

The main scholarships and bursary deadline was 1 April 2021, however further scholarships and bursaries often become available later in the year. The new scholarships/bursaries listed in this application form have a deadline to apply of 1 August 2021.

How to complete this form

You can use this application form for all scholarships and bursaries listed on page 2-3.

- Tick the Scholarships/bursaries you are applying for.
- **Attach a personal statement for each scholarship or bursary application.** You can do this by copying the Personal Statement section on page 6.
- Fill in the name of the scholarship/bursary you are applying for at the top of the page and make sure that you have covered the criteria in your personal statement(s).

Applications are considered by the Grants Committee and a recommendation is made to the Scholarship or Bursary Trust for approval. Applicants should note that students will be required to sign terms and conditions if awarded a grant.

Scholarships

West Dean College awards a number of scholarships on behalf of funders to the very best students. Applicants for the scholarship awards need to be able to demonstrate an outstanding potential and commitment to their studies and future career in their chosen subject. Candidates will be expected to demonstrate excellence by providing evidence of past achievements and related work experience, alongside recommendations from current or past tutors and colleagues.

Criteria

The criteria for each scholarship are listed on page 2 of this form. Please read these carefully to ensure that you are eligible to apply. The criteria marked with an asterisk will be given the strongest weighting when applications are being considered.

Deadline and application submission

Applications must be made by **1 August 2021 – 5pm** and, if successful, applicants will be notified between May and August. We are unable to provide an exact decision date but we will inform you as soon as a decision has been made. Please note unsuccessful applicants are unable to request feedback from the Grants Committee.

Your application must be **typed** – hand-written applications will not be accepted. Please include two typed references, one of which should be from a current or recent tutor and should address why you are the best candidate for this scholarship. Your application will not be considered if the two references are not included or if your application is incomplete. **Current students** do not have to include references but a tutor reference will be requested if nominated for a scholarship.
