



Press and steam the piping in order to prevent its shrinkage in the finished garment.
