National Innovation Olympiad (NIO) Award Ceremony

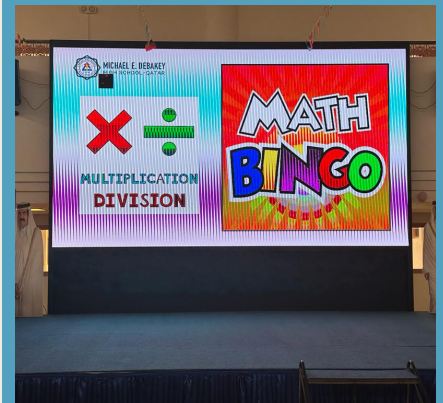
