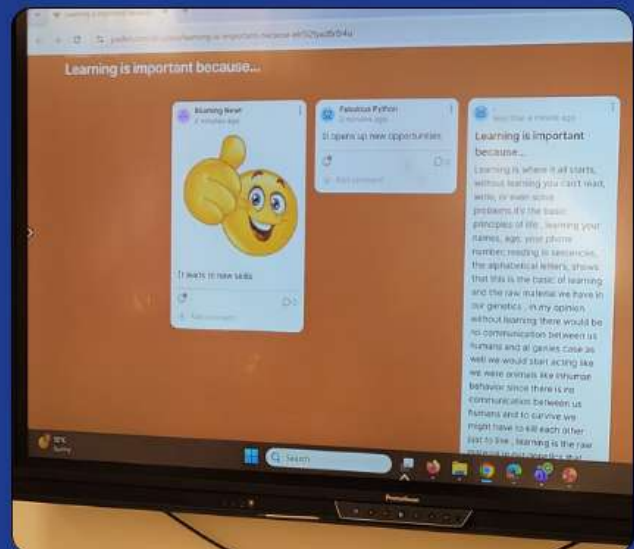
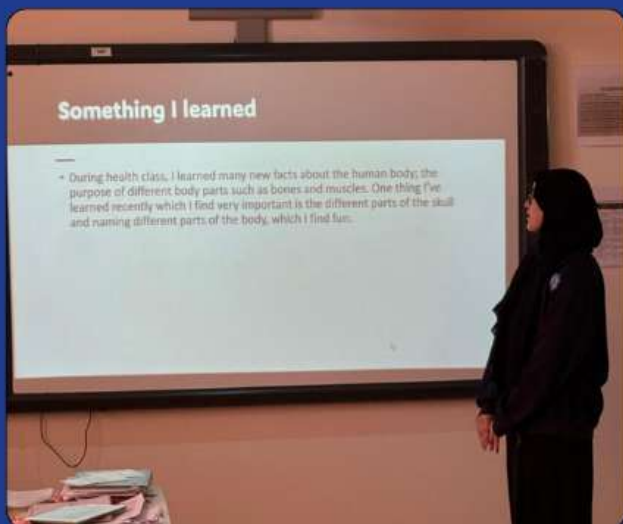
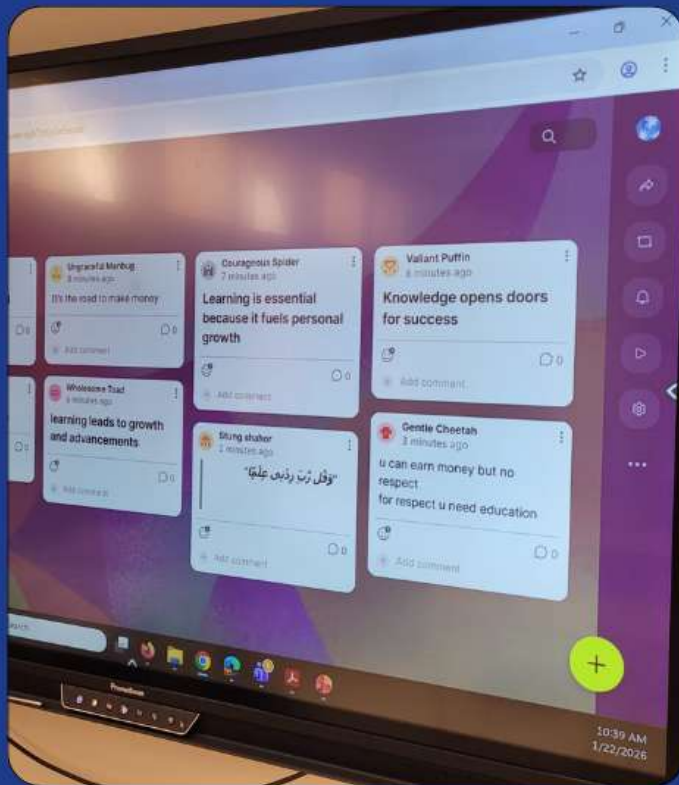
TEACHERS' PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (PD)
